RHP's Austin Peterson and Trenton Denholm are the first Captains pitchers with 36+ strikeouts and 3-or-fewer walks through the team's first 30 games of the season since 2005. The duo is tied for 4<sup>th</sup> in Minor League Baseball with a 12.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

The Captains' +43 run differential is the highest in the Midwest League, and the 6<sup>th</sup>-highest in all of Minor League Baseball.

In Friday's 8-0 Game 1 win, Nate Furman became the first Captain to hit 2 homers in a game since current Captains OF Jorge Burgos hit a pair on 5/30/2023 vs. Quad Cities, which included Lake County's most recent walk-off home run and only one of the 2023 season.

### CAPTAINS LOG

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Captains split their 7-inning twin bill against the Dragons on Friday at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake, winning their 6<sup>th</sup> straight game 8-0 in Game 1, and losing 7-2 in Game 2.

**GAME 1:** RHP Trenton Denholm pitched his first career Minor League complete game shutout to earn his 3<sup>rd</sup> win of the year.

On the 1st pitch in the bottom of the 1st, 2B Nate Furman homered to jolt the Captains in front 1-0. In the bottom of the 4<sup>th</sup>, After a sacrifice fly by SS Jose Devers, MLB Pipeline's No. 19 Cleveland prospect, and an RBI single by RF Angel Zarate, Furman then hit a 3-run bomb for his 1st career Minor League multi-home run game.

**DENHOLM'S DOMINANCE:** Denholm threw the first 7-inning complete game shutout by a Captain since RHP Aaron Davenport threw one at Great Lakes on 9/4/2022 in Game 1 of a doubleheader. It was Denholm's first complete game shutout since 4/7/2019, when he blanked Long Beach State in 9 innings while at UC Irvine.

**KAYFUS KRUSHES:** In Game 1, 1B C.J. Kayfus hit a solo home run in the bottom of the 6<sup>th</sup> inning, homering in his 3<sup>rd</sup> straight game. Kayfus became the first Captain to homer in 3 straight games since OF Johnathan Rodriguez homered in 3 consecutive contests from 8/12-8/14/2022.

**GAME 2:** The Dragons won their 1<sup>st</sup> game of the series 7-2, anchored by a 4-run 4<sup>th</sup> inning.

For Lake County, CF Jonah Advincula doubled in a run, and LF C.J. Kayfus drove in his team-best 27<sup>th</sup> run of the year on an RBI groundout.

**2-OUT HITTING:** In 4 games versus Dayton this week, 15 of Lake County's 23 runs have been scored with 2 outs. **The Captains' .278 batting average with 2 outs this season is the best of any team between High-A and MLB.**

**21<sup>ST</sup> SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL:** 2024 marks the 21<sup>st</sup> season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,765 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,392-1,373 (.503).

**WINNING WAVES:** The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

### TRENDS & NOTABLES

**FURMANATOR 2: JUDGEMENT DAY:** In the 8-0 Game 1 win on Friday, INF Nate Furman homered twice for his first Minor League multi-home run game. This was Furman's first career multi-HR game after 130 Minor League games, 94 college games, and 84 collegiate summer games. **After not hitting a home run in his first 115 MiLB games, Furman has slugged 3 in his last 15 games.**

**AN OFFENSIVE RENAISSANCE:** Lake County's 151 runs through 31 games are its most since 2019 when they scored 153. The 2019 team was 74-64, and featured current Guardians Bo Naylor and Tim Herrin, as well as current Major Leaguers Will Benson (CIN) and José Ferrín (STL).

**THAT'S OUR GUY:** Since April 30 vs. Fort Wayne, OF Guy Lipscomb is batting .455 (15-for-33) in 9 games, which is the 3<sup>rd</sup> best mark in the Midwest League during that span. Lipscomb's 8-game hitting streak, the 3<sup>rd</sup>-longest by a Captain this year, ended in their Game 2 loss on Friday.

**TOP QUALITY:** Through 31 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded 10 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs), which are the most in High-A. RHPs Carter Spivey, Austin Peterson, and Trenton Denholm have each recorded 3.

**BASH BROS 2.0:** Captains INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, and INF/OF C.J. Kayfus have been the MWL's premier slugging tandem. The duo has accounted for 32.1% of Lake County's run production, while hitting 12 of the team's 26 home runs.

**STRONG STARTING PITCHING:** Lake County's starting pitching staff has been one of the premier units in the Midwest League so far this season. The group ranks top-5 in the Midwest League in fewest walks (33, 1<sup>st</sup>), wins (12, 1<sup>st</sup>), strikeouts (154, 1<sup>st</sup>), WHIP (1.12, 2<sup>nd</sup>) innings pitched (149.0, 2<sup>nd</sup>), and ERA (3.32, 4<sup>th</sup>).

**IF I COULD BE LIKE MAICK:** In Saturday's double-header, INF Maick Collado extended his on-base streak to 18, the longest by a Captain this year. His 18-game stretch is the 2<sup>nd</sup>-longest active streak in the Midwest League, trailing only South Bend's Yohendrick Pinango (24). Collado's streak is the longest by a Captain since Dayan Frias reached base in 19 straight games from 7/7/2023 to 8/1/2023.

**PLENTY OF '23 IN LC:** 6 players on the Captains' current active roster were selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the 2023 MLB Draft. INF/OF C.J. Kayfus was drafted in Round 3, C Cooper Ingle in Round 4, INF Alex Mooney in Round 7, OF Jonah Advincula in Round 8, RHP Jay Driver in Round 9, and RHP Zane Morehouse in Round 14.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Austin Peterson (4-1) made his 2<sup>nd</sup> start in 6 days against Fort Wayne, earning his 4<sup>th</sup> win of the season. He pitched 6 shutout innings, allowing just 3 hits and fanning 3 in the 6-0 win. Peterson only threw 64 pitches (48 strikes), all while retiring the side in order 3 times.

**CAPTAIN OF THE WEEK:** Peterson was named the third-ever Captain of the Week, presented by Official League, this past Monday. He went 1-0 in two starts against Fort Wayne, pitching a combined 13.2 scoreless innings, allowing just 7 hits and 1 walk, and throwing 9 strikeouts in 150 pitches (115 strikes). Peterson's 13.2 shutout frames were the most from a pitcher across Minor League and Major League Baseball from April 30 through May 5.

**QUALITY CONTROL:** Last series versus Fort Wayne, Peterson was 1 of 4 pitchers across Minor and Major League Baseball with 2 quality starts in that span.

**OFF TO A STELLAR HIGH-A START:** Through his first 6 High-A starts, Peterson ranks top-5 in the Midwest League in innings pitched (34.2, 1<sup>st</sup>), ERA (2.08, 2<sup>nd</sup>), wins (4, tied for 2<sup>nd</sup>), WHIP (0.87, 3<sup>rd</sup>), strikeouts (36, tied for 4<sup>th</sup>), and win percentage (.800, 5<sup>th</sup>). He also ranks 10<sup>th</sup> in the league in opposing batting average (.216).

**2023 IN REVIEW:** Peterson made 24 starts with Single-A Lynchburg last season, which were tied for the most in the Carolina League with RHP and fellow Hillcat Alonzo Richardson, as well as Charleston RiverDogs (TB) RHP Marcus Johnson. Peterson recorded 4 quality starts, which were tied for the third-most in the Carolina League.

**THE GREAT EIGHT:** In 2023, Peterson posted 2 starts of 8 shutout innings on June 30 versus the Delmarva Shorebirds (BAL) and July 21 versus the Fayetteville Woodpeckers (HOU). He threw just 83 and 84 pitches, respectively, in these starts, retiring 48 of a combined 55 batters faced.

**A STAR IN STORRS:** After making 25 appearances at Purdue in 2019 and 5 appearances at Wabash Valley Community College (IL) in 2020, Peterson was a two-time All-Big East pitcher at UConn. In just two seasons with the Huskies, he struck out 226 batters, tied for the sixth-most in program history. In 2022, the right-hander was named a 1<sup>st</sup> Team NCBWA All-American, NCBWA District Co-Player of the Year, New England Pitcher of the Year, and 1<sup>st</sup> Team All-Big East. In his final year with the Huskies, Peterson struck out a program-record 147 batters, the third-most in the country. He also went 8+ innings in three starts. In 2021, Peterson was named 2<sup>nd</sup> Team All-Big East, ranking fourth in the conference with a 2.58 ERA, and leading the conference with 33 strikeouts looking.

**BOILERMAKER BEGINNINGS:** Peterson began his college career at Purdue, where he led its freshman class with 49 strikeouts, 25 appearances, and 48.0 innings pitched. He earned his first college victory on March 9, 2019, pitching a season-high 5.1 innings of relief and fanning a then-career-best 9 batters in the 9-8 win.
