LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox failed to win their third in a row against the Akron RubberDucks in a 6-3 loss on Thursday night. **TT Bowens** hit his 10th homer of the season in the first inning to put Bowie in front early. However, Akron scored six unanswered runs from the third inning through the fifth inning to take a 6-2 lead. **Samuel Basallo** homered for the 13th time this season in the eighth. Bowie brought the tying run to the plate in the ninth but **Connor Pavolony** grounded into a game-ending double play.

ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B **Samuel Basallo**, the Orioles 2024 All-Star Futures Game selection, is tied for the 8th-most hits in the Eastern League (83). The No. 2 Orioles/ No. 12 MLB prospect is tied for the 3rd-most homers by a teenager in MiLB (13) and is the first teenager to hit double-digit home runs in an Eastern League season since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. in 2018 (NH).

THE FABULOUS FABIAN

After hitting his 15th homer of the season on Tuesday, OF **Jud Fabian** is now the Eastern League leader in home runs amongst active players and is one off sharing the overall league lead. The O's No. 11 prospect has five career home runs vs Akron, including three at Canal Park.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** registered his first multi-homer game of his career on Wednesday with his 10th and 11th homers of the season, matching his season total from last year. The 22-year-old has reached base in 64 of 79 games played in his second season with the Baysox. He leads the team in walks (44) and stolen bases (20), 4th-most and tied for 5th-most in the Eastern League, respectively.

EXTRA ORDINARY

After collecting only 20 extra-base hits and four homers through the first 15 games in the month of July, Bowie has collected a whopping 15 extra-base hits and seven homers in just the first three games this week in Akron. 15 of the 23 hits in the series have gone for extra bases and 10 different players have managed to collect an extra-base hit.

YOU GOOD PHAM

RHP **Alex Pham** has been one of the best strikeout throwers in the Eastern League and in Double-A. The Orioles No. 23 prospect has 102 strikeouts on the season, which is tied for 3rd-most in the Eastern League and tied for 5th-most in all of Double-A. Pham has performed at his best this month with an ERA of just 1.35. He earned Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors on July 15 after pitching six scoreless innings over one hit and six strikeouts on July 11 at Altoona.

ARMS RACE

The Baysox pitching staff has the 4th-best ERA in Double-A since June 1 (3.50) and has recorded the 2nd-most strikeouts this season (913)...The Baysox bullpen has thrown the most innings (448.1) at Double-A with the 5th-best WHIP (1.21)...The Bowie rotation has also done its part with the 2nd-lowest ERA (2.83) in Double-A in July.

LET'S DISCUSS THE DUCKS

Entering this week, the Akron RubberDucks own the best second-half record in the Eastern League at 15-6. The RubberDucks have the best staff ERA in the Eastern League at 3.22 and they are tied with Harrisburg for the most shutouts in the league this season (12). Four of the Guardians top 30 prospects are on the RubberDucks active roster - OF Petey Halpin (No. 15), LHP Parker Messick (No. 21), 1B CJ Kayfus (No. 27) and IF Dayan Frias (No. 28)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Matthew Boyd is set to start tonight as part of his Major League rehab assignment. The 33-year-old southpaw is recovering from reconstructive elbow surgery last year. Boyd signed with the Guardians on June 29 after spending the last eight seasons with the Tigers and Mariners. In his last rehab appearance on July 21, Boyd threw four innings of one-run ball and struck out five against Richmond on 52 pitches.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado on the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Coaching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmayer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebbly joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebbly was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebbly played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022.
