AMARILLO, TX – The Naturals did not let an early deficit keep them down, scoring seven unanswered runs and keeping the Sod Poodles scoreless over the final eight innings of the game, for a 10-4 win in the series finale Sunday evening.

- First baseman **Robbie Glendinning** led the way offensively, going 3-for-5 with two home runs, the first two-homer game of his career. He put the Naturals up 3-0 in the top of the first inning with a two-run homer, then added insurance in the ninth with a solo homer, his fifth of the week and 13th of the season to tie **Seuly Matias** for the team lead.
- With at least one home run in each of the last four games, Glendinning was the second Natural in the series to homer in four straight games, after Nick Loftin homered in the first four. They are two of just five Naturals ever to homer four straight games or more, the first players to accomplish the feat since 2012.*
- Starting Pitcher **Zack Phillips** struggled in the first inning, allowing four runs to score, as Amarillo took the lead. After the 39-pitch first inning, he settled into a groove and threw 39 pitches over the next three innings scoreless, setting a career-high with 78 pitches and tying a career-high with 4.0 innings pitched.
- Stephen Woods Jr.** followed Phillips with a scoreless fifth inning, then **Yefri Del Rosario** and **Andres Sotillet** combined for 4.0 scoreless after Woods Jr., as the three relievers combined to allow one hit over the final 5.0 innings.
- After the Sod Poodles' four-run first, the Naturals remained behind until the fifth inning, when **Tucker Bradley** doubled home Loftin to tie the game, then came around to score when Glendinning bounced into a double play. Matias added insurance, as he doubled in **John Rave** two batters later, then **Sebastian Rivero** singled Matias home to cap a four-run frame and put the Naturals up 7-4.
- Rave scored Glendinning in the seventh with a two-run homer, his second long ball of the week and eighth of the season, then Glendinning crushed a solo shot to left-center field in the ninth to cap the evening, before Sotillet fired a 1-2-3 ninth to finish the game.

THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 7-6 all-time when playing on July 4

On July 4, 2010, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Corpus Christi Hooks, 6-3 at Arvest Ballpark in front of a crowd of 7,886 fans, the 10th-largest in club history, at the time the 5th-largest. Starting pitcher **Mario Santiago** delivered a brilliant performance on the mound, throwing 6.2 scoreless innings on just 71 pitches, while striking out five. As part of a three-hit and two-RBI game, **Paulo Orlando** started the scoring in the first inning with a solo home run and the Naturals held a lead the rest of the night, with **Clint Robinson** blasting his 14th long ball of the season in the third inning.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 18 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
9 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Jake Means, Noah Murdock, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Ángel Zepa.

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 27-5, while when scoring six runs or less, just 6-36.
The Naturals are 21-10 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 12-31.
The Naturals are 31-11 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 2-30 when out-hit by their opponent.
When the Naturals score first, they are 22-13, whereas 11-28 when the opponent scores first ... the Naturals scored first five times last week, but have only won two of those games.

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 3-16 in one-run games this season, meaning 16 of their 41 losses (39.0%) this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the tying run at the plate or on base in 17 losses this season (including 12 of their one-run losses).
In three games this season (4/26, 7/1 & 7/2), the Naturals have entered the last inning trailing Amarillo by five runs, proceeded to score four runs and put the tying run on and either bring the winning run to the plate or put it on base, but failed to tie the game or win.

YO, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 74 games, the Naturals have stolen 99 bases in 118 attempts (average 1.34 steals/game, 83.90% success rate).

- 99 steals ranks second in the Texas League, tied fifth in Double-A and tied 26th in the Minors.
Maikel Garcia's 23 steals (in 26 attempts) ranks third in the Texas League and tied fifth among all Double-A hitters/basestealers.
The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 49 of 74 games this season (66.2%), including 26 games with two or more steals ... there have been three occasions where the team has stolen five bases, with perfect 5-for-5 steal efforts as a club on 5/13 vs. Wichita and 5/21 @ Arkansas.
The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 14 times, meaning 28 of 9900 steals this year (28.3%) have come on a double-steal.
Naturals players have stolen two bases in a game 11 times, led by FOUR two-steal games from Garcia.

ROCKIN' ROBBIE

After slumping for much of June, first baseman Robbie Glendinning has begun to heat back up in the last two weeks.

- The West Australian is riding a nine-game hitting streak, during which he's collected seven multi-hit games, including four straight to start the streak ... since June 24, Robbie is hitting .462 (18-for-39) with four doubles, seven home runs and a 1.615 OPS, including homers the last FOUR games.
His four-game homer streak, featuring five long balls, is just the fifth four-game homer streak in Naturals history and the second last week, after Nick Loftin opened the week with a four-game home run streak.
21 multi-hit games this season ranks third among Naturals hitters, 19 being two-hit games and a pair of three-hit games, both coming during this streak.
He has reached base in 58 of 64 games he's played this season (90.6%), with hits in 43 of 64.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop Maikel Garcia has reached base in 59 of the 69 games he has played in this season (85.5%), reaching base multiple times on a team-best 39 occasions, including a team-best 23 multi-hit games.

- In 328 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 120 times (83 hits + 37 walks), for a .368 on-base percentage.
Garcia has walked 37 times and struck out 56 times, a 0.66 K/BB rate that ranks third among Royals minor league hitters with at least 250 plate appearances.
The shortstop has the second-most hits in the Texas League (83), ranks third in the league in steals (23) and tied third in doubles (22), while tied seventh in runs scored (53) ... among all Double-A hitters, fourth in hits, tied sixth in steals and tied sixth in doubles.
Maikel's 22 doubles are the most among all Royals Minor League hitters, while he ranks second in the organization with 83 hits, 23 steals and 53 runs scored ... he ranks tied third in the system in walks (37), tied fourth in total bases (116), tied fifth in extra-base hits (26), sixth in batting average (.289) and seventh in on-base percentage (.368).
His 14-game hitting streak between April 27 and May 12 is the longest on the Naturals this year, tied for the 15th-longest in club history and tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in those 14 games, he hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS.

PUSHIN P(ORTER)

Catcher Logan Porter has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among full-season Minor League hitters, Porter ranks SIXTH in on-base percentage (.446) and fifth among all Double-A hitters in OBP ... in the Texas League, he is fourth in OBP and ninth in OPS (.924).
Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter has the highest on-base percentage, ranks third in OPS and batting average (.300) and fifth in slugging percentage (.478) ... his 43 walks are tied for the most in the system, with Omaha's Nick Pratto.
Porter has reached base in 49 of 54 games he's played this season (90.7%), with hits in 45 of 54 and 17 multi-hit games, nine of which came in May.
Porter's 17-game on-base streak between May 31 and June 23 is tied with Robbie Glendinning for the longest on the team this season, a stretch where he hit .321 (17-for-53) with 15 walks and a .493 on-base percentage.

TYLER, THE CREATOR (OF RUNS)

Naturals outfielder Tyler Gentry is as hot as they come, with a great series in Amarillo and fantastic start to his Double-A career.

- Gentry enters tonight's game on a seven game hitting streak, as he's hitting .423 (11-for-26) since June 26, with two doubles, four home runs and 11 runs batted in, having drawn six walks as well, for a 1.462 OPS.
Over his first 16 games at the Double-A level since joining the Naturals June 14, Gentry is batting .311 (19-for-61) with four doubles, seven home runs and 18 runs batted, over one RBI per game, with a 1.110 OPS.
He has hits in 11 of his first 16 games with the Naturals and has reached base in 13 of 16 games.
Gentry is the Royals' organization leader in batting average (.328), slugging percentage (.582) and OPS (1.002), while ranking second in on-base percentage (.420) behind Naturals teammate Logan Porter (.446) ... his 12 total home runs are sixth, while 41 runs batted in between Quad Cities and Northwest Arkansas are 8th.
He ranks among the Top-15 among ALL qualified Minor League hitters in batting average and OPS as well.

Pitchers of the Month (1)

May: LHP Drew Parrish ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

Players of the Week (2)

April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.

May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

Pitchers of the Week (3)

May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.

May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.

June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.
