FRISCO, TX — For the second straight night, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals established control in the game early and did not look back, with an emphatic 12-4 win over the Frisco RoughRiders Saturday night.

- Despite going down 1-2-3 against Rangers' top prospect Jack Leiter, the Naturals forced the right-hander out of the game in the third inning, rallying for four runs with two outs ... Michael Massey reached on an error from Frisco second baseman Justin Foscue that prolonged the inning, then Robbie Glendinning singled home Nick Loftin, John Rave doubled across Massey and Glendinning and Sebastian Rivero doubled in Rave ... Loftin singled across another run in the third inning, then **Tucker Bradley** blew the game open in the fifth with the Naturals' second grand slam in as many nights, an opposite field laser to left field, bringing home Rivero, Nate Eaton and Jake Means ... Massey blasted his second homer in as many days out to center field in the eighth and Eaton tagged his first long ball of the year out to left in the ninth.
- Eaton finished his day 3-for-3 with three runs scored and two walks, reaching base in all five plate appearances ... eight different Naturals scored a run, while seven different players had hits and seven players drove in runs as well in the team effort.
- Left-hander Dante Biasi made a spot start for the Naturals, pitching 4.0 scoreless innings, while striking out four ... lefty Walter Pennington was the first Natural out of the bullpen, allowing one unearned run across 2.0 innings and was awarded the win in his Double-A debut. Stephen Woods Jr. followed Pennington with two innings and Zach Willeman finished the game in the ninth, with a strikeout to end the game.

This Day in Naturals History

The Naturals are 4-9 all-time when playing on April 24

On April 24, 2013, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Springfield Cardinals, 7-6 in 13 innings at Arvest Ballpark ... then second baseman, now assistant hitting coach, Christian Colón led the way offensively, going 4-for-7 with a pair of singles, plus and a double and triple, coming a home run short of the cycle. After the Naturals scored 4 in the 7th to tie the game at 6, the next five innings were scoreless, until Colón walked the game off in the bottom of the 13th, with a single to center field that scored Carlo Testa from third base.

THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, seven players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 10 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Holden Capps, Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Andrés Sotillet, Stephen Woods Jr. and Ángel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was outfielder Seuly Matias.
- Additionally, catcher/infielder Gavin Stupienski and pitcher Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021, as did catcher Tyler Cropley, who is currently on the Injured List.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 20 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas:
 Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Ángel Zerpa.

STAR-STUDDED ROTATION

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- RHP Alec Marsh started Tuesday and goes again today for the Naturals ...
 MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 12 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 11.
- LHP Drew Parrish started Wednesday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 29 in the system, while Baseball America had him at No. 38
 in their preseason rankings.
- LHP Anthony Veneziano started Thursday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 17 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- LHP Ángel Zerpa started Friday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 20.
- LHP Asa Lacy has made two starts for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him No. 72 overall in baseball, No. 4 in the system and the No. 5 lefthanded pitching prospect, while Baseball America has him at No. 4 in the Royals' minor league system, the No. 4 left-handed pitching prospect.

TOOLSY TEAM

Six active Naturals players were listed in *Baseball America*'s 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the system.
- C Sebastian Rivero is rated as being the "Best Defensive Catcher" in the system.
- SS **Maikel Garcia** is rated as having the <u>"Best Infield Arm"</u> in the system.
- RF **Seuly Matias** is rated as having the <u>"Best Outfield Arm"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Asa Lacy** is rated as having the <u>"Best Slider"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** is rated as having the <u>"Best Control"</u> in the system.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** drew 10 walks through the season's first five games, and has drawn four walks across in his last three games, is second in the Texas League with 14 walks.

- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first threewalk game on Wednesday 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.
- In 67 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 28 times, for a .418 on-base percentage (14 hits + 14 walks).
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking tied for second in walks (14) and tied 3rd in steals (7).
- Despite his on-base prowess, Garcia has gone hitless in his last four games and is 0 for his last 17 at the plate, with four walks, a span in which his batting average has dropped nearly 100 points.

STREAKY STARTS

Going 0-6 yesterday, Maikel Garcia's 13-game on-base streak game to an end, the first time in 2022 he did not reach base. 13 games is tied for the second-longest on-base streak in the Texas League, still the longest on the Naturals

- INF Robbie Glendinning has reached base in all <u>11 games</u> he's played started the season hitting .265 (9-for-34) with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run and 12 walks, giving him a .469 on-base percentage.
- Glendinning's on-base streak is the second longest among Naturals players this season, the longest active streak and he remains the last hitter on the team that has reached base in every game he's played year ... he is one of seven players in the Texas League with an active 10+ game on-base streak that dates back to Opening Day, April 8.
- Across his 13 game on-base streak, SS Maikel Garcia started the season hitting .298 (14-for-47) with 2 doubles and 14 walks, giving him a .459 on-base percentage.
- Prior to Tuesday, INF/OF Nate Eaton and 2B Michael Massey had both reached base in all eight games they'd played this season and OF Tucker Bradley had reached base in all six games he'd played to start the season, but all three of those streaks ended Tuesday as Eaton, Massey and Bradley all failed to reach base ... pinch-hitting in the 9th inning on Tuesday and striking out, Bradley's team-best six-game hitting streak ended as well.

SNIDER DEBUTS AND EARNS THE DUB!

On April 9, right-handed pitcher **Collin Snider** made his Major League debut for the Kansas City Royals, the 111th Naturals alum to reach the Majors.

- Snider is one of 16 former Naturals on the Royals' 28-man Opening Day roster, one of 15 that has made their MLB debut after playing in Northwest Arkansas.
- Snider's first MLB appearance was a high-leverage situation, as he came on to pitch the 10th inning of a game tied 0-0 at Kauffman Stadium against Cleveland. He kept the Guardians off the board, with some defensive help from fellow 2021 Natural and 2022 debutante Bobby Witt Jr. and after the Royals walked it off in the bottom of the 10th for a 1-0 win, Snider was awarded his first MLB win in his debut.
- The full list of former Naturals on the Royals' active roster is: Scott Barlow, Jake Brentz, Dylan Coleman, Hunter Dozier, Cam Gallagher, Jackson Kowar, Nicky Lopez, Whit Merrifield, Adalberto Mondesi, Ryan O'Hearn, Salvador Perez, Brady Singer, Collin Snider, Gabe Speier, Josh Staumont and Bobby Witt Jr. ... note that Barlow pitched in MLB before he played for the Naturals.






