NOTES AND NUGGETS

DOUBLE THE TROUBLE

Today, the Storm Chasers play a doubleheader against Indianapolis, Omaha's third twin-bill of 2026 and the Indians' second.

- The Storm Chasers previously split a doubleheader at home with Buffalo on Saturday, April 4 and swept a doubleheader at Iowa on Friday, April 10 ... this is Omaha's 5th doubleheader against Indianapolis since 2021 and the 4th played at Victory Field.
- This is the Storm Chasers' 3rd doubleheader in the team's first 34 games, the earliest in the season the Chasers have played 3 doubleheaders since playing 3 in April 2018.
- In the Modern Omaha Era (since 2005), Omaha is 104-118 in doubleheader games ... last year, the Chasers were swept twice and split once over 3 doubleheaders, after playing 7 in 2024 and just 1 in 2023.

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

The Storm Chasers opened the 2026 season 0-4, then won 3 straight series, but Omaha enters this week having lost back-to-back series.

- After suffering a season-opening weekend sweep in Louisville, the Storm Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, with series wins over Buffalo, Iowa and Indianapolis ... Omaha proceeded to lose 7 straight games, from April 22 to 29 ... since April 22, the Chasers are 2-9.
- Last Thursday's losing-streak snapping win over Louisville gave Omaha a winning month of April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... last year, Omaha had one winning month, going 15-11 in August.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by one of the league's best baserunners.

- Omaha's 84.8% stolen base rate (39-for-46) ranks 1st in the International League, 2nd at the Triple-A level (1st: Sacramento, 87.5%) and is 16th among the 120 full-season Minor League teams.
- John Rave** leads Omaha and is tied 10th in the International League in steals (10), while **Gavin Cross** has 7 steals and **Kameron Misner** has swiped 6 bags ... Cross and Misner are 2 of 4 Storm Chasers who have stolen multiple bases without being caught.

PITCH, PLEASE

A constant in 2026 has been Omaha's ability to go deep in plate appearances.

- The Storm Chasers are seeing 4.044 pitches per plate appearance, 3rd-most in the International League and 6th at the Triple-A level.
- Among 349 Triple-A players with 50+ plate appearances this year, **Kameron Misner** ranks 5th in pitches seen/PA (4.516) while **John Rave** ranks 10th (4.457).

VICTORY FIELD SCREECH

The Chasers have seen more success in recent years against Indianapolis than any other International League club, with a 57-32 record in 89 games since 2021 and have especially thrived against the Indians in the Circle City itself.

- A .640 winning percentage vs. Indianapolis is Omaha's best among the 7 opponents the Chasers have seen at least 20 times since 2021 ... among 54 IL matchups that have happened at least 20 times since 2021, Omaha's .640 winning percentage against Indianapolis is the 3rd-best.
- Since 2021, Omaha and Indianapolis have played 16 series, with 10 going 6+ games ... Omaha has won 11 of 17 (including 7 of the last 9), while Indy has won 3.
- Since 2023, Omaha has won 21 of 27 games at Victory Field (.778 winning percentage) - tied for the most wins Omaha has at an opposing venue in that timeframe ... the .778 winning % at Victory Field since 2023 is tied for the highest among all Minor League teams with 24+ games as the visiting team at a stadium.

CAUGHT CLEAN-HANDED

The Storm Chasers are tied for the 7th-best fielding percentage in the International League with a .980 mark (1st: Louisville & Rochester, .986), committing just 22 errors in 32 games.

- The clean play extends throughout the roster - 6 of Omaha's 14 qualified fielders (min. 60.0 inn.) have a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage, led by **Kameron Misner** in the outfield (.234.1 innings) and **Kevin Newman** in the infield (183.0 innings).
- Omaha's 35 double plays turned are tied for the most of any Minor League team ... 4 Storm Chasers infielders have participated in 10 or more double plays, led by **Abraham Toro**'s 23, tied for the 3rd-most of any Minor League player.

TODAY'S START

- Ryan Ramsey is making his **6th start** with the Storm Chasers this year and his **7th appearance** of the season with Omaha.
- Playing his **5th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.
- This is Ramsey's 3rd career start against Indianapolis ... he made his Triple-A debut against the Indians on May 1, 2025, with 4 runs allowed over 3.1 innings ... he also pitched against Indy on April 17 this year.

RECENT FORM

- STARTER'S ORDERS:** Ramsey made just two spot starts last year for Omaha, but cracked the Storm Chasers' Opening Day roster ... in 2025, just 8 of his first 13 appearances were starts, while 4 of his first 5 appearances this year have been starts.
- DOUBLE THE TROUBLE:** Ramsey has had 11 double plays turned behind him this season, the most of any pitcher between the Majors and Minor Leagues ... he's had 2 starts without a single double play turned behind him, but 4 appearances with 2+ double plays turned on the ground, including 3 double plays on April 5 vs. Buffalo, April 17 vs. Indianapolis and April 30 vs. Louisville.

LAST OUTING: THURSDAY, APRIL 30 VS. LOUISVILLE

- In his 5th start of the season, opened the game with a scoreless inning, working around a walk ... a walk, 3 singles and a sac fly scored a pair of runs in the 2nd ... finished his day with 3.0 more scoreless innings, with double plays getting him out of the 3rd and 4th inning, plus a double play for the first 2 outs of the 5th inning ... tied a season-high with 4 walks, 5.0 innings and 21 batters faced.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 1 Cactus League game with the Royals while up from Minor League camp, working 1.0 scoreless inning ... opened the 2026 season on the Storm Chasers' roster.
- Worked 5.0 innings of 1-run relief on April 5 vs. Buffalo (TOR), 1 out shy of tying his longest career relief appearance.

CAREER NOTES

- Began the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA) and spent most of the year in Double-A, also making a pair of spot starts for Omaha ... posted a 5.54 ERA (65 ER in 105.2 IP) in 25 appearances (18 starts) at Double-A ... his 114 total strikeouts ranked tied with Shane Panzini for the Royals organization lead.
- Pitched to a 3.73 ERA (17 ER in 41.0 IP) over his first 9 appearances (7 starts) from April 9 to May 31 which included a 5.2-inning, 5-strikeout, scoreless performance May 18 @ Tulsa (LAD).
- Made his first Double-A start on April 15 @ San Antonio (SD), throwing 5.2 innings of no-hit ball to start what became the fourth no-hitter in Nationals history ... relievers Chazz Martinez, Ryan Brady & Brandon Johnson finished it off ... was NWA's third combined no-no, the club's first no-hitter since 2013.
- Was transferred to Omaha on April 30 and made his Triple-A debut on May 1 vs. Indianapolis (PIT) ... returned to the Nationals on May 2 and returned to Omaha for a start on September 19 @ Columbus (CLE).

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

- Spent the entire 2024 season with Quad Cities (A+), splitting time between the bullpen and as a starter ... appeared in 22 games (11 starts) with a 2.43 ERA (24 ER in 89.0 IP) and 97 strikeouts to 30 walks (3.23 K/BB) at High-A ... had a career-high 25.2-inning scoreless streak from July 25 to August 27, the River Bandits' longest scoreless streak in their Royals-affiliate era (since 2021).
- Largely split 2023 between Columbia (A) and Quad Cities (A+), but also made 2 rehab appearances (1 start) with the ACL Royals (R) ... pitched to a 0.54 ERA (2 ER in 33.1 IP) with 38 strikeouts across 7 starts with Columbia before earning a promotion to Quad Cities ... made 5 appearances (2 starts) at High-A with 22 strikeouts in 14.1 innings (13.8 K/9) ... set a Fireflies record with a 24.0-inning scoreless streak from April 21 to July 29, spanning 5 outings and stints on the Development List and Injured List.
- Made his professional debut in 2022 with the ACL Royals (Rk) after Kansas City drafted him in the 13th round of the 2022 MLB Draft ... pitched in 1 game in the ACL that season.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Pitched 3 seasons (2020-22) for the University of Maryland (Big Ten), working a career 17-2 record with a 3.13 ERA (47 ER in 135.0 IP) and 140 strikeouts to 58 walks (2.41 K/BB) for the Terrapins ... named 2022 First Team All-Big Ten and 2021 Second Team All-Big Ten ... in 2022, went 11-1 with a 3.22 ERA (33 ER in 92.1 IP) and 90 strikeouts to 41 walks (2.20 K/BB) across 16 appearances (15 starts).
- Threw a 9.0-inning perfect game for the University of Maryland on April 29, 2022 against Northwestern.
- Was drafted by Cleveland in the 36th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Pascack Hills High School but elected not to sign and instead attend the University of Maryland.
