Jersey Shore BlueClaws (20-13) vs Wilmington BlueRocks (15-15)

Heritage Financial Park – Wappingers Falls, New York (opened 1994) RHP Jean Cabrera (3-2, 2.06) vs RHP Cam Schlittler (3-0, 1.04) Series: Game 1 of 6 (first of 24 meetings this year)

Last Time Out...Zach Arnold hit a two run home run and Starlyn Castillo gave up one run in five innings as the BlueClaws topped Wilmington 4-1 on Sunday at ShoreTown Ballpark to sweep the six game series and win their 11th straight game...Justin Crawford had two hits in the win...Four BlueClaws – Andrew Baker, Trey Dillard, Charles King, and Andrew Walling - each threw a scoreless inning of relief.

State of the Claws...The BlueClaws have won 11 in a row for the first time in franchise history (final five against Bowling Green and all six against Wilmington, their first-ever sweep of a six-game series)...The BlueClaws had two previous eight-game win streaks (see below) before breaking through with their ninth straight win on Friday...They are in sole possession of first place in the SAL North at 20-13 (a season-high seven games over .500) and 1.5 games up on Greensboro.

Streaking...<u>A win today would be the BlueClaws 12th win in a row and extend their own team record (</u>they have passed Akron [AA, Guardians] for the longest win streak in MiLB this year...Hickory [A+, Rangers] had a 15-game win streak last year]...The BlueClaws had won eight straight twice previously – April 29 – May 7, 2017 (vs Kannapolis, at Charleston, at Columbia), and August 19-26, 2016 (at Delmarva, vs Greensboro, at West Virginia)...The seventh win of their 2017 win streak was Nick Fanti's first no hitter – he got 26 of 27 outs and Trevor Bettencourt got the 27th...The 2016 win streak was part of a 15-2 stretch to close the season that year.

Welcome to Wappingers Falls...The BlueClaws are in Hudson Valley for the week for six games with the Renegades...This week marks the first six of 24 meetings between the two teams this season, with the next series beginning July 9th in Lakewood...Jersey Shore beat Hudson Valley on the last day of the regular season last year to qualify for the postseason, but lost to the Renegades two games to one in the SAL Northern Division Championship Series... They are 34-50 against HV since the teams began play in 2021 as South Atlantic League rivals.

Jumpin' Jean...Jean Cabrera (pitches tonight) gave up one run over seven innings on Tuesday in the series opener, his second straight seven inning start...Since the BlueClaws moved to High-A in 2021, only Andrew Painter (2022) threw seven innings in back to back starts (Gustavo Armas in 2018 was the last BlueClaw to do so in Low-A)... Cabrera's seven inning start lat week marked the first time a BlueClaws pitcher has thrown seven innings in an April game since 2017 when Adonis Medina (April 20th) and Ranger Suarez (April 21st) did so in back to back games... It was the first 7-inning April start for a Phillies High-A pitcher since Bailey Falter on April 29th (and 23rd) with Clearwater in 2018.

Strong From the Start...BlueClaws starting pitchers lead all of High-A (30 teams) in ERA (2.53), WHIP (1.08), and Innings Pitched (163.2), 1.2 innings more than Quad Cities (Royals)...The BlueClaws starter has thrown at least five innings in 23 of their 33 games...Jean Cabrera has two seven inning starts and a six inning start while Sam Aldegheri has two six inning starts and a 6.2 inning start...Braeden Fausnaught has three six inning starts.

In This Streak...The BlueClaws are hitting .287 as a team in their 11-game winning streak with 58 runs scored...They have allowed just 22 runs (19 earned) and have a team ERA of just 1.73...They have allowed five runs in two games and three or less in the other nine (and zero or one run in seven of the 11 games).

13 for Leandro...Leandro Pineda has hit safely in 13 straight games, going 21-49, raising his average from .196 to .310 (he has tied Kendall Simmons' 13-game hitting streak last May by the longest from a High-A BlueClaw)...Between his second PA on May 7th and May 9th, he reached base in 11 straight plate appearances going 7-7 with four walks...Pineda has three home runs this year, all at ShoreTown Ballpark...He blasted nine homers with the BlueClaws last year, hitting .243 (.298 in the second half with an .852 OPS and .193 in the first half with a .607 OPS).

EB Heating Up...Erick Brito hit his first home run of the year on Thursday, and it was his first home run in 358 days

Going For 100

Manager Greg Brodzinski enters today with 93 wins as the BlueClaws manager (93-71). He took over prior to the 2023 season and went 73-58 last year.

(since May 16, 2023 with Clearwater vs Bradenton)...Brito now has four career home runs...He is 19-59 since starting the season 0-7 and already has six multi-hit games on the year ... The 21 year old (he'll turn 22 on May 25th) split last year between the BlueClaws and Clearwater, hitting a combined .238 with 29 stolen bases.

Positively Fergalicious...Cade Fergus had two hits on Friday and is 10-31 with two HRs and three SBs in his last nine games...He has two home runs on the current homestand, including a blast on Thursday night... He now has three on the season and 19 in his career... Fergus also went deep on May 3rd to break a 3-3 tie and give the BlueClaws the lead... He already has seven steals this year after he stole 14 last year between Clearwater (10) and Jersey Shore (4)... He was a 13th round pick in 2022 from George Washington University and played at St. Thomas Aquinas HS in Fort Lauderdale

Crawford on a Roll...Justin Crawford had two hits on Friday and two more on Sunday and is 13-33 since May 2nd...He had his third career four hit game on May 7th...It was the second four-hit game by a BlueClaw this year (William Bergolla on 4/6 vs ABD)... Crawford had one four hit game last year with Clearwater and one with the BlueClaws...He was the 17th overall selection in the 2022 draft (Bishop Gorman HS in Las Vegas) and is the 15th first round pick to play for the BlueClaws.

Harper Locks It Down...Daniel Harper leads the BlueClaws with four saves, picking up his fourth save of the year on Saturday...The right-hander from the University of Kentucky has 16 strikeouts in 11 innings so far this year...He had a six out save on April 25th at Aberdeen and a three out save on May 3rd and 5th against Bowling Green...Charles King and Andrew Walling each have two saves, with Walling's coming on May 8th and 12th against Wilmington.

The Runnin' Claws...The BlueClaws are fourth in the league (though they had just one last week) with 48 stolen bases this year (Aberdeen leads with 101 and Bowling Green has 69)...Justin Crawford added his team-leading 11th stolen base on May 5th...Cade Fergus is second on the team with seven and Emaarion Boyd (who stole 56 last year to lead the Florida State League with Clearwater) and and William Bergolla (who stole just two bases last year with Clearwater) have...Jersey Shore stole a season-high seven bases on April 27th at Aberdeen – including two each by Cade Fergus, William Bergolla, and Erick Brito...The seven steals is two off the club record (4/8/23 at Brooklyn and 4/8/22 vs Aberdeen)...Jersey Shore is 48-62 on the season stealing bases.

Rincon Heating Up...Bryan Rincon had two doubles on Saturday has hit safely in eight of his last nine games, over which he is 10-29 with three doubles and four walks...Rincon began the year 2-28 but since then is 13-45...Rincon joined the BlueClaws on August 16th last year with Justin Crawford and they were the 799th and 800th players to play for the BlueClaws...Rincon was a 14th round pick in 2022 from Shaler Area HS in Pittsburgh, where he went after growing up in Venezuela.

Going Going Gone ... The BlueClaws (9 HRs in Lakewood and 8 in Hickory from April 9th - 16th) got a home run from Zach Arnold on May 12th, his second of the year...They also hit two home runs on May 9th - one by Erick Brito and one by Cade Fergus... Fergus and Leandro Pineda lead the team with three home runs apiece (all of Pineda's have come at ShoreTown Ballpark)...Justin Crawford, Jordan Dissin, and Arnold, and Troy Schreffler all have two home runs on the season.

Slingin' Sam...Sam Aldegheri (28 IP, 10 H, 3 R/2 ER, 11 BBs, 35 Ks on the season) gave up one run in six innings on Wednesday to earn his third win of the year...He's allowed two earned runs in five starts over 28 innings, pitching six innings three times...The left-hander from Verona, Italy fanned 10 over five scoreless innings on April 25th in Aberdeen, joining Jean Cabrera (4/12 at Hickory) as the second BlueClaw to do that this season...They are the third and fourth BlueClaws since the team moved to High-A in 2021 to struck out at least 10 in five or fewer innings: Mitch Neunborn (5 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 10 K on 8/31/23 vs

Of the Week...Braeden Fausnaught was named SAL Pitcher of the Week for the week ending May 5th...He threw six scoreless innings on Saturday...He is the fifth SAL Pitcher of the Week winner for the BlueClaws since moving to High-A (Mitch Neunborn in 2023, Ben Brown in 2022, Tyler McKay and Kevin Gowdy in 2021).

Mayer Stronger From the Bullpen...Gunner Mayer got the last six outs of the win on Friday night, striking out five...He has moved to the bullpen this year and struck out 22 batters in 11.2 innings (22 of the 48 batters he faced)...Last year as a starter, Mayer had a 5.47 ERA with 79 strikeouts in 77.1 innings pitched...He was a 5th round pick in 2019 from San Joaquin Delta JC (CA).

Youth Is Served...Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws have five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3rd youngest), Bryan Rincon (9th), Justin Crawford (11th), Hendry Mendez (17th), and Emmaarion Boyd (21st).

In the First Round...Justin Crawford is the 15th former first round pick to play for the BlueClaws and the fourth to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A team (Andrew Painter and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 first-round pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.

Go Phils...The BlueClaws have several players that grew up Phillies fans: C Jordan Dissin (went to Malvern Prep in Philadelphia, 27 miles from Citizens Bank Park), OF Troy Schreffler (from Harrisburg), and LHP Braeden Fausnaught (from Danville and went to West Chester University).

Walk-Off This Way ... The BlueClaws had an Opening Night walk-off win when Emaarion Boyd scored on a wild pitch...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

From The Shore to the Show...123 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show including one this year (Ben Brown, Cubs)...Three debuted in 2023 - James McArthur with the Royals, Johan Rojas with the Phillies, and Orion Kerkering with the Phillies...Kerkering, who was with the BlueClaws from May 9th through July 6th, is the only player to play for the BlueClaws and Phillies in the same year.

On the Staff...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2024 after leading the BlueClaws to the playoffs and a league-best 73-58 mark in 2023...Pitching coach Brad Bergesen is in Lakewood for a third time (2018 and 2022) and is joined as a pitching coach by first-year Phillies coach Matt Ellmyer...Hitting coach Adam Lind hit 200 big league home runs and is in his first year as a coach...Position coach Orlando Munoz is in his first year with the BlueClaws after managing the DSL Phillies since 2017...Development coach Beth Greenwood is the first BlueClaws female position coach and a member of Team USA Women's National Baseball Team.
