

RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (4-3) AT Inland Empire 66ers (2-5)





TODAY'S GAME: Today's game is the first of six straight on the road, as your Quakes take on the Inland Empire 66ers (LAA) at San Manuel Stadium. The Quakes return to LoanMart Field next Tuesday, April 23, hosting Lake Elsinore in a six-game set. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's games is the first of 24 head-to-head meetings between the two clubs and the first of 12 at San Manuel Stadium. Last year, the Quakes went 8-4 here at San Manuel Stadium, 14-13 overall against the 66ers. **LAST GAME:** Saturday's regularly-scheduled game was interrupted and eventually postponed, as the Quakes held a 2-0 lead in the top of the third inning. Steady rain eventually became too much and after more than a 90-minute delay, the game was called. Wilman Diaz gave Rancho a 2-0 lead in the second, with a two-run double off Ports starter Franck De La Rosa. Today's action will pick up where we left off, with a man at second base and two outs in the top of the third inning. At the completion of that nine-inning contest, the Quakes and Ports will take a 30-minute break, then play today's regularly-scheduled game, which will now be just seven innings. The Quakes last played a double-header at LoanMart Field in September of 2022, dropping both games against the Lake Elsinore Storm.

BUEHLER....BUEHLER: Former Quake Walker Buehler returned to Rancho on Friday night for the first time since a rehab appearance in 2018, as he threw 27 pitches over two innings, allowing one run on three hits on Friday night. His appearance marked the first for a rehabbing Dodger in 2024. Buehler made five starts for the Quakes in 2017 while coming up through the Dodgers' system, so Friday marked his seventh overall game in a Rancho uniform. All Dodger rehabbers are sponsored by Yaamava' Resort and Casino at San Manuel.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made five moves today, placing RHP Eriq Swan on the Injured List, while also sending INF Oswaldo Osorio and RHP Ben Serunkuma to Extended Spring Training in Arizona. They have filled two of the three spots with a pair of 2023 Quakes, INF Jordan Thompson and RHP Noah Ruen, giving them 29 active players. **FAMILIAR FACES ON THE FIELD:** The Quakes have 29 active players on their 30-man roster to open this road trip. Of the 29, 23 have seen time in Rancho within the last two years. Returning Quakes include pitchers Patrick Copen, Carlos Duran (2022), Gabe Emmett, Jorge Gonzalez, Roque Gutierrez, Edgardo Henriquez (2022), Carlos Martinez, Garrett McDaniels, Jose Rodriguez, Christian Ruebeck, Noah Ruen, David Tiburcio and Reynaldo Yean. Returning position players include Jesus Galiz, Cameron Decker, Wilman Diaz, Jake Gelof, Jeral Perez, Jordan Thompson, Joe Vetrano, Juan Alonso, Josue De Paula and Kendall George.

PROSPECTS TO WATCH: The Quakes have four players on their current roster who are rated by MLB Pipeline as Top-30 Dodgers prospects. Three of them play in the outfield, with Josue De Paula (#4), Kendall George (#12) and Zyhir Hope (#21). Infielder Jake Gelof is the other ranked prospect, as he checks in at #23.

EDGARDO HENRIQUEZ: Edgardo Henriquez makes his second appearance of 2024 and just his second overall since 2022, after suffering a season-ending injury with Rancho. In his only start so far, he allowed just one hit and one walk over two innings, striking out four in a no-decision in Lake Elsinore on April 6. In 2022, Henriquez went 2-3 for the Quakes, with a 4.54 ERA over 14 games (13 starts). Henriquez signed with the Dodgers out of Venezuela in 2018. **FRANCIS TEXIDO:** Left-hander Francis Texido makes his second start for Inland Empire this year. In his lone start, he scattered four hits and three walks with five strikeouts over four scoreless innings in a no-decision versus Visalia on April 7. Last year, he went 6-1 with a 2.31 ERA over 12 starts and 50.2 innings. Texido signed with the Angels in 2023 out of Havana, Cuba.
