- Dunedin squandered a 7-3 ninth inning lead, as Mighty Mussels' clean up man Jose Rodriguez belted an 'ultimate' grand slam to end the game with two outs in the bottom of the ninth.
- Blue Jays starter Connor O'Halloran fired 5.2 innings, allowing just 1 ER while striking out nine. The performance is the lefty's third start of the season in which he pitched five innings or longer and allowed one earned run or fewer.
- Bryce Arnold's 2-RBI single delivered Dunedin it's first lead of the day in the top of the seventh.
- Cristian Feliz belted his third homer in as many games; a two-run shot in the eighth that pushed the Dunedin lead to 7-3.
- Yhoangel Aponte went 2-4 with an RBI marking his sixth multi-hit game of the season.

#### **HEARTBREAKER**

Last night's defeat was the Blue Jays' third walk-off loss of the season in 13 road games. The loss marked just the second time this season Dunedin lost when leading after the eighth (11-2).

#### PUTTING 'EM ON THE BOARD

After being held to four or fewer runs in 11 consecutive games, the Blue Jays have scored five or more runs in four straight games. Dunedin is 10-4 when tallying five or more runs.

#### SLIMMEST OF MARGINS

Last night's loss continued the trend of close games for Dunedin, as 14 of the Blue Jays' last 16 contests have been decided by four or fewer runs. Dunedin has gone 4-10 in those games.

#### **BULLPEN BLEMISHES**

The Blue Jays bullpen has struggled the last two games, allowing 14 runs in 9.1 innings (13.50 ERA). After entering Sunday with the second-best bullpen ERA in the Florida State League, the 'pen has tumbled to 7th place with a 4.07 ERA.

#### FANTASTIC MR. FELIZ

With a two-run homer last night, Cristian Feliz has hit three homers in his last three games. Feliz's two-homer performance Saturday night marked the first by a Blue Jay this season. Feliz's second homer traveled 431 feet - the 5th longest homer in the Florida State League this season. Feliz's 44% hard-hit rate leads Dunedin (10th in the FSL), but his 52% K-rate leads the FSL.

#### SUPER 8TH

The Blue Jays have scored in the eighth inning in five of the last six games. Last week, Dunedin scored 10 8th inning runs.

#### IN THE ARIAS TONIGHT

Victor Arias ranks among the league's leading hitters in nearly every major rate stat. Arias is top 10 in average (7th - .311), OBP (9th - .400), SLG (6th - .473), and OPS (9th - .873). Arias has more multi-hit games (7) than hitless games (5).

#### <u>K COUNTER</u>

Blue Jays pitchers racked up 74 strikeouts in six games last week - the second most in all of Single-A last week. Tampa's hurlers weren't far behind, picking up 68 punchouts (6th in Single-A).

#### YOUNG GUN

Dunedin shortstop Arjun Nimmala is the second-youngest player in the Florida State league to open the season, at 18.5 years old (behind Daytona's Alfredo Duno at 18.2). Maykel Minoso joins Nimmala as the second 18 year old on the Blue Jays' roster.

#### FREE PASSES

Dunedin's pitching staff issued a season-high 12 walks on Sunday. The Jays pitching staff leads the FSL with 141 walks. However, Dunedin is also top three in the league in walks drawn with 128 (3rd, behind Lakeland and Tampa).

- Throws a four pitch mix that features a low-90s fastball, slider, curve and changeup. Mid-80s slider has been considered his best pitch by scouts
- Was a three-sport star at Hanford High School... was the school's starting varsity quarterback and also played basketball.
- Was originally committed to Texas Tech out of high school, but Red Raiders pulled offer after a football injury suffered his senior year.
