### JUMBO SHRIMP FALL TO SOUNDS

A strong night from **Victor Mesa Jr.** wasn't enough as the Jumbo Shrimp dropped a 6-2 contest to the Sounds. **Brewer Hicklen** opened up the scoring with a solo home run in the second before adding an RBI ground out in the third. Jacksonville tied the game in their half of the third when Mesa Jr. scored on a wild pitch and **Troy Johnston** came home on a passed ball. However, **Wes Clarke's** RBI single in the fourth broke the tie and **Vinny Capra** added an RBI double in the fifth. Clarke's RBI two-bagger in the eighth capped the scoring at 6-2.

#### **BATMEN**

Heading into play on June 16, Jacksonville had mustered only 304 runs in 68 games (4.5 per game), which ranked last out of 30 Triple-A teams. The Jumbo Shrimp also placed just 20th in batting average (.254), 25th in OBP (.337), 24th in slugging (.409) and 24th in OPS (.746) in the first 68 games of the season. Jacksonville has registered at least nine hits in eight of their last 11 games, sparking an offensive resurgence from the club. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A in batting average (.304) and rank second in hits (117), 10th in OBP (.363), 12th in SLG (.473), 12th in OPS (.836) while scoring runs (57, 5.2 per game).

### GET PITCH OR DIF TRYIN'

Jacksonville has won 12 of their last 19 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 14 of those 19 affairs. Since this run began on June 7, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A in runs allowed (65) and ERA (3.02) while ranking third in batting average against (.238), OPS against (.705) and WHIP (1.33) and fifth in hits allowed (152).

### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 52 of Jacksonville's 79 games (65.8 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 13 of the club's last 17 contests and eight of the last 10. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 25 of its last 37 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 24-28 (.462) in these affairs.

#### STARTING FROM SCRATCH

Somewhat incredibly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded three earned runs or fewer in 17 of the last 18 games, with 15 of those starts resulting in two earned runs or fewer charged to a Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifter, and eight being scoreless. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers have ceded only 24 runs, 20 earned, on 60 hits (7.6 H/9) in 71.1 innings for a 2.52 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 68 strikeouts (8.6 K/9) against 33 walks (4.2 BB/9) during this stretch.

#### LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 41 of his last 46 games, notching 19 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 64-for-185 (.346/.404/.492/.896) at the plate with 15 doubles, three triples, two home runs, 31 RBIs, 20 walks and 25 runs.

### GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder **Griffin Conine** suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 44 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 49-for-his-last-152, slashing .322/.397/.645/1.042 with 11 doubles, one triple, 12 home runs, 33 RBIs, 20 walks and 29 runs scored. Among the 121 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks 11th in HR/FB (26.8 percent). On the season, the 26-year-old ranks tied for fifth in the International League in extra-base hits (32), tied for 12th in home runs (15), 15th in slugging percentage (.541), 17th in OPS (.908), tied for 17th in doubles (16) and tied for 21st in hits (68).

### SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp have won only one home series all season, when they took four out of six from Norfolk from April 16-21. They will need to win both Saturday and Sunday to take this series from the Sounds. Jacksonville is 1-4-2 in their home sets this season... Over his last 30 games, **Troy Johnston** is hitting .351/.413/.550/.963 with six doubles, two triples, four home runs, 15 RBIs, 11 walks and 23 runs scored.

### **ABOUT SHAUN**

-A native of Coral Springs, Fla., Anderson was originally selected by the Washington Nationals in the 40th round of the 2013 draft out of American Heritage High School (Plantation, Fla.). After a three-year career at the University of Florida in which he garnered All-America honors, Anderson was picked by the Boston Red Sox in the third round of the 2016 draft.

-Anderson made his major league debut for the San Francisco Giants on May 15, 2019 against the Toronto Blue Jays at Oracle Park. He went 5.0 innings and yielded three runs, two earned, on two hits with five strikeouts against three walks. Texas dealt him to Miami on May 30 in exchange for cash considerations. The Marlins optioned him to Jacksonville that day.

### 2023 SEASON

-Anderson began the year by pitching in the Korean Baseball Organization with the KIA Tigers. He went 4-7 with a 3.76 ERA in 14 starts (79.0 IP, 76 H, 42 R, 33 ER, 26 BB, 64 K before signing a minor league deal with the Philadelphia Phillies on July 20. He pitched the remainder of the season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley, and actually pitched against Jacksonville on August 18 with 5.0 innings of three-run ball at Coca-Cola Park.
