SUNDAY: The Captains clinched a series win at Dayton with an 8-3 victory. Lake County exploded for six runs in the second inning, including the first Captains home run for Jhonkensy Noel. Captains starter Mason Hickman picked up the win after limiting the Dragons to three runs over 5.1 innings. **Jerson Ramirez** notched a save by pitching 2.2 innings of hitless baseball to close it out.

PRESSURE PACKED: The Captains have held at least a share of first place in the High-A Central League East Division since their win over West Michigan on August 15. Since then, every game the Captains have played has been against a team within 1.0 game of them for the division lead. Lake County was either tied for first place with Dayton or one game ahead of the Dragons throughout their series last week. The Captains enter today's series with Great Lakes just 1.0 game ahead of the Loons.

TOP OF THE HEAP: When the Captains reached first place in the High-A Central League East Division on August 15, it was their first time atop the division since May 26. That date is also the last time the Captains held a share of a playoff position, but that was before Major League Baseball's July 1 announcement that there would be postseason baseball in the

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today 1.0 game behind the Cedar Rapids Kernels for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Cedar Rapids, the Dayton Dragons and the Great Lakes Loons are all separated by just 3.0 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 11.0 games ahead of second place. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

ARCH NEMESIS: The Great Lakes Loons are the only team against whom the Captains have a losing record this season 7-11). Lake County also has its worst run differential (-50), ERA (6.36) and opponent's OPS (.911) against Great Lakes.

NO TRAFFIC: In the month of August, the Captains' pitching staff owns the league's lowest WHIP (1.08), has allowed the fewest hits (120), has the second lowest ERA (3.60) and has the second-lowest batting average against (.204). Their hit total and WHIP are both the lowest in all of High-A, while their ERA and batting average against are second-lowest.

SIT 'EM DOWN: The Captains' starting staff is enjoying its best strikeout month of the season. Lake County starters are averaging a season-high 11.4 K/9 in August (116 K, 91.2 IP). Their 3.87 K/BB rate is also a season-best (30 BB). Four of the Captains' six 10-strikeout games have come in August. The other two were on July 24 and 30.

WALK THIS WAY: The Captains' offense enters today tied with Cedar Rapids for the most walks in August (81). Lake County has not finished a month above fourth in the league in that category this year.

LEADING THE PACK: George Valera leads the High-A Central in OPS (.977) and wRC+ (165). He is also second in onbase percentage (.430), second in BB% (20.9), third in walks (55), fourth in slugging percentage (.548) and tied for fifth in home runs (16).

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains have a better record at home (26-16) compared to on the road (25-28). Lake County's run differential, however, is better on the road (even) compared to at home (-9).

BIG LEAGUE REHAB: 1B Bobby Bradley and OF Harold Ramirez will make major league rehab appearances with the Captains tonight. Bradley spent 2015 with the Captains when he hit 27 home runs and collected a .875 OPS. He is in his second season at the major league level. Across 46 MLB games this season he has 11 home runs and a .796 OPS. Ramirez is in his first season with the Cleveland organization after breaking into the big leagues with Miami. In 77 games his season, Ramirez has 17 doubles and six home runs.

LAST TIME OUT: Coulter made his sixth start in the Captains weekly rotation against Dayton last Tuesday in a rain shortened seven inning game. The Captains got Coulter and early lead and he dominated the Dragons one time through the batting order, retiring the first ten batters to the plate with four strikeouts. After Lake County tacked on two more runs on a Gianpaul Gonzalez RBI double in the fourth, Coulter allowed his first base runner on a walk in the bottom of the fourth before Ivan Johnson hit a two-run home run to bring the Dragons within a run. Following the Johnson home run Coulter retired the final five batters he faced while matching his career high with eight strikeouts. Lake County added a final run in the top of the seventh inning and beat the Dragons 4-2 to open the series.

**TURNING IT AROUND:** Coulter has posted a 3.34 ERA since the beginning of July with 33 strikeouts, compared to eight walks (4.13 K/BB). In May and June, Coulter had an 8.31 ERA with 26 strikeouts, compared to 12 walks (2.17 K/BB).

**2019:** Across 18 appearances Coulter compiled 36.1 innings out of the bullpen in the Arizona league and finished the season with a 2.23 ERA. After allowing at least one earned run in his first four appearances Coulter found his rhythm in July, only giving up one earned run eight appearances and 14.1 innings in the month. He began to stretch his arm out in August finishing the season with three straight appearances in which he threw three or more innings.

**BEAR DOWN:** Coulter had an up and down career at Mercer where he finished with a career 4.74 ERA. He bounced back and forth between a starting role and the bullpen where he accumulated five saves across his four-year career, including three as a senior in the first three games of the Bears season. His best season came as a senior. After starting the year in the bullpen he was moved to the rotation where he made 11 consecutive starts before bouncing back to the 'pen to finish the season. He completed the 2019 season with a career best 3.90 ERA.

**THREE SPORT STAR:** While at Buford High School Coulter starred as a basketball player and runner on the cross country team as well as the diamond. In 2015 he led the Wolves to a state championship his senior season.
