YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Yard Goats, 7-0. It was the ninth shutout win of the year for Richmond, which leads the Eastern League. **Charlie McDaniel** threw 6.2 scoreless innings and struck out five. **Mitch White** and **Manuel Mercedes** covered the final 2.1 innings. **Jean Carlos Sio** hit a three-run homer in the bottom of the second to open the scoring. In the bottom of the fifth, **Dakota Jordan** hit a two-run double and scored on a single by **Sabin Ceballos** for a 6-0 lead. **Jack Payton** hit an RBI double in the bottom of the eighth.

POSTSEASON BOUND: The June 12 win clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division title for the Flying Squirrels, locking in a postseason berth. The Flying Squirrels will play the second-half division champion in the Division Series. Game 1 will be at the home of the second-half champion on Tues., Sept. 15. Game 2 and, if necessary, Game 3 will be at CarMax Park on Thurs., Sept. 17 and Sat., Sept. 18. If Richmond advances to the EL Championship Series, Game 1 will be at CarMax Park on Sun., Sept. 20. This year marks the fifth postseason appearance in franchise history and the first since 2023.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels continue a nine-game homestand with the fifth of six games against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. Richmond won four-of-five in Hartford from April 14-18 and the series finale on April 19 was canceled. This series is the first of three consecutive home sets for Richmond against opponents from the Northeast Division.

RECORD YEAR: The Flying Squirrels' 10-game win streak from April 4-15 was the longest in franchise history, surpassing an eight-game win streak from May 5-13, 2021, also beginning with the second game of the season. The 56-36 record is the best in team history through 82 games, passing a 55-37 record in 2014. Richmond has won seven series, split six and lost three so far this year. After opening the season with a 27-7 record through May 13, the Flying Squirrels are 29-29 in their last 58 games since.

RELENTLESS: In their 56 wins this year, the Flying Squirrels have come from behind in 28 of them. In 18 of the wins, Richmond has taken the lead in the eighth inning or later. The Flying Squirrels have 10 walk-off wins at CarMax Park this season, including at least one in each home series. **Diego Velasquez** has three walk-off hits this year, all in 10th innings. **Drew Cavanaugh**, **Parks Harber** and **Dayson Croes** each have two walk-off winners this year. Richmond has three wins after trailing by five-or-more runs this season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS won the Southwest Division first-half title by seven games over second-place Erie and has the Eastern League's best overall record this season. Richmond leads all 30 Double-A teams in batting average (.270) and sacrifice flies (38) this season and ranks second in hits (830) and doubles (177). The team has combined for 99 homers this year, surpassing 11 of the franchise's previous 15 season totals. The Flying Squirrels are on pace to set offensive single-season franchise records for batting average, runs, total bases, doubles, RBIs, stolen bases, OBP, SLG, OPS, sacrifice flies and hit by pitches. The Richmond pitching staff has thrown nine shutouts this season, which is the most in the Eastern League and tied for second in Double-A. At 33-15, the Flying Squirrels have the second-best home record in MiLB this season, trailing only High-A Bowling Green (36-9).

THE YARD GOATS won the Northeast Division's first-half title with a 39-29 record, 2.5 games ahead of second-place Somerset. The Yard Goats will appear in the Eastern League playoffs for the second time in franchise history and the second time in the last three seasons. Hartford's roster features four players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Rockies prospects, including RHP Jackson Cox (No. 8), LHP Griffin Herring (No. 12), 2B Roc Riggio (No. 15) and C Cole Messina (No. 23). MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects list features five Hartford players, including Herring (No. 9), Riggio (No. 10), Cox (No. 19), Messina (No. 21) and LHP Konner Eaton (No. 25).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Tyler Switalski** makes his third Double-A start. He made his CarMax Park debut on Sunday against the SeaWolves and threw two scoreless innings before allowing five runs in the third. He made his Double-A debut on July 11 in Altoona, he surrendered five runs over four innings in a loss. He began the season with High-A Eugene and went 2-5 with a 4.22 ERA in 16 outings (15 starts). At the time of his promotion, he was leading the Northwest League in strikeouts (94) and innings pitched (74.2). In his last start on Sunday for Eugene at Vancouver, he allowed five runs (four earned) over 3.1 innings. Over his previous six starts from May 30-June 30, Switalski posted a 3.66 ERA (13 ER/32.0 IP) with 42 strikeouts. Switalski pitched two seasons at Gardner-Webb University in North Carolina and was named Second-Team All-Big South as a sophomore in 2023. He transferred to West Virginia University for the 2024 season and was selected by the Giants that year in the 16th round of the MLB Draft. **For more on Switalski, see page two.**

FOR HARTFORD: Left-hander Stu Flesland III makes his fourth Double-A start and 10th Double-A appearance. He last pitched last Saturday and threw five hitless innings with four strikeouts in Bowie. In July, Flesland has made three starts without allowing a run, holding opponents to two hits over 11 innings. He started the season with High-A Spokane in his hometown and went 2-1 with a 3.63 ERA in five appearances, also throwing two outings for Triple-A Albuquerque. He was assigned to Double-A Hartford on May 19. Flesland was selected in the 11th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of Washington.

THE NEW GUYS: The Flying Squirrels added three players from High-A Eugene last week for their Double-A debuts: **Gavin Kilen**, **Dakota Jordan** and **Trevor Cohen**. Kilen, who was the 13th-overall pick in last summer's MLB Draft, was leading the Northwest League in doubles (27) and also ranked tied for second in extra-base hits (37), fourth in total bases (144), tied for fourth in hits (88), eighth in batting average (.282) and tied for eighth in runs scored (49). Jordan led the Northwest League in RBIs (66), extra-base hits (41) and total bases (171) and ranked tied for first in homers (18), second in SLG (.533), second in hits (93), third in doubles (22), fifth in batting average (.290), fifth in OPS (.879) and seventh in runs (50). Cohen led the league in hits (97) and runs (72) and ranked second in doubles (26), third in stolen bases (26), fourth in batting average (.297), tied for fourth in walks (48), sixth in total bases (136), seventh in extra-base hits (31) and eighth in OBP (.387). **Jancel Villarroel** joined the Flying Squirrels from Eugene this week and had an RBI single in his Double-A debut on Tuesday.

GO, DIEGO, GO! In his last 17 games since June 28, **Diego Velasquez** is batting .456 (26-for-57) with a homer, four doubles, 10 walks, eight RBIs and four stolen bases. Since joining the Flying Squirrels in July 2024, Velasquez has played 248 games. In Richmond's franchise history, Velasquez ranks second in sacrifices (19), third in walks (121), third in OBP (.376, min. 400 PA), tied for fourth in stolen bases (40) and sixth in hits (244). This month, he ranks 10th in MiLB in OBP (.525) and ranks fifth in batting average (.442), which leads the Eastern League.

JACK ATTACK: In his last 30 games since June 5, **Jack Payton** is batting .352 (37-for-105) with a homer, five doubles, a triple, 10 RBIs, 10 walks and 13 runs scored. He has 10 multi-hit performances in his last 27 games dating back to June 9, including seven two-hit games and three three-hit games.

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 316 wins in his career, which is a franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23, 2025. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship. Of Richmond managers since 1954, Pelfrey is second in wins behind Eddie Haas (1968, 1981-84), who had 351 wins.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Diego Velasquez** is fourth in batting average (.304) and fifth in OBP (.394). **Bo Davidson** is tied for third in homers (19), sixth in RBIs (54) and eighth in SLG (.521). **Parks Harber** is tied for seventh in doubles (20), ninth in batting average (.284) and ninth in OPS (.879). **Jonah Cox** is first in triples (5) and sixth in stolen bases (27). **Tyler Vogel** is first in saves (13). **Trystan Vrieling** is first in shutouts (1), tied for first in complete games (1), sixth in ERA (4.13) and fourth in BAA (.233). **Cesar Perdomo** is eighth in strikeouts (89).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features five players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Dakota Jordan** (No. 7), **Gavin Kilen** (No. 8), **Trevor Cohen** (No. 9), **Yunior Marte** (No. 19) and **Diego Velasquez** (No. 29). **Adrián Sugastey** is rated by Baseball America as the top defensive catcher in the Giants organization. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including Kilen (No. 4), Jordan (No. 5), Cohen (No. 8), **Maui Ahuna** (No. 18) and Marte (No. 25).

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1966: The Richmond Braves beat the Atlanta Braves, 5-3, in an exhibition game at Parker Field Richmond pitchers Jim Britton, Phil Niekro and Jay Ritchie held Atlanta to six hits. Gene Oliver, replacing Joe Torre at catcher, hit a two-run homer in the sixth to give Atlanta a 3-2 lead. In the bottom of the seventh, Alomar led off with a homer to tie the score. Later in the inning, John Herrnstein hit a go-ahead, two-out double and scored on an error for a 5-3 Richmond lead. Hank Aaron lined out twice to center. Eddie Mathews went 1-for-3. **1967:** The Richmond Braves beat the Rochester Red Wings, 5-4, at Parker Field. In the bottom of the 11th, Bobby Cox hit a solo homer over the left field fence to win the game for Richmond.
