SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

SOME OF THE BEST: On Sunday, **INF Tyler Black** was named the 100th-best prospect in baseball by MLB Pipeline, becoming the third Shuckers' player to enter the Top-100... Today, **C Jeferson Quero** was named the 58th-best prospect in the game by *Baseball America*, his highest ranking on any prospect list... **OF Jackson Chourio** enters today as the unanimous third-ranked prospect.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: At the 2023 MLB All-Star Game, held at T-Mobile Park on Wednesday, three former Shuckers took part in the festivities... **RHP Devin Williams** ('19) and **RHP Corbin Burnes** ('17) were both selected to represent the Brewers... Former Shuckers' **INF Orlando Arcia** ('15) was also selected as the starting shortstop for the National League... Arcia, in his first year with the Atlanta Braves, was the only part of the trio to appear.

HEATING UP IN JULY: Since the start of July, the Shuckers offense has been one of the hottest in Double-A... They enter today ranked in the top five in average (4th, .282), hits (2nd, 90), doubles (3rd, 19), home runs (5th, 14), on-base percentage (5th, .382), slugging (4th, .480) and OPS (3rd, .862)... **OF Lamar Sparks** (T-5th, 1.100) and **INF/OF Isaac Collins** (T-5th, 1.100), both enter today among the Southern League leaders in OPS for the month... Sparks is also second in the league in OBP (.529) during July.

THESE SPARKS ARE ON FIRE: Since being activated off the Injured List on June 25, **OF Lamar Sparks** has tallied a hit in all 10 games, including back-to-back multi-hit performances entering today... During that streak, Sparks is hitting .389 (14-36) with 10 RBI and five stolen bases... Sparks also has three multi-hit games over his last four, and went 9-21 with a double, home run, eight RBI and four walks at Pensacola in the Shuckers' last series.

HE GETS ON BASE: **C Jeferson Quero** enters today with a 17-game on-base streak, tied for the second-longest by a Shuckers' player in 2023... Over Quero's streak, he has a .356 average (21-59) with a .487 on-base percentage and a .995 OPS... Quero has also struck out just 10 times during the streak, a 13% rate.

ON THE RUN: **INF Tyler Black** became the second player in Shuckers' franchise history (since 2015) to tally 40 stolen bases in a season, doing so on Sunday, June 25... Black enters today 12 away from breaking **OF Johnny Davis'** record of 52, set during the 2017 season in 133 games... Black enters today as the stolen-base leader in the Southern League and Double-A.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP CHRISTIAN MEJIAS (4-7, 7.04): RHP Christian Mejias is set to make his 15th start of the year, and his third against the Rocket City Trash Pandas... Over seven home starts, Mejias has a 5.08 ERA, compared to an 8.84 mark on the road... In two starts against Rocket City, Mejias has allowed three runs in 9.1 innings, and has struck out 10.
