#### JACKSONVILLE SPLITS TWIN BILL

Dane Myers homered twice as the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp split their doubleheader with the Memphis Redbirds on Friday, falling 5-3 in game one and taking the finale 5-1 in front of 6,032 fans at 121 Financial Ballpark. In the second game of the doubleheader, Jumbo Shrimp (30-36) starter Ronald Bolaños (2-7) led the way with six innings of one-run baseball with four strikeouts. Jacksonville plated runs in the first, third and fourth innings to ride a 5-1 win in game two. Memphis scored runs in four consecutive innings in game one, earning a 6-3 win to split the doubleheader.

#### **BIRD HUNTING SEASON**

Since 2021, Jacksonville's first year back in Triple-A, they are an extraordinary 28-11 (.717) against the Memphis Redbirds. Perhaps most dominantly, in 2022, the clubs matched up 18 times, with Jacksonville winning 14 of those contests (.778). Since 2021, Jacksonville has outscored Memphis 202 to 143 or an average of 5.2 to 3.7 runs per game. In close contests, the Jumbo Shrimp own a record of 15-9, including an incredible come-from-behind 9-8 win on Saturday, May 6, a six-run comeback that marked Jacksonville biggest come-from-behind victory in 10 years.

#### THE BRIAN KING

Heading into play on May 12, **Brian Miller** had posted just a .217/.318/.315/.633 line for the season. However, over the last 26 games, the Durham, N.C., native is 28-for-89 (.315/.398/.438/.836) with seven doubles, two triples, eight RBIs and 13 runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022, Miller is walking in 11.0 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 37.6 percent.

#### CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine home runs, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last 19 contests, Jacksonville has blasted 26 long balls, including a season-high six on May 27 against Charlotte, their most at notoriously pitcher-friendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 26 home runs are tied for the 12th-most in Triple-A over the last 26 games.

Dane Myers has four homers in seven games with Jax.

#### YOU CAN ONLY PLAY WHO'S IN FRONT OF YOU

Jacksonville's 30-36 record is tied for 14th in the International League, but the Jumbo Shrimp have played arguably the most difficult schedule in the circuit. Fifty-one of the club's 66 games, or 77.3 percent, have come against teams with a record of at least .500. That figure is by far the most in the league with Gwinnett sitting second with 46 games against teams with a winning record. Jacksonville is 23-28 (.451) against teams who have posted a record of at least .500.

#### IT'S \*STARTING\* TO TURN AROUND

Over the 27 games from May 5-June 4, Jacksonville starting pitchers combined to surrender 103 runs, 100 earned, on 142 hits (12.4 H/9) in 103.1 innings for an 8.71 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville starters walked 64 (5.8 BB/9) against only 75 strikeouts (6.5 K/9). However, over the last 10 contests, the club's starting pitching has improved considerably. Over this recent 10-game stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have totaled 21 runs, 21 earned, on 36 hits (7.0 H/9) in 46.0 innings for a 4.11 ERA with 33 strikeouts (6.5 K/9) against 15 walks (2.9 BB/9). Jacksonville starters have yielded one run or fewer in five of these last 10 contests.

#### FOUR SCORE AND ONE MONTH AGO

The Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in nine of their last 10 games, going 6-4 in that span. The Jumbo Shrimp are outscoring opponents 54 to 44 during this run. After going 0-6 to close out May and open the month of June, Jacksonville has won four of their last five. The Jumbo Shrimp's longest stretch of scoring at least four runs stands at 10 (April 27-May 7). During that run, Jacksonville went 7-3 and outscored their opponents 65 to 49.

#### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville snapped a four-series losing streak by splitting their series last week with Nashville. One more win in this current set against Memphis will be the Jumbo Shrimp's first series victory since taking four out of six from the Redbirds from May 2-7 at AutoZone Park... Devin Smeltzer has worked at least 5.0 innings in two of his last three starts after doing so in just one of his first four starts with the Jumbo Shrimp.

#### **ABOUT GEORGE**

-Signed in 2015 as a non-drafted free agent for just \$55,000, Soriano has risen to become the No. 27 prospect in the Marlins' organization according to MLB.com

-Due to an injury that caused him to miss the 2017 season and the canceled 2020 minor league season because of the COVID-19 pandemic, Soriano had totaled just 307.0 innings in six years in the Marlins' organization entering the 2022 season. It took him four seasons to finally reach full season pro ball in 2019 with Low-A Clinton.

#### 2023 SEASON

-Made his major league debut with the Marlins on April 16, 2023 against the Arizona Diamondbacks.

-Pitched three scoreless frames, allowing just one hit and notching two strikeouts on 25 pitches thrown.

#### 2022 SEASON

-Soriano was transferred to Jacksonville on May 22 from Double-A Pensacola. Among the  $114\,\rm pitchers$  who had logged at least 20.0 innings in the Southern League at the of his promotion, Soriano had logged the 11th-highest fly ball rate (50.9 percent) and fourth-lowest groundball rate (25.5 percent). His HR/FB rate at 7.1 percent, which was the 27th-lowest in the Southern League.

-Against right-handed hitters with Double-A Pensacola, Soriano posted .143 batting average against in 35 at-bats. Left-handed batters collected a 292 average in 48 at-bats against Soriano.

-With the bases empty (i.e. when pitching from the windup) with Pensacola, Soriano yielded a .308 opponents' average and 1.053 OPS. However, with runners on (i.e. when pitching from the stretch), opponents batted only .159 with a .469 OPS against his ledger.

-Soriano faced only two batters during the duration of his time with the Blue Wahoos in which Pensacola had a lead. He gave up a single and then an RBI triple for that contest to fall back into a tie.

#### 2021 SEASON

-In 10 starts at home between both Low-A Jupiter and High-A Beloit, Soriano went 3-1 with a 4.50 ERA in 48.0 innings (45 H, 22 BB, 64 K). Conversely, in eight starts on the road between the two levels, Soriano was 4-0 with a 2.18 ERA in 41.1 frames (39 H, 15 BB, 50 K).

-Between both levels, opponents batted .280 (52-for-186) against Soriano with the bases empty (i.e. when working from the windup). However, with runners on base, Soriano held opponents to a .203 (32-for-158).

-With Beloit, left-handed hitters batted .313/.411/.385/.796 in 96 at-bats against Soriano. Right-handed hitters slashed .231/.279/.397/.676 in 121 at-bats.
