YESTERDAY: The Captains mounted their biggest comeback of the season, erasing a six-run deficit to beat the Lansing Lugnuts, 13-9. Lake County trailed 7-1 going into the seventh inning, but scored six runs to tie the score, highlighted by a Victor Nova tworun triple that pulled the Captains within a run. Nova then scored on a wild pitch to knot the score. Jordan Díaz hit a solo homer in the bottom of the seventh to put Lansing back in front, 8-7. The Captains responded in the top of the eighth, however, as Bryan Lavastida hit a two-run double to give the Captains their first lead of the game, 9-8. The Captains scored four more insurance runs in the top of the ninth, including a two-run single by Will Brennan, to expand their lead to 13-8. Austin Beck tallied the last run of the game for Lansing with a solo homer in the ninth. Captains reliever Nick Gallagher picked up the win, allowing one run over 3.1 nnings. Kevin Kelly held Lansing to one run over two innings for the save. Lugnuts reliever Charles Hall took the loss and suffered a blown save after allowing two runs, both unearned, over 1.2 innings.

BABY, COME BACK: The six-run deficit the Captains overcame on Friday marked their biggest comeback of the season. Lake County had previously come back from two five-run deficits (6/1 vs. DAY and 6/13 at FW), but lost both games.

KEEP BATTLING: Will Brennan worked a 15-pitch walk during the Captains' six-run seventh inning on Friday. Brennan fouled off 10 pitches during the plate appearance before drawing the free pass against Lansing reliever Brock Whittlesey. When the Captains were in Lansing two years ago, on May 27, 2019, shortstop Tyler Freeman worked a 15-pitch at-bat with 10 foul balls against Lugnuts starter Sean Wymer. Freeman singled to center on the 15th pitch.

OUCH: The Captains have been hit by 11 pitches in this series, including a High-A Central League/Midwest League record seven on Wednesday. Brayan Rocchio has been hit by three pitches and Joe Donovan was hit three times in Wednesday's game alone.

ROCCHIO ON A ROLL: Brayan Rocchio is on an 11-game on-base streak, during which he has hit .370 (17-for-46) with one nome run, two doubles and he has been hit by four pitches. Rocchio has five multi-hit games during the streak, including a four-hit ame on July 13 at Lansing. In the month of July, Rocchio is hitting .321/.415/.411 (.826 OPS).

SUPER NOVA: Victor Nova has hit .412/.488/.912 (1.400 OPS) in July with four home runs in 10 games. Over the first two months f the season, he hit .179/.295/.241 (.536 OPS) with one home run in 37 games.

BRENNAN BASHING: Captains OF Will Brennan has led off two games with a home run in the last week. He hit a home run on the first pitch of the game at Fort Wayne on Wednesday, July 7 and homered on the fifth pitch of last night's game at Lansing. Brennan enters today third in the High-A Central League (HAC) with 18 doubles, seventh in hits (59), ninth in batting average (.284), tied for 10th in extra-base hits (23) and 14th in total bases (91).

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 18-6 at home, compared to 17-23 on the road. Captains pitchers have xperienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.01 ERA at Classic Park and a 4.91 ERA on the road.

IOT LAVA: Bryan Lavastida is riding a 17-game on-base streak. Over the last 17 games (since June 24), Lavastida is hitting .403/.466/.710 (1.175 OPS) with four homers and seven doubles. Lavastida has seven multi-hit games during that span, including hree three-hit performances.

OPPO: José Tena has been among the league's best at hitting the ball to the opposite field. Entering today, Tena has the fourthowest Pull% in the High-A Central League at 35.7%.

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2017 Captains RHP Justin Garza became the 102nd former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 27. A record 10 former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018), RHP Eli Morgan (2018), INF Ernie Clement (2018) and Garza. That breaks the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, besting the nine alumni that debuted in 2013 and 2016.

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first aseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field.

LAST TIME OUT: Sloppy Captains defense and long balls put Gaddis behind the eight ball early last Saturday at Fort Wayne. The Lake County defense committed two errors in the first inning, including a dropped fly ball with two outs that would have ended the frame. Seamus Curran followed that miscue with a three-run homer to give the TinCaps a 3-0 lead. In the second, Reinaldo llarraza led off with a bunt single and a throwing error moved him to second base. Chris Givin later hit a two-run homer on an 0-2 pitch with two outs to give Fort Wayne a 5-0 lead. Gaddis dominated after Givin's home run, retiring the final 13 men he faced to get through six innings. Lake County rallied and ultimately pulled within one run on a three-run homer by Victor Nova in the eighth, but the Captains could not complete the comeback and lost, 5-4. Gaddis was saddled with the loss.

**PROSPECTING**: Gaddis ranks as Cleveland's #29 prospect, according to FanGraphs. He is unranked on Cleveland's top prospect lists published by MLB.com and Baseball America. 2019: Across 13 appearances and 11 starts in 2019, Gaddis posted a 2.73 ERA across two levels – the Rookie Level Arizona League Indians Blue and Short Season Mahoning Valley.

NO-HITTER: On August 23, 2019, Gaddis threw three perfect innings after a 93-minute rain delay to begin what turned into a combined no-hitter against the Williamsport Crosscutters. It was the first no-hitter for Mahoning Valley since 2013. After Gaddis left the game, RHP Matt Waldron and RHP Luis Sanchez finished the game for the Scrappers. Gaddis set his career high with six strikeouts, throwing 35 pitches in the outing. Also in the starting lineup for Mahoning Valley that day were current Captains INF Brayan Rocchio, C Bryan Lavastida and OF Will Brennan

**THE MAGIC NUMBER**: Gaddis has thrown exactly three innings 10 times in his first 14 appearances as a professional. He has never thrown more than three innings so far in his professional career. To open the 2021 season against Lansing, Gaddis worked into the fourth inning for the first time as a pro, however he could not record an out exiting the game after three innings of work. In college Gaddis worked 266.2 total innings over 46 appearances, or 5.2 innings pitched per appearance.

**GEORGIA STATE STAR**: Gaddis is in the history books as an all-time great at Georgia State finishing his career with a program best 3.81 ERA. He also is second all-time in program history with 266 strikeouts, fourth in innings pitched (266.2) and sixth in games started (40). His junior season he finished with 112 strikeouts to lead the Sun Belt and finish 14th in the country. He wrapped up 2019 with his second consecutive second-team allSun-Belt selection.

**PANTHER PRO'S**: David Buchanan is currently the only Georgia State Panther to ever make the big leagues. Gaddis is trying to become the second, after being drafted in the 5th round at 160 overall he is also the highest ever draft pick from Georgia State. Buchanan was a starting pitcher from 2014-15 for the Philadelphia Phillies and was drafted in the seventh round of the 2010 draft.

**TEAM USA**: In 2017 Gaddis became the first ever player from Georgia State to be chosen by Team USA when he joined the USA Collegiate National Team.
