TODAY'S GAME: The Curve wrap up a six-game series with Bowie, a series that has massive postseason implications.

LAST TIME OUT: Altoona snagged an extra inning victory, 10-8, on Saturday night on the strength of 15 hits. Five Curve players picked up at least two hits, led by **Endy Rodriguez** who had 3 including a solo homer in the seventh.

BIG TREE HIT BALL HARD: Infielder Jared Triolo is playing some of his best baseball on both sides of the ball as the season moves into late-August. Triolo is amid a 14-game on-base streak (8/9 - Present) in which he's batting: .349/.408/.635/1.043 with 4 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 6 RBI and 3-3 SB. Triolo scored a run in 8 straight games (8/14 - 8/25), the longest active streak in the Eastern League. In his last 53 games (6/21 - Present), Triolo has a .398 on-base percentage with 25 extra base hits. He's reached base safely in Ž0-of-21 games in August.

K-MAN: Right-hander Luis Ortiz has 126 strikeouts on the season; becoming the first Curve pitcher with 100 strikeouts in a season since Taylor Hearn in 2018. Ortiz struck out 10 Bowie Baysox on Friday, August 26, the first 10+ strikeout performance for the Curve since Roansy Contreras struck out 10 on 6/15/21 at Erie. Should Ortiz stay on turn in the rotation, he would have 4 more starts in the regular season; giving him a solid chance to set the team's franchise récord for strikeouts in a season (Ian Snell, 2004: 142). He needs just 16 strikeouts to match the record.

NICKY G IS BACK: Infielder Nick Gonzales picked up a season-high 4 hits including a walk-off double in the 10th inning of Altoona's 3-2 win over Harrisburg on Wednesday, August 17. After missing 10 weeks of the season with a right foot injury, Gonzales has reached base safely in each of his first 10 games since his activation batting: .244/.404/.390 (10-for-41) with 3 2B, 1 HR, 5 RBI, 9 BB

BOMBS AWAY: Jared Triolo hit 3 lead-off homers in the span of 9 days (8/10, 8/14 and 8/18) becoming just the 2nd player in franchise history to hit 3 lead-off homers in a career. **Alen Hanson** hit a franchise-best 4 lead-off homers in 2014. The Curve have now hit 6 lead-off home runs this season setting the franchise record.

SHACK ATTACK: Aaron Shackelford homered in four consecutive games for the Curve from August 7-12, all of which were two-run shots. Altoona's franchise record for consecutive games with a home run stands at 6 when Brad Eldred homered in each game from 4/26-5/2 in 2005. With his 24 homers on the season, Shackelford is the 10th player in franchise history to homer 20 times in a season, Mason Martin hit 22 homers in 2021 for the Curve. Martin was also the most recent Curve batter to homer in 4 straight games when he did so from 7/3-6 in 2021. Shackelford is 1st among Pirates MiLB with 24 HR (Matt Gorski) and ranks T-2nd in the Eastern League with 25 Extra-Base Hits in the Second Half of the Season.

ENDY'S TIME: Prior to Altoona's series with Binghamton, the Pirates promoted the No. 5 prospect in the system according to MLB. com, C Endy Rodriguez. Rodrigurez picked up at least one hit in 13-of-14 games with the Curve and driven in 14 runs. He had a hit in 12 straight games to begin his Curve career, a stretch that ended on August 26 at Bowie.

STOLEN HEARTS: The Curve have stolen 144 bases on the season, on pace to break the franchise record of 159 (2014) with 19 games to play. Altoona has 3 players, Jared Triolo (24), Liover Peguero (23) and Andres Alvarez (20), with 20 stolen bases for the second time in franchise history: first since 2014 when Keon Broxton and Alen Hanson each had 25 and Drew Maggi stole 37 bases.

THE MEN FROM THE SENATE: Managed by Kyle Moore, Bowie is right in the thick of the playoff race entering this series. Bowie features several top prospects ranked by MLB.com: OF Colton Cowser (#4), INF Coby Mayo (#7), INF Connor Norby (#12), RHP Chayce McDermott (#14), LHP Cade Povich (#15), INF Joey Ortiz (#19), INF Cesar Prieto (#21), and OF Hudson Haskin (#24).

THE FIRST TO LAY BY THE BAY: Chayce McDermott makes his second start of the series on Sunday afternoon. McDermott tossed 4.1 innings on Tuesday allowing 6 runs on 5 hits and 4 walks with 7 strikeouts. Ranked as the #14 prospect in the org according to MLB.com, McDermott is a native of Anderson, Indiana. He shared a pitching staff with Curve RHP Kyle Nicolas for 3 seasons (2018-20) at Ball State. McDermott essentially took over as the ace after Nicolas was drafted by the Marlins in 2020. He was selected in the 4th round, 132nd overall, by the Houston Astros and was swapped to Baltimore in the Trey Mancini deal at the deadline 3 weeks ago. Chayce's brother Sean, played college basketball at Butler and for the Memphis Grizzlies. His mother, Kim, played basketball at Indiana Śtate.

CAREER NOTES

2022: Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 22 right-handed pitching prospect in all of minor league baseball entering the season... Suffered an oblique injury at the end of spring training and missed all of April and May before returning for a rehab assignment beginning on Thursday, June 9 with Bradenton vs. Clearwater in which the Marauders threw a combined no-hitter (Priester 3.0 IP, Anthony Solometo 4.0 IP, Jake Sullivan 1.0 IP, Yunior Thaibo 1.0 IP), game was caught by rehabbing Curve C Henry Davis... Bradenton's no-hitter was the first he's ever been part of in his life... Completed his rehab assignment on 6/14 with Greensboro: allowed five runs on six hits in 2.2 innings...EL Ranks in July: 5th in ERA (1.69), 6th in IP (26.2), 9th in WHIP (1.05), 10th in BAA (216)... His 1.69 ERA in July ranked 8th among Double-A Pitchers... His 2.40 ERA in the second half (6/28 - Present) ranks 7th in the EL, also ranks 8th in IP (48.2)...

2021: Entered the season ranked by *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline as the fourth-best prospect in the Pirates system...Was also ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 58 prospect in all of baseball and the No. 17 right-handed pitching prospect... Was listed as having the "Best Curveball" in the Pirates minor league system by *Baseball America* entering the 2021 campaign... Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training where he made two appearances and allowed one earned run in 1.1 innings pitched... Spent the entire season in Greensboro's rotation, went 7-4 with a 3.04 ERA in 20 starts... His 3.04 ERA was the second-best mark among Pirates minor leaguers (minimum 90.0 IP) behind Bradenton's Adrian Florencio (2.46)... Picked up his first two wins of the season in back-to-back starts on May 18 and May 25 by throwing 5.0 scoreless innings... Completed 5.0 innings in each of his four starts in the month of July, going 1-0 with a 2.63 ERA (7 ER / 24.0 IP)... Was selected to appear in the Sirius/XM Futures Game at Coors Field, worked 0.2 of an inning and struck out one batter... Finished a career-best 7.0 innings for the second time on August 13 against Winston-Salem, struck out a career-high 10 and did not allow a run... CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the first round (18th overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Cary-Grove High School in Cary, Illinois...Signed on June 10, 2019

CURVE CUTS: Charles Quinn Priester... Was committed to play collegiately at Texas Christian University before his selection in the 2019 draft... Signed for a bonus of \$3,400,000 by Pirates scout Anthony Wycklendt... Is a 2019 graduate of Cary-Grove (IL) High School, where he posted an 8-2 record and 1.00 ERA as a senior... Was named the 2018-19 Gatorade Illinois Player-of-the-Year... Was a two-sport athlete in high school; also played wide receiver and defensive back on the high school is football team that went 14-0 and won a Class 6A state championship in 2018 where he caught a 3-yard touchdown pass in the championship game against Crete-Monee HS... Played quarterback as an underclassmen before moving to receiver during his senior year of high school... Turned down an offer of a dual scholorship from Northwestern University to play football and baseball for the Wildcats... Was named a 2019 Rawlings Perfect Game pre-season All-American... Was also ranked as the 19th-best prospect by MLB Pipeline in the 2019 draft... Became the first high school player from the state of Illinois to be selected in the first round since Houston's Mike Foltynewicz in 2010...
