Today: It's a a Capital City Market Kids Day with gates opening at 12 noon for a 1:05 p.m. start, entertainment throughout, Kids Run the Bases after the game, and an Extra Inning with free ice cream and music with Big Lug across Michigan Ave. at Capital City Market postgame! It's also a rubber match in a seven-game, six-day series for the Lansing Lugnuts with the Lake County Captains, with each team winning three games entering play today. (Seven games are being played in this series rather than six because of a Wednesday make-up of a postponement from a series in Lake County in April.) The Nuts are 4-7 overall this year against the Captains.

Starting Matchup: Lake County lefty Ryan Webb, drafted from Georgia in the fourth round in 2021, makes his seventh start of the year. Lansing counters with right-hander Jack Perkins, a fifth-round selection last year from Indiana, in his sixth start and seventh overall appearance this year.

Last Night: Lugnuts 6, Captains 5. The Nuts scored the game's first three runs, Lake County rallied for five unanswered, but the Lugnuts laughed last with a three-run rally in the bottom of the ninth capped by a two-out, two-run walkoff single from Danny Bautista, Jr. to thrill a Saturday night crowd of 4,823.

On the Air: Today's game is available on Bally Live and MiLB TV, and via StreamGuys with Adam Jaksa and Jesse Goldberg-Strassler.

On Deck: The Lugnuts head on the road to Fort Wayne next week, returning home May 30 to welcome in the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the Minnesota Twins' High-A affiliate.

Lug•Notes

On the Edge of Our Seat: With last night's dramatics, the Nuts have now walked off five times in 24 home games this year (and, weirdly, four times by the final score of 6-5). Looking back on recent Lugnuts seasons, walkoffs by year: 5 in 2022, 4 in 2021, 2 in 2019, 6 in 2018, 5 in 2017, 5 in 2016, 1 in 2015, 5 in 2013, 4 in 2012, 8 in 2011, and 8 in 2010.

Other Notables From Last Night: Catcher Daniel Susac went 4-for-4, tying Caeden Trenkle's four-hit performance from earlier this year for the most hits by a Lugnut in a game this season. The outing also set a professional high for Susac for hits in one game; the former Arizona Wildcat had six four-hit games in college. Meanwhile, second baseman Sahid Valenzuela became the first Lugnut to reach base five times in a game, going 3-for-3 with two walks and three runs scored. After opening the season 2-for-15, Valenzuela has 17 hits in his last 44 at-bats, a 386 batting average. First baseman Jack Winkler also stayed hot, going 2-for-3 with a walk, single and a double, and has reached base six times in his last two games to vault his batting average from .212 to .240 and his OPS from .597 to .653.

Streaking: With his game-winning single last night, Danny Bautista, Jr., extended his hitting streak to seven games, tying him with the longest hitting streak for a Lugnut this season, a four-way tie with Lazaro Armenteros, Daniel Susac and Jack Winkler).

Seventh Heaven: Seven times this season a Midwest League starting pitcher has tossed seven innings. (No one has yet pitched longer than seven innings). Of those seven occasions, two were supplied by Lansing right-handers: Blake Beers on May 13 at West Michigan and Jake Garland on May 18 vs. Lake County. Garland's 10 strikeouts on Thursday were one behind the highest single-game strikeout total recorded by an MWL pitcher this year (Quad Cities' Noah Cameron, who has twice whiffed 11 in a game).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old Max Muncy was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old Daniel Susac was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and Alexander Campos (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: Bowling Green scored seven runs in the 2nd inning for a 7-2 lead, but the Lugnuts rallied past the Hot Rods, 13-9, with a 20-hit attack (and going 10-for-24 with RiSP, plus 12 runners left on base). 1-2-3 hitters Markus Brisker, Carlos Perez and Kevin Nolan each collected three hits, and Nolan drove in four runs. This was the start of three straight overwhelming Lugnuts offensive performances against the Hot Rods at Cooley Law School Stadium.

2015: The Lugnuts wrapped up a four-game home sweep of South Bend with a 17-2 rout. Future Major Leaguer Chase De Jong threw 8 2/3 innings (5 hits, 2 runs, 5 K's, 0 walks), one out shy of his first complete game. The Nuts broke the game open with eight runs against MSU Spartan David Garner in the sixth inning. The Lugnuts had eight extra-base hits, seven of them doubles.

In a Nutshell: Jack Perkins makes his fifth Lugnuts start today... one of four 2022 draftees on the roster; the others are 1st-rounder Daniel Susac, 4th-rounder Jacob Watters and 9th-rounder Caeden Trenkle... scouted and signed by Rich Sparks, who also was responsible for scouting/signing Lugnuts teammate Blake Beers and such other notables as Max Schuemann (promoted to Triple-A Las Vegas), Jeff Criswell (traded in the offseason to Colorado), Jack Weisenburger and Nuts teammate OF Clark Elliott... unrelated to former Phillies MiLB pitcher of the same name who split 2022 between Lehigh Valley and Reading... agent is Sam Samardzija, Jeff "Shark" Samardzija's brother.

Glory Days: Starred at Kokomo High School, batting .525 as a senior while being ranked Perfect Game's No. 2 prospect in the state of Indiana and No. 1 right-handed pitcher and No. 61 overall in the nation.... all-state running back for Kokomo Wildkats football, earning three letters... taken in the 39th round by the Cubs, but elected to attend college instead.

Study Skills: Posted a 4.42 GPA in high school, graduating fifth in his class... graduated in three years from the University of Louisville, earning double major in finance and marketing, before pursuing business management in grad school at Indiana.

Life in Louisville: Pitched in 2019 and 2021 for the Cardinals... overall as a freshman, posted 4.18 ERA in 16 appearances, four starts, spanning 32 1/3 innings, with 18 walks and 37 strike-outs... missed 2020 due to undergoing Tommy John; suffered UCL tear while pitching against Clemson in the 2019 ACC Tournament... returned in 2021 and struggled, with 7.31 ERA in 11 games (1 start) over 16 innings, walking 22 and whiffing only 15.

Off to Bloomington: Transferred to Indiana in order to work with pitching coach Justin Parker, but Parker left for South Carolina the week after Perkins transferred in... ended up instead working with Dustin Glant, who had been the pitching coach at NYY Triple-A affiliate Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, whom he credits for his development... opened as the no. 2 starter for the Hoosiers in 2022, but moved into the Friday night role for Big Ten play, going 3-4 with a 5.10 ERA in 16 games, team-leading 15 starts... in a team-leading 83 innings, gave up only six homers and struck out 91 while walking 47, hitting 21 batters and tossing 12 wild pitches... 91 strikeouts ranks 10th highest all-time in school history... recorded six quality starts.

Draft Day: Selected with the 154th pick of the 2022 draft, Oakland's fifth-round selection and second pitcher taken (after fourth-rounder Jacob Watters)... signed for \$270,750... highest of three Indiana Hoosiers selected in the draft (12th-rounder Bradley Brehmer and 20th-rounder Reese Sharp, both to the Orioles)... the last impactful Indiana Hoosier to reach the Majors was Kyle Schwarber, taken fourth overall in 2014.

Pro Debut: Made Minor League Baseball debut on August 6, 2022, in the Arizona Complex League, striking out three while allowing two hits and one run in one inning at the Cubs... worked with catcher Daniel Susac; fellow Lugnut Caeden Trenkle was in right field and leading off in the game... six days later, made Stockton debut with two scoreless innings at San Jose, the first of three straight two-inning scoreless appearances for the Ports in which Perkins allowed only one hit, walked none, and struck out seven in total... whiffed four Giants in two innings on September 2 in fourth Stockton appearance before allowing two runs on two hits and two walks in one inning on September 8 at Modesto, his final appearance of the year... runners attempted two steals and were caught once... lefties hit .182 (2-for-11, 0 BB, 4 K) and righties hit .150 (3-for-20, 2 BB, 7 K).
