Yesterday: Loons 4, Lugnuts 2. Right fielder Bubba Alleyne went 2-for-2 with a two-run double and a two-run triple, and Great Lakes held off the Lugnuts to triumph on Sunday in front of 1.858 at Dow Diamond.

One Base at a Time: The Lugnuts have 37 hits in this series: five extra-base hits and 32 singles. Meanwhile, the Loons collected two more doubles yesterday, giving them 14 doubles in the series.

Start Your Engines: This series features the two clubs with the most stolen bases in the Midwest League, with 116 steals for Great Lakes and 111 steals for the Lugnuts. Last night, the Lugnuts went 2-for-2, giving them 10 steals in 10 attempts in the series, while the Loons were successful in three of four attempts, giving them 11 steals in 15 attempts through four games.

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts' defense continues to lead the league with 69 double plays this year, eight more than second-place South Bend and 34 more than 12th-place Lake County. The Nuts' 53 errors ranks second lowest in the circuit, with only two errors in the last eight games and 36 errorless games this season. In their seven-game season series, Great Lakes has committed 12 errors to the Nuts' four.

The Future is Now: 2022 Lugnuts stars Tyler Soderstrom and Lawrence Butler will play in the Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game, Soderstrom's second time appearing in the Futures Game (2021). 2022 Lugnuts outfielder Denzel Clarke, currently in Double-A Midland with Butler, played in last year's Futures Game, joining Ángel Perdomo (2016), Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. (2017) as active Nuts to play in the event.

All-Star Nuts: 2017 Lugnuts standouts Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. were named All-Star reserves to the American League squad yesterday. It is Guerrero's third consecutive All-Star Game appearance and Bichette's second All-Star nod, joining 2021.

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, Jack Winkler went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and Ryan Gold (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: In front of a sellout crowd of 6,057 at Dow Diamond, the Loons rallied to force extra innings with two runs in the bottom of the 9th, and then walked off in the 12th on a Dee Gordon two-run homer off Dustin Antolin, 5-3. Great Lakes starter Nathan Eovaldi pitched five scoreless innings, striking out seven and allowing five hits. A.J. Jimenez had given the Lugnuts their 3-1 lead with a three-run homer in the 7th.

2016: Max Pentecost hit two home runs off of South Bend right-hander Adbert Alzolay, the first home runs allowed by the Cubs since June 12th, but the Nuts gave up four runs in the bottom of the eighth and lost 5-3 at Four Winds Field.

2017: Jason Heyward played the second straight game of an MLB rehab assignment, going 2-for-3 with two singles and a run scored, but Bo Bichette broke out of a 2-for-16 slump with a single, double and two-run homer, lifting his batting average to .392 in an 8-2 win at South Bend.

In a Nutshell: Making 12th appearance, 11th start, of the season... returning from the Injured List (concussion)... last Pitt Panther to start a game for the Nuts was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in 2016, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016, spent last season with the Cincinnati Reds, and is currently in Lehigh Valley (Triple-A - Philadelphia)... @mitch_myers9 on social media.

International Respect: Mitch is ranked No. 3 in the world in the video game Super Monkey Ball.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

May 18 - P **Jake Garland** delivers a stunning debut, coming up from Stockton to strike out 10 Lake County Captains in seven innings while allowing one run on two hits.

June 6 - The Lugnuts scored seven runs in the first inning at South Bend, promptly lost the lead, falling behind 9-7, but retook the lead on a Max Muncy three-run homer in the seventh and went on to win 13-9.
