Today: It's a Capital City Market Kids Day, featuring in-game entertainment, post-game Kids Run the Bases and an Extra Inning of free ice cream and music with Big Lug across Michigan Avenue at Capital City Market, as the Lugnuts close out a 13-day, 12-game homestand with the finale of a six-game series against the Dayton Dragons. Dayton has won four of the first five games in the series including each of the last two nights.

Starting Matchup: The A's 19th round selection in 2021 from the University of Michigan, right-hander Blake Beers, makes his sixth appearance and second start start for Lansing. Dayton counters with right-hander José Acuña, who was acquired with teenage second baseman Hector Rodriguez from the New York Mets for Tyler Naquin and Triple-A pitcher Philip Diehl on July 28, 2022.

Last Night: Dragons 11, Lugnuts 0. Ruben Ibarra, Blake Dunn and Jack Rogers each homered to support the combined two-hit efforts of Julian Aguiar, Brooks Crawford and Vin Timpanelli, helping Dayton clinch a series victory. Sahid Valenzuela supplied both hits in defeat with singles in the first and fourth innings, and Nuts pitchers set a new single game high in 2023 with 16 strikeouts: six from starter Jacob Watters in four innings, five by Kumar Nambiar in two innings, four by John Beller in 1 2/3 innings and one by Mac Lardner in 1 1/3 innings.

On the Air: Today's game is available on Bally Live, MiLB TV and StreamGuys with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Zach Surdenik on the call.

On Deck: Dayton heads out to Peoria, the Lugnuts travel to West Michigan, and the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) postseason baseball tournament takes over Jackson Field.

Lug•Notes

Roster Transactions: The Lugnuts placed pitcher Joelvis Del Rosario and infielder Joshwan Wright on the Injured List yesterday. No corresponding moves were made, leaving Lansing's active roster at 28 players.

Sunday Vibes: The Nuts are 4-2 on Sundays this year, their most wins of any day of the week. This has been achieved mainly through pitching: the Nuts have a 2.80 ERA on Sunday, limiting the opposition to a .190 average.

Fanning the Dragons' Flames: Lansing pitchers have struck out 54 Dragons this series in five games, including 16 yesterday, compared to 39 Lugnuts strikeouts. On the other hand, Dayton has outhomered the Lugnuts 7-0.

West Texas Classic: In yesterday's Midland 5-4 victory over Frisco, the Double-A RockHounds turned a triple play in the top of the ninth (a diving catch on a sacrifice bunt attempt by pitcher Chase Cohen, starting a 1-6-3 triple play) and then walked off in the bottom of the tenth on an RBI single from Darell Hernaiz, plating 2021-2022 Lugnuts outfielder Lawrence Butler. Promoted 2023 Lugnuts outfielder Lazaro Armenteros went 2-for-3 with two singles and an HBP.

Master Noda: 1B Ryan Noda, a member of the 2018 Lugnuts who was the A's December Rule 5 selection from the Dodgers' system, went 2-for-3 yesterday with a double, a triple and two HBPs in the A's 5-4 victory at Kansas City. Noda is now slashing .263/.427/.488 in his rookie season, including a .385/.556/.769 mark in May.

Streak Snapped, Extended: C Daniel Susac's seven-game hitting streak ended with an 0-for-3 yesterday, though Susac did draw a walk to reach base in his eighth straight game (12-for-28, three walks, .429 average, .484 on-base percentage). Susac is hitting .389 (14-for-36) this homestand with four walks, raising his average from .180 to .267.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and Alexander Campos (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: When Henderson Álvarez was on the mound, magical things had a way of happening. On this day, the 19-year-old fired a nine-inning complete game against Peoria in two hours and one minute, allowing four hits, one walk, one run, and one strikeout in a Lugnuts 4-1 victory.

2010: The Lugnuts collected seven doubles and one triple – The Great Balbino Fuenmayor had two doubles and one triple by himself – in a 9-4 victory at Fort Wayne. No. 9 hitter Chris Hopkins led a 16-hit attack by going 4-for-5 with a steal. Chad Jenkins tossed seven innings.

2011: Lake County built a 6-0 lead with a run in the 1st, a run in the 2nd and four runs in the 3rd, but the Lugnuts responded with seven unanswered (two in the 3rd and five in the 7th) for a 7-6 victory.

Draft Day: Signed for \$40,000 as the 578th pick in the 2021 draft... signing scout: Rich Sparks, the 2006 Dick Bogard Scout of the Year, who scouts Indiana/Kentucky/Michigan/Ohio and also signed Braves catcher Sean Murphy, Lugnuts starter Jack Perkins and former Lugnuts Marty Bechina, Jeff Criswell, Max Schuemann and Jack Weisenburger... third Michigan Wolverine drafted in 2021, following southpaw Steven Hajjar (2nd round, Minnesota) and shortstop Benjamin Sems (15th round, Colorado).

What's in a Name? Besides Seth Beer, pitcher Clarence Beers saw action in one game in relief in 1948 for St. Louis... middle name of Ausweger is Blake's mother's maiden name.

Hometown: Manhattan Beach is in southwestern Los Angeles County, bordering the Pacific Ocean, with a beach stretching over two miles... motto: "Sun, Sand, Sea"... city name was decided by coin flip, with landowners George Peck and John Merrill arguing between the names Shore Acres and Manhattan; they flipped to decide the name, and Manhattan won... the postmaster added "Beach" to the end to differentiate it.

Glory Days: Attended Loyola High School (the "Cubs"), a private all-boys Roman Catholic prep school in Los Angeles that first opened in 1865... Loyola also produced Royals broadcaster Ryan Lefebvre, volleyball great Sinjin Smith, linebacker Anthony Barr, and New York Giants outfielder Fred Snodgrass, who played with Christy Mathewson on John McGraw's powerful Giants teams... Beers distinguished himself at Loyola, named a 2017 Perfect Game First Team All-State, First Team All-Region and Third Team All-American.
