Tonight's Game: The Sounds and Knights play game three of the six-game series tonight. The Nashville offense awoke in the middle innings last night to coast to victory in a 12-2 win, evening the series. Right-hander Mitch White faces right-hander Sean Burke at Truist Field.

Mitch White: The 29-year-old pitches for the 15th time in a Sounds uniform. He is 4-4 with a 5.61 ERA (33.2 IP/21 ER) since being outrighted to Nashville from Milwaukee on June 3. White took the win in his third start of the season on August 23 vs. Jacksonville. Doing an impression of Greg Maddux, he held the Jumbo Shrimp to a run (earned) on three hits with four strikeouts and 63 pitches (44 strikes) in six innings. White looks to turn the tide compared to his past road appearances - he is 0-3 with an 11.70 ERA (10.0 IP/13 ER) with Nashville away from First Horizon Park, compared to being 4-1 with a 3.04 ERA (23.2 IP/8 ER) at home. He is also 2-1 with a 3.09 ERA (11.2 IP/4 ER) as a starter, compared to being 2-3 with a 6.95 ERA (22.0 IP/17 ER) as a reliever. White was traded to Milwaukee from San Francisco on May 10 - he was also traded to the Giants from Toronto on April 20. The Santa Clara University product was selected in the second round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft by the Dodgers.

Sean Burke: The 24-year-old makes his 15th start with Charlotte this season. He is 1-5 with a 4.77 ERA (54.2 IP/29 ER) with the Knights in 2024. Burke also made three rehab appearances with the Arizona League White Sox on rehab assignment in May, going 0-1 with a 6.14 ERA (7.1 IP/5 ER). He last pitched on August 23 and took the loss at Memphis, allowing three runs (2 ER) in 4.2 innings (3 H, 0 BB, 8 K). Burke last made it through five innings just three times this season, the last being on July 31 vs. Norfolk (W, 3 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 5 K). He took the loss at Nashville on July 24, walking five and hitting a batter but not allowing a hit in 0.2 innings. Since July 5, Burke is 1-4 with a 5.17 ERA despite having a 1.12 WHIP and .183 opponent batting average. Born in Worcester, Massachusetts, Burke attended Saint John's High School in Shrewsbury, Massachusetts and the University of Maryland, College Park. He was selected by the White Sox in the third round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft.

Quality Control: Starter Carlos Rodriguez logged his fourth consecutive quality start and ninth of the season in yesterday's win. His seven-inning outing tied his career high, last accomplished on May 27, 2023 with Biloxi vs. Montgomery. The right-hander is 3-1 with a 2.10 ERA (34.1 IP/8 ER) over his last six starts. He is one of five pitchers in the International League to have nine quality starts this season. Rodriguez leads the league among qualified pitchers in opponent batting average (.202) and ranks among league leaders in WHIP (3rd, 1.21), strikeouts (T-4th, 115), ERA (8th, 4.43) and innings pitched (8th, 113.2). Combining the stats between Rodriguez and other Sounds star starter Chad Patrick, the pair have a 3.72 ERA in 230.0 innings with 229 strikeouts and a .190 (182/957) opponent batting average. The Sounds are 29-10 when Patrick and Rodriguez start (and are 38-50 without one of the two starters).

Hicklen Homering: With his eighth inning homer last night, Brewer Hicklen has homered in back-to-back games for the fourth time this season. His 21st blast of the season moves him into a tie for sixth place in the International League. Hicklen still leads the league with 41 stolen bases on the season - he's also tied for 10th on the Sounds single-season stolen bases list with Rich Thompson (2004) and Leo Garcia (1987).

Good Knights: This season, the Sounds have four active players with batting averages of .300+ against the Knights, minimum 15 AB - Isaac Collins (.317), Owen Miller (.313), Brewer Hicklen (.310) and Vinny Capra (.300).

The Future Brew Crew: The Sounds currently have five of the top 30 Brewers prospects, per MLB Pipeline. They are RHP Jacob Misiorowski (No. 3), INF Tyler Black (No. 4), RHP Logan Henderson (No. 10), RHP Craig Yoho (No. 20), and RHP Carlos Rodriguez (No. 21).

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 750-642 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,342-2,162 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).
