LAST TIME OUT: Designated hitter Sonny DiChiara hit a solo homer and lifted a sacrifice fly as the Trash Pandas defeated the Barons 3-1 in 10 innings Tuesday night at Regions Field. In addition to DiChiara, first baseman Nolan Schanuel went 3-4 with a double and two singles. Centerfielder Bryce Teodosio and catcher Tyler Payne contributed with two singles apiece as Rocket City pounded out 10 hits for the game. Getting the win in relief was Nick Jones who fired 1.2 innings of scoreless relief with a strikeout. Righty Kelvin Caceres retired the only man he faced for his first save as a Trash Panda. Starter Brett Kerry allowed a run on five hits with seven strikeouts in six innings of work.

DRAFTEES DEBUT: In the past week, two of the Los Angeles Angels' 2023 draftees have been added to the Rocket City roster. On 7/26, 20th round selection Mac McCroskey was the first player from the draft class to reach Double-A. The infielder out of Oral Roberts recorded his first Double-A hit, a bunt single, in Friday's win. McCroskey added a key single in the 10th inning last night for his second Double-A hit. Last Friday, first round pick Nolan Schanuel was promoted from Low-A Inland Empire. after going 7-for-14 at the plate in five games between the ACL Angels and Inland Empire. He went 0-4 in his Double-A debut on 7/29 but broke out since then, going 6-8 with four runs scored, a double, a triple, and five RBI in his last two games, including the game-winning bases loaded walk in the 10th last night.

IT'S WHAT WE'RE HERE FOR: As the Angels go on a playoff run, they have made moves to bolster their roster that have impacted Rocket City. On 6/9, the Angels traded Rocket City starting hurlers Landon Marceaux and Coleman Crock to the Mets for Eduardo Escobar. The dealing continued on 7/26 when the Angels traded Rocket City starting pitcher Ky Bush and catcher Edgar Quero to the White Sox for reliever Reynoldo Lopez and starter Lucas Giolito. Finally, on 8/1, Los Angeles sent utilityman Jeremiah Jackson to the Mets for MLB reliever Dominic Leone.

FLINT DOESN'T FLINCH: In his first season at the Double-A level, outfielder Tucker Flint has struggled while adapting to the higher level of play. At the All-Star Break, Flint was batting .206. Since the All-Star break, he is 15-52 (.288) with a home run and seven RBI to raise his average to .222. During the Pensacola series (7/18-7/23), Flint went 9-22 with three runs driven in. His best game was on 7/21 when he went 4-6 with two RBI and finished a homer shy of the cycle. On Sunday, he was the only Rocket City player to not record a hit in the rout over Tennessee, going 0-1 with three walks in the win. Over the season, Flint has especially loves playing against the Birmingham Barons. In 17 games against the Barons, Flint is hitting .373 (25-67) with 15 runs scored, four home runs, 15 RBI, and a .462 on-base percentage.

SONNY SHOWS PROMISE: A little more than a year since he was drafted in the fifth round, Auburn alumn Sonny DiChiara is starting to show why the Angels have high hopes on the Hoover native. After starting the year at extended spring training, DiChiara beat up Pensacola pitching last week, going 7-21 over five games with a homer and four RBI. Included was a bases-clearing double to tie the game on 7/22. His seven-game hitting streak came to an end on 7/27, but he started a new one with hits in his past three games. Over his past 11 games, DiChiara is hitting .325 (13-40) with three home runs and 12 RBI.

STRUGGLING ARMS: Rocket City currently leads the league in hit batters (93). Of the season's first 96 games, Trash Pandas pitchers have walked six or more hitters 31 times. They have the fewest strikeouts in the league at 875. They have the second-highest opponents' batting average (.255), the second-most runs (557) and the second-most earned runs (499).

BIG INNING WOES: The Trash Pandas have struggled with the big inning this season. With 7/22's loss, Rocket City has now allowed six or more runs in a single inning 16 times this season. The largest coming on 7/6, 6/28 and 6/7 when they allowed eight runs in one inning.

NOTEWORTHY

THE LEE FILE: RHP Jake Lee will make his first start of the season for Rocket City in today's doubleheader at Regions Field. This will be his first start for Rocket City since 6/4/21 against Chattanooga. He began the season at Triple-A Salt Lake in the rotation and was solid in April, posting a 3.05 ERA in five starts while not factoring in a decision. In late May, he transitioned into a bullpen role after a few rocky starts at the beginning of the month. Overall, he made nine relief appearances and nine starts for the Bees. In the starts, he went 0-2 with a 5.67 ERA and a .343 opponents' average. In the relief outings, Lee went 1-0 with a 11.30 ERA, allowing 18 runs in 14.1 innings with opponents hitting .422 against him. He was transferred to the Trash Pandas on 7/2 and has been an asset in the Rocket City bullpen, with five of his seven outings being scoreless. His longest outing was last Wednesday, throwing 4.1 scoreless relief innings after starter Brett Kerry was knocked out in the fourth inning against Tennessee.

VS. BIRMINGHAM: Lee is set face the Barons for the second time in his career. On 5/29/21, he pitched 4.1 innings against Birmingham at Toyota Field, allowing three earned runs on three hits with six strikeouts.

MORE NOTES

2022 IN REVIEW: Lee began the 2022 season on the injured list while recovering from surgery that ended his 2021 season. On 7/29, he was sent on a rehab assignment to the ACL Angels and made three appearances there before joining Salt Lake for his Triple-A debut on 8/9. He struggled with Salt Lake, allowing runs in six of his nine outings.

INAUGURAL TRASH PANDA: Lee began the 2021 season with the Trash Pandas for his Double-A debut. He got the start in the fifth game in Rocket City history on 5/8, taking the loss at Chattanooga after allowing five runs, three earned, on nine hits. He earned the win in the fourth game at Toyota Field on 5/14/21, pitching five scoreless innings with eight strikeouts. Lee made five total starts for Rocket City before winding up on the injured list on 6/8, ending his season.

2019 CUT SHORT: In 2019, he earned a promotion from Low-A Burlington to High-A Inland Empire on 4/27. After five appearances for the 66ers, he was placed on the injured list on 5/20. He was activated on 6/22 and made one more appearance before returning to the IL on 6/23, ending his season.

ALL-STAR ROOKIE: In his first professional season in 2018, Lee was named a Pioneer League Mid-Season All-Star for Rookie-Level Orem after going 0-1 with a 1.93 ERA (3 ER/14.0 IP) and four saves over 10 relief outings in the first half of the season. Out of his 17 appearances for the Owlz, 14 were scoreless.

WHAT IS A TRASH PANDA?

The name was chosen in a name-the-team contest and is a reference to the area's association with the space industry and the determination and ingenuity of raccoons, aka trash pandas.

Trash Pandas, slang for raccoon, was included in the original 10 nominations following several Brandiose-led focus groups in Madison and Huntsville. The ballot descriptor read: Our community is known for engineering, and no creature in our galaxy is as smart, creative, determined and ingenious a problem solver - dedicated to the challenge at hand - as our local raccoons!

In July 2018, after the results from several focus groups in Madison and Huntsville, 10 names were selected, based on their uniqueness and how each name relates to the characteristics of the area: (Alphabetically) Army Ants, Comet Jockeys, GloWorms, Lunatics, Moon Possums, Puffy Head Bird Legs, Space Chimps, Space Sloths, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas. The focus groups were led by San Diego-based Brandiose, the Minor League Baseball industry's premiere branding partner.

Over the next few weeks, two rounds of online voting took place. The first round narrowed the list to Comet Jockeys, Moon Possums, Space Chimps, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas.

Trash Pandas won the final round with 44.75 percent of the vote to ThunderSharks 19.25 percent. Moon Possums was third (12.57 percent); Space Chimps fourth (12.05 percent); and Comet Jockeys fifth (11.38 percent).

By the way, Trash Pandas dominated in both rounds.

More than 28,500 nominations and votes were recorded. According to Brandiose, this represented - by far - the largest community participation in a Name the Team contest in the history of Minor League Baseball. The team name was announced in a local microbrewery in September 2018 with nearly 1,500 fans on hand. Trash Pandas was nominated by Matthew Higley of Lacey's Spring, Alabama. He received two box seats for the first five seasons and will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at a Trash Pandas home game.

The regional identifier was also chosen by the community. Out of 13,559 votes cast, 67.4 percent chose Rocket City over North Alabama (18.09 percent) and Madison (14.51 percent).
