RIDERS EVEN SOUTH DIVISION SERIES IN ALL-TIME CLASSIC 4-3 WIN:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Midland RockHounds 4-3 in 11 innings on Thursday evening from Riders Field. Frisco (84-54) and Midland (84-54) went scoreless through the first three innings before **Cody Freeman** pushed the RoughRiders ahead with a solo homer to left field against Jack Perkins in the home half of the fourth inning. **Kohl Drake** was dominant, holding the RockHounds scoreless while allowing just two hits and a walk with six punchouts across his 5.0 innings of work. In the top of the sixth inning, **Bryan Magdaleno** emerged from the Riders bullpen. The lefty picked up the first two outs of the inning before back-to-back homers from Daniel Susac and Will Simpson gave Midland a 2-1 advantage. **Jackson Kelley**, **Josh Sborz** and **Skylar Hales** combined to throw 2.1 scoreless and hitless frames while striking out four. Trailing 2-1 in the bottom of the ninth inning, Seth Elledge retired the first two he faced. Down to his final strike, **Abimelec Ortiz** launched a mammoth homer to left, evening the game at 2-2. In the top of the tenth inning, Acker retired the first two he faced before surrendering an RBI single to Denzel Clarke that put the RockHounds back in front at 3-2. In the home half of the tenth inning, Daniel Mateo pinch ran for **Cooper Johnson**. David Leal (0-1) picked up the first two outs before **Alejandro Osuna** leveled the score with a two-out RBI single. **Dane Acker** (1-0), who entered in the top of the ninth, held the RockHounds scoreless in the 11th. He finished after 3.0 innings, allowing just one unearned run on one hit while fanning two. In the last of the eleventh, **Maximo Acosta** swiped third base to set the table for Ortiz to drive in the winning run with a sacrifice fly to center. Offensively, the Riders were held to just five hits, scoring each of their first two runs on solo homers. Ortiz paced the offense with two RBI.

BACK IN THE POSTSEASON:

The Riders are back in the playoffs for the first time since 2022, when they won their second Texas League Championship, along with 2004. The RoughRiders have an overall playoff record of 28-24.

RECORD SEASON:

The RoughRiders finished the regular season with franchise record for the best winning percentage (.609). The 2024 Riders finished third in franchise history in steals (150) and fifth in walks (481). On the pitching side, they finished third in ERA (3.67), they allowed the fewest hits in a full season (not including the 119-game 2021 season), with 1,032, tied for the lowest batting average against in a full season (.231) and third in strikeouts (1,253).

SOUTHERN SUCCESS:

In order to achieve their record season, the Riders were very good against their South Division opponents, going 59-31 against their division teams. The only problem is that they went just 6-12 against Midland while they went a combined 53-19 against Corpus Christi, Amarillo and San Antonio. Against Midland, the Riders hit just .219/.291/.305/.596 with seven home runs in 18 games and averaged 2.4 runs per game. Only **Alejandro Osuna** (.909), **Max Acosta** (.820), **Cody Freeman** (.785) and **Cooper Johnson** (.771) have an OPS above .700 against Midland.

I LIKE BIG BATS AND I CANNOT LIE:

Over the last four games of the regular year, the Riders have hammered the Sod Poodles, batting .373/.432/.745/1.177 (OPS is first in MiLB) as a team while scoring 42 runs in the four games. Their 15 home runs in the last four games are first in MiLB as well.

PUSH IT TO THE MAXIMO:

Riders infielder **Max Acosta** has been en fuego at the plate, hitting .339 (60-for-177)/.404/.520/.924 over his last 45 games. Since July 10th, in those last 45 games, he is second in the league in average (.339) and third in OPS (.924). In his last 32 games, he is hitting .359 (46-for-128)/.429/.555/.984. He has hits in 13 of his last 14 games, batting .434 (23-for-53)/.538/.755/1.293. Acosta set a career-best in all slashline categories and is one of five qualified players in the Texas League this year who is 21-year-old or younger.

HATCHIN HOMERS:

Josh Hatcher ended the season as one of the hotter hitters in the Texas League, batting .327/.394/.494/.888 over his last 42 games with 10 doubles, six home runs and 24 RBIs. In his last 14 games, he is hitting .368 (21-for-57)/.429/.632/1.061 with six doubles, three home runs, 10 RBIs, 11 runs scored. He finished as one of two qualified players in all of Double-A to hit .300 or better and one of 37 in all of Minor League Baseball to hit that mark.

ABIMELECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz ended the year on fire for the RoughRiders. In his last 48 games, Ortiz hit .321/.413/.592/1.005 with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 38 RBIs, 37 runs scored and 28 walks. After July 10th, in those 48 games, he is fourth in average (.321), first in OPS (1.005), tied for first in RBIs (38) and first in home runs (13). During that span, he leads all of Double-A in OPS as well. In his last 29 games, he batted .364 (40-for-110)/.470/.710/1.170 with five doubles, 10 home runs, 30 RBIs, 21 walks, 24 strikeouts and 27 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. Since, he hit .307 with an .954 OPS, raising his batting average to .243 and a .760 OPS. In a five-game hitting streak to end the year, Ortiz batted .524 (11-for-21)/.600/1.143/1.743 with four home runs, eight RBIs and eight runs scored, winning Texas League Player of the Week. That marked three-straight seasons that the Riders captured the Texas League Player of the Week award in the final week of the regular season: **Thomas Saggese** (2022) and **Wyatt Langford** (2023).

HOMER HAPPY:

On August 16th, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with **Luis Mieses** capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. Since then, the RoughRiders finished the season with 41 home runs in their last 27 games, with those 41 home runs being first in the Texas League over the last 27 games. Frisco finished sixth in the Texas League in home runs this season with 117 across their 138 games.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders were fantastic at home this year, going 44-24 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco had a +69 run differential, a 3.88 ERA and is averaging 5.2 runs per game with a .743 OPS. On the road, Frisco went 39-30 with a 3.46 ERA, but a +35 run differential while averaging 4.3 runs per game and owning a .695 OPS (3rd in the league). **Cody Freeman** has 10 of his 14 home runs at home while **Abimelec Ortiz** has hit 10 of his 18 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .303/.392/.524/.916 at home.

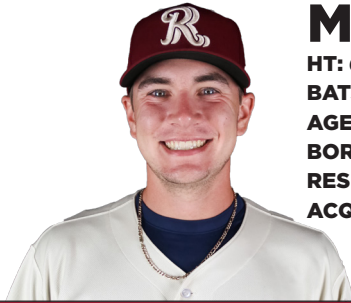

ABOUT MITCH

-During COVID-19, finding a place to throw was difficult, so he built a bullpen in the backyard of his home in Newmarket, Ontario to keep throwing. While most Canadian schools were not able to start playing baseball in 2021, Bratt made the decision to transfer to Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Georgia (outside of near Savannah). He completed his final year of high school online while playing baseball.

-After spending two months at GPA, he played in the MLB Draft League during the summer of 2021, going 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA while playing for the West Virginia Black Bears.

-*Baseball America* ranked Bratt as the No. 3 Canadian prospect going into the 2021 draft.

-Committed to play baseball at Florida State.

-Made one start for Team Canada in the 2023 World Baseball Classic as a 19-year-old against Team USA, going 0.1 IP, 3 H, 6 R, 6 ER, facing MLB All-Stars Mookie Betts, Mike Trout, Paul Goldschmidt, Nolan Arenado, Kyle Tucker, Tim Anderson and JT Realmuto.

2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.

-After tough first start of the season (3.0 IP, 8 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 0 BB, 4 K vs. JS) with Hickory, has gone 6-3 with a 2.30 ERA over his last 16 games (14 starts) with 80 strikeouts to 16 walks over 74.1 innings.

-In last 10 games in Hickory (nine starts), went 4-1 with 1.35 ERA, striking out 55 over 53.1 IP to 11 walks, holding opponents to .182 batting average.

-Dominated with Hickory while ahead in the count, allowing a .163 average and .240 slugging (as opposed to .298 average and .638 slugging when behind in the count).

-First Double-A start was 5.0 shutout innings at San Antonio on 8/1.

2023 SEASON

-Spent all of 2023 with High-A Hickory and was selected as an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star.

-Despite being 19 at the beginning of the season and turning 20 midway through the year, he ranked fifth in the South Atlantic League in ERA (3.54) among those with at least 15 starts.

-Was placed on the Injured List from 7/18-8/31 with lat tightness.

-Played under Carlos Cardoza in the 2023 Arizona Fall League with the Surprise Saguaros, going 1-0 with a 6.46 ERA over six games (one start).

2022 SEASON

-Was named an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star with Low-A Down East, entering the season as the youngest pitcher in the Carolina League at 18 years old.

-He finished the season third in ERA (2.45).

-Named the Rangers Starting Pitcher of the Month for July, going 3-1 with a 1.96 ERA.

2021 SEASON

-Bratt out 13 of 24 (54.2%) batters faced without issuing a walk over four appearances for the ACL Rangers in his professional debut.

-He recorded at least three strikeouts in each of his outings, all of which came in August or September, shortly after his 18th birthday.
