YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Patriots, 8-7, in 10 innings. Aeverson Arteaga won the game with a walk-off infield single in the bottom of the 10th. Somerset took a 1-0 lead in the first before a solo homer by Jairo Pomares tied the game in the second inning. Spencer Jones moved the Patriots in front 3-1 with a two-run homer in the third. In the fourth, Devin Mann hit his first Richmond homer to pull the Flying Squirrels back within a run. Diego Velasquez tied the game with a double in the fifth and later scored on a go-ahead double by **Bryce Eldridge**. **Jairo Pomares** added an RBI single in the inning to push the lead to two. After Somerset scored on an error in the sixth, **Zach Morgan** belted a solo homer in the bottom of the inning and **Carter Howell** went deep in the seventh to extend the lead to 7-4. The Patriots tied the score in the top of the ninth with a two-run triple by Alexander Vargas and a single by Wegner.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game home series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. The two teams meet again at Somerset from July 29-August 3. The Flying Squirrels and Patriots met last season for two series. Richmond opened the year at Somerset dropping two-of-three from April 5-7. The Patriots won fiveof-six at The Diamond from June 25-30.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 7,048 fans per home game, which ranks second among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7.290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 1-5 in last week's road trip to Akron, their fourth series loss of the year. Their 7-18 start is the worst in franchise history. The 2015 Flying Squirrels started 3-2 before losing a franchise-record 15 consecutive games, falling to 3-17. They snapped the losing slide with a six-game win streak and finished the year 72-68, one game out of a postseason spot. The Flying Squirrels have won both of their May games.

THE PATRIOTS split last week's home series against the Hartford Yard Goats. They opened the season dropping two-of-three at Hartford before splitting a home series against the Hartford dods. The Somerset offense leads the Eastern League in homers (29) and doubles (56) and rank second in SLG (.424). Somerset's roster features four of Baseball America's top-30 Yankees prospects, including OF Spencer Jones (No. 6), C/1B Rafael Flores (No. 10), RHP Cam Schlittler (No. 14) and RHP Clayton Beeter (No. 21). There are also four players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Yankees prospects list, including Jones (No. 2), Schlittler (No. 10), Flores (No. 15) and Beeter (No. 20).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Joe Whitman makes his fifth start of the season and his first against Somerset. He last threw on Sunday in his hometown of Akron and allowed four runs over 2.2 innings. In his first full professional season last year, Whitman split the year between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, going 3-8 with a 4.63 ERA in 23 starts. He finished the year ranked ninth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (108) and tied for ninth in games started. Whitman was selected in the second round of the 2023 MLB Draft by the Giants out of Kent State, where he was the MAC Pitcher of the Year that season. Before transferring to Kent State near his hometown of Akron, Ohio, Whitman pitched at Purdue. Entering 2025, Whitman was ranked by Baseball America as the No. 10 Giants prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com. For more on Whitman, see page two.

FOR SOMERSET: Right-hander Trent Sellers makes his fifth start of the season. Last time out, he allowed two runs over 5.2 innings with seven strikeouts in a no-decision against Hartford. In his last two starts, he has a 1.59 ERA (2 ER/11.1 IP) with 14 strikeouts. Sellers began his collegiate career at Washington State before pitching two years at NAIA Lewis-Clark State. He transferred to Oregon State in 2023 and signed with the Yankees that July. He spent last season with High-A Hudson Valley and went 6-3 with a 2.09 ERA in 31 outings (nine starts) en route to being named a South Atlantic League All-Star.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to throw out 16 stolen base attempts this season, which is first among all 30 Double-A teams. Sugastey is tied for first in Double-A with 10 runners caught stealing, which leads the EL. Morgan is third in the EL with six.

BRYCE IS BACK: Northern Virginia native **Bryce Eldridge** returned to the Richmond roster last Tuesday after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For the year in 116 games, Eldridge hit .291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 11 prospect in baseball. Eldridge is also the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history. On Thursday, he tied his Double-A high with three hits and added his fourth RBI of the season.

GO, DIEGO, GO: Diego Velasquez is riding a 13-game hitting streak, which is the longest current streak in the Eastern League and the third-longest in the EL this season. In those 13 games since April 18, Velasquez is batting .392 (20-for-51) with a homer, four doubles, eight RBIs and eight runs scored. In his 36 games with Richmond dating back to last year, Velasquez is batting .315 (75-for-238). His 13-game hit streak is the longest since a 13-game streak by **Shane Matheny** in 2022. The last 14-game hit streak by a Richmond player was in 2017 by **Miguel Gomez.**

CLOSING THE DOOR: On Thursday, **Tyler Myrick** closed the 14th save of his Flying Squirrels career, tying ninth place on the franchise's all-time list with **Brett Bochy** (2012) and **Melvin Adon** (2019, 2022). In his Richmond career dating back to 2023, Myrick has converted 82.4 percent of his save attempts, which is tied for fifth-highest in franchise history (min. 15 attempts). In 2023 between Richmond and High-A Eugene, Myrick went 15-for-15 in save attempts, the only pitcher in MiLB with a perfect mark and at least 12 tries.

WHERE DID THESE GUYS COME FROM?: There are players from six different counties on the Flying Squirrels' roster, including the United States (22 players), Venezuela (2), the Dominican Republic (1), Cuba (1), Panama (1) and Puerto Rico (1). Among the 21 American-born players, 12 different states are represented, including North Carolina (3), Florida (3), Ohio (3), California (3), Michigan (2), Pennsylvania (2), Minnesota (1), North Dakota (1), Rhode Island (1), Texas (1), Indiana (1) and Virginia (1). There are 12 players who joined the Giants organization out of the MLB Draft, five were signed as non-drafted free agents, four as international free agents, four who were picked up in trades, one who was claimed in the minor-league phase of the Rule 5 Draft and two signed as MiLB free agents. For 22 players, the Giants were their original affiliated organization and seven have played with other major-league organizations.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Diego Velasquez is tied for eighth in batting average (.319), ninth in OBP (.392) and tied for first in hits (29). **Jairo Pomares** is tied for third in homers (5), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (11) and tied for seventh in total bases (44). **Jack Choate** is tied for fourth in strikeouts (30).

LONG NIGHTS: The Flying Squirrels are playing nine-inning games at an average time of two hours, 48 minutes and 25 seconds, which is tied with Reading for the longest in the Eastern League this year. It is their second-longest average game time in the pitch clock era (since 2015), trailing only 2021 (2:56:51). It is the fourth-longest in franchise history. This year, the Flying Squirrels have played eight nine-inning games at 2:52 or longer. Wednesday's game was 3:27, the longest nine-inning game for the team since September 9, 2021.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Bryce Eldridge (No. 1), Joe Whitman (No. 10), Diego Velasquez (No. 13), Sabin Ceballos (No. 16), Trent Harris (No. 26), Aeverson Arteaga (No. 27) and Jack Choate (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 11 overall by Baseball America and No. 22 by MLB.com.

BASEBALL HISTORY

1960: The Richmond Virginians beat the Buffalo
Bisons, 7-0, at Parker Field. Eli Grba threw a six-hit Shutout with seven strikeouts. Bill Shantz, Deron Johnson and Bob Martyn each homered for the Vees. **1976:** The Richmond Braves beat the Rochester Red Wings, 9-1, at Parker Field. Richmond ester Red Wings, 9-1, at Parker Field. Richmond starter Blue Moon Odom and Rochester starter Dennis Martinez were in a tight pitching duel to the middle innings. Kiko Garcia hit a solo homer in the fifth to give Rochester a 1-0 lead. In the bottom of the sixth, Reggie Sanders hit a two-run homer to move the R-Braves ahead, 2-1. Richmond added three runs in the seventh and four in the eighth. 1992: Pete Smith pitched a seven-inning perfect game in a doubleheader for the Richmond Braves against the Rochester Red Wings at Silver Stadium. Rochester won the first game, 5-4, in 14 innings in the completion of a suspended game that was picked up in the second inning. Richmond won the second game, 1-0. Smith struck out seven of the first nine batters he faced and 12 total. The only run scored on a double by Vinny Castilla in the third inning. Smith was coming back from surgery to repair a rotator cuff tear after the 1990 season. It was the first seven-inning perfect game in the International League since 1974, the seventh seven-inning perfect game in the league's history and the ninth overall in IL history. It is the only perfect game on record in Richmond's professional baseball history. 2010: The Flying Squirrels beat the Altoona Curve, 9-5, at The Diamond. It was the team's seventh straight win, which sat as a franchise record un til 2021. In the victory, Clay Timpner went 3-for-3 and drove in three runs. Nick Noonan had three hits, including a homer.
