Captain's Log

NEW NAME, SAME GAME: The Lake County Captains are the High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. Cleveland officially changed their name to the Guardians on November 19, 2021.

2021 DRAFT: Five starting pitchers for the Captains' were selected in the 2021 draft. Today's starter Doug Nikhazy, the 58th overall selection, has totaled 31 innings over nine starts allowing 14 earned runs. Tommy Mace was also taken in the second round, 69th overall via a competitive balance pick. Tanner Bibee, was drafted in the fifth round as the 156th overall pick, he's amassed 44 innings allowing 12 earned runs. Aaron Davenport, was the sixth round and 186th overall pick in the 2021 draft. New addition Rodney Boone was an 8th round selection, pick number 246.

LAST TIME OUT: The Lake County Captains stranded eight runners on base, and for the second straight night left the potential tying run on base in the ninth inning, losing 2-1. Rodney Boone made his Captains debut and struck out eight TinCaps over five complete innings.

IS STAT SO?: Last night's game was the 27th game decided by two runs or less in the 54 games played by Lake County, exactly 50 percent of the 2022 season. The Captains are 9-10 in one-run games, and 4-4 in two-run contests.

CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND: Five former Lake County Captains have made their MLB debut with the Cleveland Guardians in the 2022 season.

Oscar Gonzalez: The 24-year-old made his MLB debut on May 26th against the Detroit Tigers going 2 for 4, with a single and double. Gonzalez played 114 games in the 2018 season in Lake County, posting 135 hits, 13 Home Runs and 25 doubles.

Richie Palacios: The Brooklyn born Palacios earned two singles in his first two major league at-bats on April 25th against the Angels. Palacios earned had both his mother and father in attendance. Palacios played 20 games with Lake County in 2018 and had 24 hits.

Kirk McCarty: McCarty took the hill for the first time as a Guardian on Sunday, April 24th at Yankee Stadium. He appeared in the sixth inning, going three innings, surrendering four runs but adding three strikeouts. He made 22 starts in the 2018 season as a Captain, accumulating a 4.29 ERA through 115.1 innings.

Tanner Tully: The left-hander from Elkhart, Indiana, made his MLB debut on April 22nd entering in the fifth inning against the Yankees. He went two innings allowing two hits, and one run over 38 pitches. Tully was a Captain in 2017, where he 16 appearances, eight starts and posted a 3.16 ERA over 77 innings.

Bryan Lavastida: Lavastida caught all nine innings for the Guardians in their 17-3 win over the Kansas City Royals on April 10th. He earned his first big league hit April 22nd at Yankee Stadium. Lavastida was a Captain in 2021 playing in 48 games where he batted .303/.399/.467.

LAST TIME OUT: Doug Nikhazy delivered his longest outing of the season against West Michigan. He completed five innings in his ninth start of the season. The left-hander allowed only two runs on three hits, despite issuing six walks. Nikhazy finished the fifth scoreless, getting a 5-4-3 double play to end his day.

DOUG DAY: Each start for Nikhazy at Ole Miss during the 2021 season was known as #DougDay. Nikhazy earned a program record with 12 wins and became the fourth two-time All-American in University of Mississippi history.

16 K's: On June 5, 2021, Ole Miss played Florida State in the Oxford Regional. In front of the home crowd, Nikhazy struck out 16 Seminoles, matching a school record. Ole Miss would advance to the Super Regional but lose in a three-game set to the University of Arizona.

CALLING YOUR OWN SHOTS: At the professional level, Nikhazy calls his own game instead of a coach orchestrating the decision for the next pitch. He told Mandy Bell of MLB.com "All I had to do was try and think about executing the pitch, not how I want to get ahead or out. Now you have to think about both those things at the same time while you're pitching, so it's a little bit harder."

FAMILY IN OXFORD: Nikhazy isn't the only family member affiliated with the Rebels program. His sister Amanda, is currently a graduate assistant, in the athletics department. Amanda played college softball at Stetson University in DeLand, FL. Doug and Amanda would play catch regularly growing up.
