Game 2 - Lugnuts 4, Captains 2. Matt Cross provided a three-run homer and sacrifice fly, shouldering all of the Nuts' offense in the nightcap for a twinbill split.

On Deck: The Lugnuts return home to host the Great Lakes Loons on Independence Day, take a day off on Tuesday, and then continuing against the Loons through Sunday, July 10, at Jackson Field in Michigan's state capital.

Coincidence: Last night, Lake County starter Rodney Boone became the second pitcher in the Midwest League to hurl a seven-inning complete game shutout in a Captains 8-0 win over the Lugnuts at Classic Park. Weirdly, the first pitcher to do so was the Lugnuts' **Jeff Criswell** against the Captains at Classic Park in an 8-0 Lugnuts win on April 30th.

Catching Fire: With his home run and four runs batted in last night, Matt Cross added to a remarkable showing this series by the Lugnuts' trio of catchers comprising Cross, Jared McDonald and Tyler Soderstrom. In the first five games of this series, the three have combined to hit .353 (12-for-34) with a double, six homers, 17 RBIs and eight walks, slugging .912 with a .465 on-base pct.

Let Me See Your Halo: He may not be a catcher, but Euribiel Angeles has also caught fire recently. The prospect middle infielder hit safely in both games of yesterday's doubleheader and is 8-for-20 against the Captains in this series with 12 hits in his last 32 at-bats. The hot streak follows an 0-for-15 slump last homestand.

Soder Pop: C/1B **Tyler Soderstrom** is 2nd in the Midwest League with 49 RBIs, 4th with 121 total bases, 4th with 29 extra-base hits and tied for 5th with 13 home runs. Through three games of this series, Soderstrom has reached base via five hits and three walks, scoring five runs. Others among the league leaders include P **Kumar Nambiar**, who is tied for 2nd with 26 relief appearances, while P **Angello Infante** and **Trayson Kubo** are tied for 4th with six saves.

Road to L.A.: At the conclusion of Phase 1 of MLB All-Star voting, Alejandro Kirk (2019 in Lansing), Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. (2017) and Bo Bichette (2017) each advanced to the Phase 2 vote, starting July 5th and ending July 8th, as the top two vote-getters at their positions. If any/all of them win their Phase 2 vote, they will start the All-Star Game for the American League.

Nuts to the Show: 6-foot-2, 280-pound pitcher Max Castillo (2018) made his MLB debut for the Toronto Blue Jays on June 19, becoming the 169th all-time Lugnut to reach The Show. He is the 8th former Lugnut to reach the Majors this year, joining Oakland A's pitchers Zach Logue (2018) and Zach Jackson (2017) and infielder Christian Lopes (2013); Toronto Blue Jays utilityman Vinny Capra (2018) and catcher Gabriel Moreno (2019); Seattle Mariners reliever Danny Young (2016) and Boston Red Sox starting pitcher Josh Winckowski (2019) as former Lugnuts to make it to the Major Leagues this year.

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

Take Two: Joined Lugnuts in initial flight from Spring Training and was scheduled to be part of the starting rotation, but was placed on Injured List on Opening Day and flew back to Arizona (elbow)... made two Arizona Complex League starts in rehab, totaling 4 2/3 IP... flew to Double-A Midland on June 24 to be ready in case of emergency, but was not needed... returned to Lugnuts on June 28, starting the series opener of this current series and tossing three scoreless innings... has not shaved since beginning rehab in April.

In the Classroom: Attained Bachelor's degree in Sport Management in three years at SNHU, posting a 3.88 GPA, then attained his MBA, focusing on project management, with a 4.0 GPA... interned in the SNHU athletic department, filming sporting events... twice was named Northeast 10 (NE10) Academic All-Conference and was named Academic All-District as a grad student.

On the Field: In high school, played shortstop when not pitching, batting second in the lineup... turned in an outstanding college career at SNHU, finishing 23-5, 16 saves – 11 in 2016, 2nd most in a season in school history – 1.93 career ERA, 76 G, 22 GS, 233 IP, 168 H, 62 BB, 234 K... finished 2nd in career wins, 2nd in ERA, 4th in strikeouts and 5th in innings pitched in SNHU record books... other NE10 rivals included Lake County's Zach Hart (Franklin Pierce University) and former Lugnut and current Stockton Port Edward Baram (Adelphi)... in 2019, named D-II East All-Region First Team, ABCA East All-Region Second Team, NCBWA East All-Region Second Team, and NE10 All-Conference First Team... SNHU was ranked No. 17 in the nation, but lost in the NCAA East-Super Regional to NYIT, finishing one victory shy of punching its ticket to the D-II College World Series in Cary, N.C.

The Penmen? Yes, SNHU's nickname is the Penmen, created by the editorial cartoonist of the Union Leader, Bob Murphy. Southern New Hampshire University was originally founded as New Hampshire College of Accounting and Commerce. The "pen" refers to the quill used by an accountant of colonial New Hampshire. The current logo, however, shows a Revolutionary War patriot holding an American flag bravely rushing forward.

Into the Workforce: Currently serves as Special Project Coordinator at Advanced Theory & Performance (ATP)... first came to ATP while rehabbing from Tommy John surgery in 2017, leading to post-college work opportunity.

Going Pro: Signed with the Athletics for \$1,000... debuted in 2019 with A's Green in the Arizona League, making 18 relief appearances, holding lefties to .200 avg. while righties hit .302... moved up to Stockton in 2021, converting from relief pitcher to starter, and had similar success vs. lefties (.248) compared to righties (.320)... worked this past offseason to change the spin of his slider to get more horizontal and vertical movement, seeking increased swing and miss.

Personal: Loves going fishing in his spare time... grew up rooting for the Yankees as an Alex Rodriguez fan and, just like Rodriguez, began as a shortstop before moving to third base (and eventually to pitching, unlike A-Rod, in order to get drafted)... drafted in the 20th round in 2017 from the Puerto Rico Baseball Academy and High School (Gurabo, Puerto Rico) and signed away from Alabama State University commitment... was first scouted at the Perfect Game national showcase... said that he talked least to the Athletics of any MLB team approaching the draft.

PRBHS History: Founded in 2002 by Ed Correa, who first used the Los Angeles Dodgers' Dominican complex in Las Palmas, DR, in 1999 as what would become the Puerto Rico Baseball Academy and High School three years later... produced Carlos Correa (1st overall in 2012), Hiram Burgos, Joe Jiménez, Vimael Machin, Jesmuel Valentin and Christian Vázquez... in 2021, produced one draftee, Astros 16th-rounder Gaby Nieves... in 2017, when Berrios was drafted, he was one of four players drafted from PRBHS.

Puerto Rican Baseball: Puerto Rico has produced four Hall of Famers thus far in Roberto Clemente, Iván Rodríguez, Roberto Alomar and Orlando Cepeda, with 1996 Lugnuts outfielder Carlos Beltrán and current catcher Yadier Molina each with their own Hall of Fame cases... today's Major League stars from Puerto Rico are led by Javier Báez of the Tigers, Francisco Lindor of the Mets, José Berríos of the Blue Jays, and Carlos Correa of the Twins... Lindor, like Osvaldo Berrios, was born in Caguas.

Pro Debut - 2017 in AZL: Made professional debut on July 1, 2017, vs. AZL Giants, allowing three runs on five hits in 1 2/3... final appearance of the year was his best (3 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K) vs. AZL SD1 on September 2... gave up .302 avg. to lefties, .366 to righties... base-stealers were 4-for-6.


2018 in AZL: Relieved Daulton Jefferies in the second game of the season, tossing 3 2/3 innings (6 H, 1 R, 5 K) vs. AZL Glants Black... pitched six-inning gem (3 H, 1 R, 4 K) on the 4th of July vs. AZL White Sox... gave up just two earned runs in final 17 2/3 innings... limited righties to .252 avg /.628 OPS while lefties thi: 348/.660... base-stealers were 6-for-6.

2019 in AZL and the NYPL: Opened season with AZL A's Gold, making four appearances... in first game of the year, appeared in relief on June 17 and struck out six AZL Cubs2 in 3 2/3 innings, allowing only one hit... tossed five-inning gem (4 H, 1 R, 4 K) on July 1 vs. AZL Dodgers, earning promotion to Short-Season A Vermont... finished the year with best outing for the Lake Monsters, August 29 vs. Connecticut in Game 2 of doubleheader (5 IP, 1 H, 2 BB, 4 K)... with Vermont, gave up. 326 avg./.855 OPS to right-handed hitters while lefties hit .241/.770... base-stealers went 1-for-1 in the AZL and 7-for-9 in the New York-Penn League.

2021 in Low-A West: Received the Opening Day start for the Stockton Ports, May 4 at Modesto, allowing two-run homer to Nuts catcher Matt Scheffler in the second inning but nothing further in four innings, striking out five... by month: May (4 G, 2 GS, 17 1/3, 3.63, .231, 0.98 WHIP)... June (5 G, 3 GS, 23 1/3, 8.49, .350, 1.89 WHIP)... July (4 G, 3 GS, 18 2/3, 4.82, .282, 1.39 WHIP)... August (3 GS, 16 IP, 6.19, .308, 1.44 WHIP)... in best outing, whiffed nine batters in 5 2/3 innings, July 6 at Modesto, allowing two runs on four hits and two walks... vs. left-handers: .320/.379/.484, 3 HR... vs. right-handers: .283/.333/.514, 9 HR... base-stealers stole 22 bases in 26 attempts.

2021 in High-A Central: Promoted to Lansing on August 19, replacing starter Jack Cushing (promoted to Double-A Midland; the Rock-Hounds' 2022 Opening Day starter, coincidentally)... enjoyed a smashing debut, limiting Great Lakes to two runs in six innings, August 20 at Dow Diamond... followed up with six scoreless innings of seven-hit relief at West Michigan, August 26, earning the win... faced the Whitecaps in back-to-back home starts to end the year, allowing two runs in three innings in a no-decision September 15, and suffering the loss on the final day of the year, September 19: 2 1/3 IP, 6 H, 8 R, 3 BB, 3 K, serving up a solo HR to Jake Holton in the 1st inning and knocked out by a six-run 3rd... Whitecaps won the game, 19-4, to end the season with an identical 58-62 record as the Lugnuts.

Winter Ball: Pitched for Cangrejeros de Santurce – a cangrejero is a crabber – in Liga de Béisbol Profesional Roberto Clemente, who finished 17-15 in 3rd place and were knocked out in the playoff semifinals by champs Criollos de Caguas... appeared in six games in relief, his first time ever pitching regularly in relief: 5.87 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 9 H, 5 R, 2 BB, 6 K... the Santurce Cangrejeros were the same team that the great Clemente himself played for in the early 1950s... the 1954-55 Cangrejeros had both Clemente and Willie Mays in their outfield.
