Shipping Up to Portland

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series at the Portland Sea Dogs tonight. It is the ninth of 21 matchups between the teams this season, with Portland holding the 6-2 edge. Reading won the series in 2023 11-9 over Portland. Matt Osterberg starts tonight for Reading, opposite Hunter Dobbins for Portland. Following last night's postponement, the teams will play a doubleheader on Saturday, beginning at 1p.m.

Put it in the Rearview

Reading fell 8-3 Wednesday night in its second-straight defeat against Portland. The Fightin Phils took a 3-0 lead in the top of the fifth, but relinquished the lead when Portland scored five runs in the bottom of the frame. The Sea Dogs added a run in the sixth and two in the eighth on a two-run home run from Kyle Teel. Christian McGowan tossed four innings, and Andrew Baker suffered the loss. Reading was held to a season-low two hits for the third time this season.

Closer Tandem

The Fightin Phils have leaned on Max Lazar and Tommy McCollum as their late-inning arms this season. Both have three saves each through the first month of the season. The duo has appeared in a combined 13 games this season, and have allowed two-earned runs over 16.1 IP (1.10 ERA). They also have 25/6 strikeout to walk ratio. Reading is 6/7 in save opportunities this April, after going 3/6 last season. Also the R-Phils have not blown any leads after the 6th, 7th or 8th innings in April.

As of Late

Reading's win on Sunday gave the R-Phils their first series win of the season. The R-Phils first series win of the season in 2023 came one week later, the first week of May at Hartford. In total, Reading won seven series in 2023. The Fightin Phils ended up finishing April with a 10-12 record, which comes after going just 6-14 in the season's first month last season. The Fightin Phils posted a 6-6 home record in April, which compares to just a 4-7 home record in the first month of the 2023 season. In April, the Fightin Phils welcomed nearly 60,000 fans to America's Classic Ballpark and over 5,000 fans per game, on average. Both the total and average attendance ranked as third in the Eastern League and Double-A, behind only Richmond and Hartford.

Marcus Mashing

Marcus Lee Sang had his best game of the season on Tuesday night. Lee Sang went three-for-four, with two runs, a double, two homers and three RBI. It marked his third-career multi-homer game, and first in Double-A. It was also the third-time in his career Lee Sang had three extra-base hits. The last time he accomplished both of those feats was Aug. 6, 2022 with High-A Jersey Shore. It marked Reading's second multi-homer game this season, with the other coming Apr. 9 against Portland from Carson Taylor. Ironically, both of Reading's multi-homer games have come in the first game of a series against the Sea Dogs.

Magic Number

This season, Reading is 9-1 when scoring more than five runs in a game, and the Fightin Phils are 1-12 when scoring less than five in a game this season.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 3, 2023: At Hartford, Reading's offense explodes in a 12-6 win over the Yard Goats. The only thing that could slow down the Fightin Phils offense was the weather, as the game was called after five-full innings due to rain. Ethan Wilson homered for the second-straight day, which was the second time he homered in back-to-back games in a one-week span. Newcomer Drew Ellis joined the home run party, while Carlos De La Cruz and Johan Rojas each collected three hits. Every member of the R-Phils lineup reached base and scored a run.

Playing Portland

Portland enters today with an 13-8 record and sits in second place in the Northeast Division. Last week, the Sea Dogs went 2-4 at Hartford, including dropping the final three games of the series. After this week, Portland remains at home and welcomes Binghamton. Portland went 73-63 in 2023 and narrowly missed out on winning the division in the first half of last season. Portland's roster has nine of Boston's top-30 prospects on its roster, featuring: Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), Kyle Teel (3), Wikelman Gonzalez (5), Nick Yorke (6), Blaze Jordan (19), Eddinson Paulino (22), Hunter Dobbins (25) and Angel Bastardo (26). Blaze Jordan was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .444 (12-28), with four 2B, two HR and 8 RBI.

Portland Pitcher

Righty, and Boston's No. 25 Propsect, Hunter Dobbins gets the start tonight for Portland. Dobbins is 1-0, with a 2.25 ERA over three starts so far this season. He's pitched 16 innings, allowed 12 hits, nine walks and nine strikeouts. Last Friday at Hartford, Dobbins went six innings, allowing two runs, five hits, three walks and seven strikeouts in a no-decision. He pitched against Reading on Apr. 13 and allowed two runs (one earned) on three hits over four innings pitched. Dobbins also walked five and struck out one in the game at Reading. He split 2023 between High-A Greenville and Portland, combining to go 5-5, with a 4.27 ERA over 20 appearances and 19 starts. Dobbins began his professional career with Single-A Salem in 2022. The Red Sox drafted Dobbins in the eighth round of the 2021 draft out of Texas Tech. Dobbins features a fastball, curveball, slider and splitters in his pitch arsenal.

CAREER NOTES

2024 Notes: On Fightin Phils Opening Day Roster. Earned Opening Night start Apr. 5 at Bowie. Was efficient over 3.2 innings against Baysox, allowing just one-earned run and two hits. Second start of season was another strong one Apr. 12 vs Portland. Allowed three runs, but just one was earned. Surpassed Opening Night strikeout total with five punchouts in total. Was efficient on Apr. 12, throwing 66% of pitches for strikes, while scattering six hits. Followed up with second-straight five-inning start Apr. 18 at Binghamton. Matched season-high with six hits allowed, and surrendered season-high to date two-earned runs. Second-straight start allowing no walks, and threw strikes on 74% of pitches. Placed on Development List Apr. 19 and activated prior to start on Apr. 26. Roughed up Apr. 26 vs SOM. Allowed season-high 10 hits and career-high 7 runs, while walking three in just 3.1 IP, while suffering second loss of season.

2023 Notes: Promoted to Double-A Reading on August 5. Made six starts for Fightin Phils and finished on strong note. Went seven-shutout innings on Sept. 14 at Binghamton, matching both season and career high. Won Eastern League Pitcher of the Week following final week of regular season. Earned lone Reading win in first start with Fightin Phils, going 5.2 innings at New Hampshire on Aug. 13. Did not allow a walk over final four starts (19.2) innings pitched en route to strong finish. Posted a 1.88 ERA over three appearances in September. His 24 starts ranked third in Phillies organization, nine wins was tied for second, 106 strikeouts were fifth, 4.24 strikeout to walk ratio was second, 122.2 IP was also tied for second. He had the best ERA (3.52) and WHIP (1.11) out of all qualifying starting pitchers in the Phillies organization. With Jersey Shore, he had three outings of seven innings and had a streak of four-straight wins from June 8 through June 28.
