TONIGHT'S GAMES

The Round Rock Express and Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Houston Astros affiliate) will play a doubleheader Saturday after Tuesday and Wednesday's games were postponed. Round Rock fell 5-2 on Friday. Sugar Land built a 2-0 lead on CF Kellen Strahm's RBI single and 3B CJ Alexander's solo homer before 1B Jonah Bride hit a solo homer to make it 2-1 in the fourth. RF James Nelson answered with a solo shot in the fifth, and the Space Cowboys added two more in the eighth on an E-Train error. DH Nick Pratto's sacrifice fly for Round Rock in the ninth capped the 5-2 loss.

BROADCAST INFORMATION

Tonight's games can be heard live on the flagship home of the Round Rock Express, AM 1300 The Zone. Online audio is also available at am1300thezone. iheart.com and via the iHeart Radio app. Fans can also watch the game with a valid MiLB.tv login or on the Bally Sports Live App. Express Manager, PR & Broadcasting Rylan Kobre handles play-by-play duties.

THE TRAIN IS RUMBLING

Round Rock can guarantee a series split with one win today and claim the series with two victories. It would be the first road series victory of 2026 (0-2) and would mark back-to-back series wins (Last week vs ELP). The Express are 6-3 over their last nine games. In the three losses, they have scored a combined five runs, while totaling 46 runs in the six wins. Five of those six victories have been decided by three runs or fewer, including four by two runs or fewer. The lone win by more than three was a 12-5 victory in Game 2 of Thursday's doubleheader.

DOUBLEHEADER DOMINATION

Round Rock is 26-8 in doubleheaders since the start of 2021 and 22-6 since 2023 (includes suspended games played as two at a later date). They have not lost a doubleheader since July 5, 2019 at Oklahoma City. The last time they lost a doubleheader, Sugar Land manager Mickey Storey was managing the Express. Thursday will mark the eighth doubleheader Sugar Land and Round Rock have played since the start of the 2021 season. The Express are 11-3 in those games. Saturday marks the third doubleheader for the Express in the last seven days.

WALK IT OUT

The Express own a .397 OBP over their last 11 games, third-best in the PCL during that span. Their 77 walks (7.7 per game) lead the league despite playing one fewer game than the next two clubs. Round Rock has drawn seven or more walks in seven of those 11 games, including three games with 10-plus walks.

BRIDE TRIBE

INF Jonah Bride has a hit in back-to-back games and five of last six. He owns a seven-game on-base streak and leads all Express players in batting average (.306), runs (16), home runs (4), RBIs (19) and walks (19). His 20.2% walk rate is T-3rd in the PCL and his .961 OPS is eighth.

GOING FIVE FRAMES

LHP Austin Gomber tossed 5.0 innings on Friday while earning a loss. Round Rock starters have gone 5.0 innings or more in seven of 24 games with Rangers RHP Cal Quantrill throwing three of those. E-Train starters are averaging 3.1 innings per start with a 6.86 ERA (62 ER/81.1 IP).

ON THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - FRIDAY, APRIL 25, 1986

Forty years ago today, Nolan Ryan threw the 203rd complete game of his career as the Houston Astros beat the Cincinnati Reds, 3-1, at the Astrodome. Ryan would not record complete game No. 204 until September 19, 1987—16 months later.

The Reds managed five hits and three walks while Ryan struck out seven. Dickie Thon doubled home the first run in the opening inning, and Glenn Davis followed with an RBI single for a 2-0 lead. Ryan allowed only one run, an Eddie Milner single that scored Buddy Bell in the seventh. Houston added an insurance run on a squeeze play in the eighth to improve to 11-5.

"That's probably as much as I've struggled for an entire game since I can remember," Ryan said afterward. The next day, writer Hal McCoy noted that Dave Concepcion, hitting .188, "would rather fall off a Venezuelan oil derrick than bat against Ryan."

A year earlier, Ryan went 0-3 against Cincinnati in four starts with a 5.27 ERA. In the Houston Chronicle that morning, Astros owner John McMullen was quoted in the front page saying he isn't satisfied in Houston and has considered moving the club to Washington. 1986 was a 25th season celebration in Houston and before this game the Astros honored every single one of their 25 team MVP's in club history.
