Racking Up Runs... The Bowling Green Hot Rods plated a season-high 15 runs in a 15-5 win over the Greensboro Grasshoppers on Friday night at First National Bank Field. The 15 runs is the most scored by Bowling Green in a single game since June 24, 2025 against the Asheville Tourists (16 runs).

A Super Seven... The Hot Rods also tied their most runs in a single inning during the 2026 season on Friday. The Hot Rods tallied seven runs in the top of the eighth inning, the most in a single inning since June 14, 2026 against the Rome Emperors in the bottom of the second inning.

Power Play... Bowling Green launched two home runs in Friday's win over Greensboro. The Hot Rods have blast-ed nine home runs in four games this series. The Hot Rods crushed 37 home runs during July, good for the fourth-most in the South Atlantic League.

Double Trouble... First baseman Ryan McCoy logged two doubles on Friday night. McCoy's 22 doubles is tied for the most by any SAL hitter this season, even with Greenville Drive infielder Yoeilin Cespedes.

Setting the (Ay)bar High... Infielder Nicandro Aybar drove in two runs and scored three more in Friday's victory. Aybar is hitting 7-for-12 (.583 AVG) with three RBI in his first three games as a Hot Rods player after being promoted from the Charleston RiverDogs on Wednesday.

Flew Ball is For Real... Nathan Flewelling drove in a game-high three RBI in Thursday's win, including a two-run home run. The Tampa Bay Rays' No. 2 prospect has tagged 18 home runs, tied for sixth-most in the 2026 SAL season.

Hujsak Nearing History... Outfielder Connor Hujsak launched his 23rd homer of the season on Wednesday. Hujsak is now tied for the second-most single-season home runs in Bowling Green franchise history. Only Heriberto Hernandez (24 in 2022) has hit more home runs as a Hot Rods player in a single campaign.
