Last Time Out: Andy Otero tossed six innings, tying a career high, and allowed one run while striking out eight as part of a 5-1 Shuckers win... Biloxi plated four runs in the bottom of the fourth on a pair of two-RBI singles by Brent Diaz and Ryan Aguilar... Leo Crawford picked up the save, tossing three scoreless innings.

At the Plate: *Turang, Turang:* Brice Turang continued his productive hitting for the Shuckers on Tuesday night, driving in his 30th RBI with a single in the third... Turang has now hit safely in 22 of 30 games... With runners in scoring position this season, Turang is hitting .418 (23-55) with 3 2B, HR, 26 RBI and 6 walks... In June, Turang slashed .313/.361/.475 with 8 2B, 3B, 2 HR, 16 RBI and 17 R in the month and his 31 hits were the second most in the Double-A South during the month of June (Lorenzo Cedrola (CHA) - 35).

Lujano's Career Day: Of Jesus Lujano went 4-for-5, 2B, RBI on Sunday against Pensacola, giving him a four-hit game in just his seventh game with the Shuckers... The four hits ties a career high for Lujano, who had a four hit game on 4/17/19 @ Beloit while with Single-A Wisconsin and again on 5/15/19 vs. Kane County while also with the Timber Rattlers.

Palma's Hit Parade: Alexander Palma has been the Shuckers hottest hitter in the last five contests, going a combined 11-for-20 (.550) with two home runs, 6 RBI and just one strikeout.

Diaz Does It Again: Brent Diaz has the longest active on-base streak on the Shuckers' roster, reaching base in 19 straight games, tied for the 8th longest on-base streak in franchise history (25 - Garrett Cooper and Cooper Hummel)... Diaz hit safely in 9 of 10 games in June and had a .378 on-base percentage for the month... He extended his on-base streak on Wednesday with a two-RBI single in the bottom of the fourth...

On the Mound: *League Leaders:* Five of the Shuckers relievers rank in the top five in appearances in the Double-A South: Webb - 22 (T-1st), Vennaro - 19 (T-3rd), Hardy - 18 (T-5th), Hitt 18 (T-5th), Strzelecki - 18 (T-5th)

OH-tero: Andy Otero spun a gem for the Shuckers on Wednesday night, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing just one run while striking out a season high eight batters... The six innings pitched tied a career high for Otero, who last tossed six frames on July 26, 2009 while he was with the Dominican Summer League Braves.

The ERA is Too Dang High: In the month of June, the Shuckers' pitching staff posted a 5.23 ERA, the highest ERA in a single month in franchise history... It surpassed the previous high of 5.00, which the 2021 Shuckers posted in the month of May... Coming into 2021, the highest monthly ERA in franchise history was in September of 2016 when the Shuckers posted a 4.50 ERA in five games to close out the season.

Long Ball Blues: Biloxi has allowed 82 home runs this year, tied for the 8th most in all of Minor League Baseball (1st - Las Vegas: 105) and the 2nd most in Double-A (Amarillo)... Biloxi did not allow a home run on Wednesday night, the 14th game this season that they did not allow a homer... In those contests, the Shuckers are 9-5... In games in which they have allowed a home run, the Shuckers are 8-33.

What's Shuckin: *Quadruple-Double:* Biloxi turned four double plays on Tuesday night in the opener against Birmingham.

Top Two on the Coast: With the promotion of Garrett Mitchell, the Shuckers now have the top two prospects in the Brewers' system by either major ranking (Baseball America - Turang #1, Mitchell #2, MLB Pipeline - Mitchell #1, Turang #2).

Glad That's Over: With their 3-0 win on Thursday night, the Shuckers snapped a nine game losing streak, ending the longest losing streak in franchise history... The previous longest losing skid was six games in 2016 when the Shuckers lost four games at home against Jacksonville before falling in their first two games in Pensacola from 7/5 to 7/10/16.
