COMEBACK FALLS SHORT IN 7-4 LOSS

The Jumbo Shrimp stole six bases on Saturday but lost to the Tides 7-4. After Norfolk scored a\ run in the first, a four-run Tides third made it 5-0. It took the Jumbo Shrimp until the sixth to get on the board on Jack Winkler's RBI single. A two-run Johnny Olmstead base hit and Matthew Etzel sacrifice fly in the seventh cut the Norfolk lead to 5-4. However, in the top of the eighth, Jordyn Adams cracked a two-run home run to widen the gap to 7-4. The Jacksonville bullpen ceded only two runs on three hits with eight strikeouts in 5.2 innings of work.

BE STILL. MY BEATING START

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/ Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 118 games this season, the Jumbo Shrimp have already tied that record by using 28 different starting pitchers. Perhaps unsurprisingly. Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 463.1 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.75 starters' ERA ranks second at the level.

IT GETS LATE EARLY

Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have worked 568.0, or 55.1 percent, of the club's 1,031.1 innings this season. Despite the huge workload, which marks the third-most innings of any bullpen in Triple-A, Jacksonville relievers have posted the level's best ERA (3.58) and BAA (.208). Over the last 23 games, the club's bullpen has worked 113.0 innings (4.9 per game), yielding only 37 runs, 34 earned, on 64 hits (5.1 H/9) for a 2.71 ERA (134 K, 10.7 K/9, 43 BB, 3.4 BB/9).

MEN OF STEAL

Over the last three seasons, Jacksonville ranked 23rd, 21st and 29th, respectively, in Triple-A in stolen bases. The club's 240 this season not only lead the entire level, but they rank seventh in all of Minor League Baseball. Of the top 24 MiLB teams in steals, only two are Triple-A or Double-A teams (Jacksonville & Nashville, 229, 9th). The Jumbo Shrimp's 240 steals are the most in a campaign for any Jacksonville team in the club's Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present). No Jacksonville club has finished in the top five in their respective level in steals since at least 2005.

THE BOOK OF MORGAN

It took Morgan McSweeney 22.0 innings to finally allow his first tally with the Jumbo Shrimp, the best scoreless streak for a Jacksonville pitcher since Sixto Sánchez went 24.0 consecutive scoreless frames from July 23-August 10, 2019. Through eight outings with the Jumbo Shrimp, McSweeney has only yielded five runs in 33.2 innings (1.34 ERA). Among the 266 IL pitchers who have logged at least 30.0 innings this season, McSweeney has the second-lowest swingingstrike rate (6.5 percent), second-lowest BABIP (.183), and third-lowest line drive rate (14.0 percent).

LESS IS MORE

Jacksonville has allowed the fewest hits (839) in Triple-A this season, a robust 32 knocks better than second-place Durham. The Jumbo Shrimp have posted a level-best .222 batting average against and 7.3 H/9 mark, respectively, and done so mainly limiting hard contact. Opponents' average exit velocity of 87.0 miles per hour is the fifth-best in Triple-A, and Jacksonville has surrendered the third-fewest barrels (163) and eighth-fewest home runs (114).

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Over the first 63 games of the season, Jacksonville cracked only 52 home runs, tied for the 26th-most in Triple-A. The Shrimp have blasted 75 bombs over the last 55 games since June 10, the seventh-most in Triple-A. Jacksonville has plated at least four runs in 38 of these 55 games, a rate of 69.1 percent. In comparison, the Shrimp plated four runs or more in just 30 of their first 63 games (47.6 percent).

SO. BABY, PULL ME CLOSER

The Jumbo Shrimp are a remarkable 46-24 (.657) in games decided by three runs or fewer this season, by far the most such wins in Triple-A. Thus, of the club's Triple-A-leading 71 victories, 64.8 percent have come by no more than three runs. In one-run affairs, Jacksonville has excelled, going 24-9, the second-most such wins in Triple-A and just one behind two teams' 25 for the most in MiLB.

SHRIMP BITES

After outscoring Nashville 40-13 during their six-game sweep last week, Jacksonville has been outscored 32-15 by Norfolk in five losses this week.
