TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and El Paso Chihuahuas get set for the third of six games on Thursday night. Round Rock RHP Michael Lorenzen is slated to start against El Paso LHP Daniel Camarena. First pitch at Southwest University Park is scheduled for 7:35 p.m. CT.

LET'S RECAP

Round Rock fell to El Paso 11-8 on Wednesday at Southwest University Park to even the six-game series at one apiece. The Chihuahuas took an early 1-0 lead in the bottom of the first inning when LF Tirso Ornelas drew a bases loaded walk before SS Mason McCoy smacked a single to score two runs and make it 3-0. El Paso would add three more runs in the second inning on a home run by 2B Clay Dungan to make it 6-0. Round Rock's bats struck for five runs in the top of the fifth. 2B Jax Biggers, DH Dustin Harris and 3B Davis Wendzel were each credited with an RBI. After the big inning, El Paso held onto a 6-5 advantage. In the seventh inning, Dungan would hit his second three-run home run of the game, followed by a two-run blast for RF Oscar Mercado, to make it an 11-5 ballgame. E-Train RF Sandro Fabian singled in the top of the eighth inning to score two runs and cut the Chihuahuas lead to 11-7. A Wendzel sacrifice fly in the ninth brought the Express within three, but Round Rock ultimately fell to El Paso, 11-8. Round Rock reliever LHP Danny Duffy went 3.0 innings giving up one run on one hit and he struck out three. His only mistake pitch was to the first batter he faced. He retired the next eight consecutive hitters.

IN A STATE OF ZEN

Texas Rangers RHP Michael Lorenzen is scheduled to make his second start of the season for the Express, as he continues his Major League rehab assignment. In his first start, the veteran right hander allowed three earned runs on three hits, while walking two and striking out three. Lorenzen is still building up his arm for the season after signing with Texas late in Spring Training. Lorenzen holds a career record of 4-5 with a 3.57 ERA (25 ER /63 IP) in 18 games at the Triple-A level. The 32-year-old was a former first round pick in 2013.

FABIAN ES FABULOSO

Express OF Sandro Fabian has come to play early in 2024. In his first three games, Fabian is hitting .455 (5-11) with a 1.227 OPS, three doubles and four RBI. Wednesday night's contest saw the 26-year-old go 3-for-4 with a double, RBI and a run scored. He is tied for second in the Pacific Coast League individual rankings with three doubles.

HILL THE THRILL

E-Train OF Derek Hill has provided a veteran spark to the lineup. The four-year Major Leaguer has hit .364 (4-11) with a 1.136 OPS in his first three appearances of the season. Wednesday night, Hill went 2-for-4 with a double, triple, walk and stolen base. He has recorded a stolen base in back-to-back games, as he re-entered the lineup on Tuesday after missing two games from being hit by a pitch on Opening Night.

STIFLING ARMS

Round Rock LHP Danny Duffy and RHP Jack Leiter rank second and third, respectively, in the Pacific Coast League in opponent batting average. Duffy has held opposing hitters to just a .083 batting average, while Leiter has held his opponents to .118. In addition to batting average, the pair is at the top of the PCL ranks in WHIP. Leiter holds the top spot with a WHIP of 0.40, while Duffy is tied for second with Oklahoma City RHP Kevin Gowdy at 0.50.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
