**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 8-2. **Simon Whiteman** opened the scoring with a two-run homer in the bottom of the third inning, his third at Double-A. Erie tied the score, 2-2, in the top of the fourth with a two-run homer by Dane Myers. Richmond moved back in front in the bottom of the fourth inning with a solo home run by **Heath Quinn**, his first hit in his first game back with Richmond since 2019. The Flying Squirrels pulled away with five runs in the fifth inning. **Shane Matheny** hit a solo homer to lead off the frame, **Sandro Fabian** added a two-run double and **Vince Fernandez** brought in two runs with a triple. Richmond starting pitcher **Michael Plassmeyer** matched a career high with nine strikeouts while allowing two runs over seven innings, matching his longest outing of the season.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This series marks the first time the two teams have faced off this season. The Flying Squirrels will travel to Erie for a six-game series from September 13-19 to finish the 2021 season.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 7-17 since July 21. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 11.5 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .234 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.92 ERA for the season.

**THE SEAWOLVES** have won four of the last five games since August 12 and six of the last eight since August 7. Over the last five games, the SeaWolves have outscored opponents 47-10. The SeaWolves are ranked fourth in the league with a .253 team batting average and third with 114 homers. The Erie pitching staff is ranked fourth with a 4.11 ERA. Erie's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 prospects, including LHP Joey Wentz (No. 5), RHP Reese Olson (No. 11), INF Andre Lipcius (No. 23), RHP Paul Richan (No. 26), RHP Elvin Rodriguez (No. 27) and RHP Beau Brieske (No. 29). Prior to this series, the Tigers promoted No. 1 prospect Spencer Torkelson, No. 2 prospect Riley Greene and No. 19 prospect Ryan Kreidler from Erie to Triple-A Toledo.

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Akeel Morris** makes his sixth start for Richmond and his third since returning to the roster from Triple-A. He last pitched in the second game of a double-header on Saturday at Bowie, allowing one run, a solo homer by Johnny Rizer, over 6.0 innings with seven strikeouts. In two starts since returning to the Richmond roster, Morris has gone 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1 ER/12.0 IP), working 6.0 innings in both starts. He made his previous five appearances, including four starts, for Triple-A Sacramento, going 1-3 with a 10.23 ERA. He was assigned back to Richmond on August 1. He signed with the San Francisco Giants on June 19 from the independent Long Island Ducks, where he made two starts and combined for 11.0 scoreless innings of work. Morris, a native of St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands, was drafted by the New York Mets in the 10th round in 2010 and reached the big leagues with them for the first time in 2015. He has also appeared in the majors with the Atlanta Braves and the Los Angeles Angels. After reaching free agency following the 2018 season, Morris signed with the High Point Rockers of the independent Atlantic League to begin the 2019 season, where he pitched as a reliever. He was traded to the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs and then swapped again before making an appearance to the New Britain Bees, where he finished the year going 7-4 with a 4.94 ERA in 16 outings (13 starts). **For more on Morris, see page two.**

**FOR ERIE:** Right-hander Beau Brieske makes his fourth Double-A start. Last time out, he worked 4.0 innings and allowed two runs in a no-decision against Altoona on Friday. He made his Double-A debut on August 1 and allowed two runs over 6.0 innings against Akron. He followed with his first Double-A win on August 7 at Harrisburg, firing 7.0 scoreless innings against the Senators. Brieske began the season with High-A West Michigan, going 6-3 with a 3.45 ERA in 15 starts. At the time of his promotion, he was ranked tied for first in the High-A Central in wins (6), sixth in strikeouts (76) and 10th in innings pitched (62.2). He was named High-A Central Pitcher of the Week twice with the Whitecaps, picking up the award on May 23 and July 18. Brieske was selected in the 27th round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Tigers out of Colorado State University Pueblo.

**BIG FLIES IN BUNCHES:** The Flying Squirrels have hit 18 homers in the last eight games since August 10, which is the most in the Double-A Northeast with Akron and Erie. In that stretch, **Sandro Fabian** has four homers, **David Villar** has hit three, **Brandon Martorano**, and **Diego Rincones** have two and **Vince Fernandez**, **Jacob Heyward**, **Simon Whiteman**, **Shane Matheny**, **Heath Quinn** and **Mitchell Tolman** each have one home run.

**POWER SURGE:** This season, the Flying Squirrels rank tied for fourth in the circuit with 101 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 132 home runs this season in 120 games. The franchise record for the most home runs in a season is 109 in 2013. Richmond's 98 home runs this season is the second-highest homer total in a season in the franchise's history, ahead the entire 2018 (97), 2017 (93), 2019 (84), 2016 (83), 2011 (83), 2012 (76), 2014 (74), 2010 (71) and 2015 (61) seasons. This year, the team has combined for a .394 slugging percentage, which is ninth in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history (Ahead of a .382 mark from 2013).

**LEAVING THE YARD:** The 2021 Flying Squirrels have five players who have reached double-digits in home runs this season, including **Vince Fernandez** (14), **David Villar** (14), **Sandro Fabian** (13), **Frankie Tostado** (11) and **Heliot Ramos** (10). Five players with 10 or more homers ties a franchise record, matching the 2013 season, which included **Jarret Parker** (18 - tied for most in a season in team history), **Adam Duvall** (17), **Javier Herrera** (16), **Andrew Susac** (12) and **Mark Miniccozzi** (10).

**FABULOUS FABIAN:** Over the last eight games since August 10, **Sandro Fabian** is hitting .387 (12-for-31) with four homers and 13 RBIs. He has picked up multiple hits in four of his last eight games, including three hits last Thursday. He hit two homers in the second game of Saturday night's double-header and is now tied for third on the team with 13 this season, which is a new career high.

**BACK IN THE SWING OF THINGS:** In his last seven games since August 10, **David Villar** is batting .367 (11-for-30) with three homers and five RBIs. He is now tied for the team lead with 14 home runs this season, which is also tied for the eighth-most in a season in franchise history. Last Thursday, Villar snapped a season-high stretch of 25 games without a homer, going deep at Bowie. He picked up two home runs in the series finale at Prince George's Stadium on Sunday afternoon.

**GO, DIEGO, GO!** Over his last 25 games since July 17, **Diego Rincones** is batting .302 (26-for-86) with six homers, five doubles, one triple and 19 RBIs. He homered in three consecutive games from July 17-20 and added a fourth on July 29 against Bowie. He hit homers in Bowie last week on Wednesday and Thursday. Over his last 14 games since August 3, Rincones is batting .333 (17-for-51) with two homers, four doubles and eight RBIs.

**GOING STREAKING:** **Mitchell Tolman** saw his seven-game hitting streak end on Wednesday night. In that span, he hit .391 (9-for-23) with one homer, two doubles and four RBIs. He has picked up two hits in two of his last three games, including Sunday's finale at Bowie and Tuesday's series opener against Erie. He has three multi-hit games in his ten played with Richmond since August 4.

**TAKE A WALK:** In 2019, **Jacob Heyward** set the single-season franchise record with 80 walks, surpassing the previous mark held by **Mark Miniccozzi**, who walked 62 times in 2013. Heyward has walked 27 times this season. For his career with the Flying Squirrels, Heyward has worked 107 walks, which sits him in second in the team's history in career walks. The franchise career walks record is held by **Ricky Oropesa**, who walked 113 times in his four seasons with Richmond from 2013-2016.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **David Villar** is tied for ninth with 82 hits. **Simon Whiteman** is fifth with 15 stolen bases. **Trenton Toplikar** is ranked ninth with a 5.23 ERA and tied for 10th with 76 strikeouts. **Patrick Ruotolo** (31/T-3rd), **Joey Marciano** (31/T-3rd), **Matt Seelinger** (30/T-5th) and **Frank Rubio** (29/T-8th) are in the top-ten in the league in games pitched. **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for fifth with seven saves and **R.J. Dabovich** is tied for ninth with six.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have two players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10) and **Tristan Beck** (13 - on IL). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system and **Diego Rincones** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Two players, Wilson (12) and Beck (20), are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
