YOUNG DRIVES IN THREE IN LOSS: The Yard Goats got four runs batted in and two home runs from Sean Bouchard as they snapped a seven game losing streak with a 5-3 win in yesterday's contest. Chaves Young homered for the third time this series and also doubled for New Hampshire, but Bouchard drove home a pair of runs in the bottom of the eighth to deliver the win for the Yard Goats. Elvis Luciano struck out three in his only inning of work as Nick Frazee followed him with 4.1 innings of work. PJ Poulin got the win for Hartford and Reagan Todd picked up the save, his sixth of the year.

BATTING CROWN: Otto Lopez (now in the Majors), leads Double-A Northeast with a .330 average, and will likely be named batting champion. By rule, he would have to have 2.7 plate appearances per game. Even though he would fall short of that mark by seven plate appearances (over 118 games), his effort would be recognized anyway. An assumption of 0-for-7 would still give him a .322 average. Samad Taylor currently sits third at .300. One can only wonder how Gabriel Moreno would have fared had he not suffered a thumb injury. MLB's #34 prospect was hitting .373 in 32 games for the Fisher Cats.

YOUNG AND WILD AND FREE: Chavez Young is on a nine game hitting streak now, and during that span he is 16-36 (.444). He has five doubles and three home runs, and 10 runs batted in since August 10th when the streak began. His average on the season has been raised from .242 to .274 over the duration of the streak.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: August 21, 2017—The Fisher Cats edged the Rumble Ponies 7-6 in ten innings in Binghamton. New Hampshire opened a 6-1 lead in the top of the sixth on homers by Anthony Alford and Jonathan Davis. Alford homered off Matt Harvey, who was making a rehab start for the Mets. The Ponies rallied to tie with a five spot in the bottom of the sixth. In the tenth (before extra runners), Derrick Loveless walked with the bases loaded. Danny Young tossed two scoreless innings in relief for the win.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays dropped another game, falling 4-1 to the Tigers in ten innings. Robbie Ray struck out 11 batters and went eight innings but the Jays could not push across the winning run with two on and no one out in the ninth. Zach Logue picked up his sixth win as Buffalo won 3-1 against Syracuse. Addison Barger hit a walk off single to lead Dunedin to a 5-4 win over Fort Myers. Vancouver beat Tri-Cities 5-2 as Spencer Horwitz hit his fifth homer. The FCL Jays beat the Yankees 4-1 as the DSL Jays were postponed.

STARTERS:

Reilly Hovis will get the start today against the Yard Goats. Hovis struggled in his last outing, giving up back-to-back-to-back home runs against Harrisburg. He was tagged for a career high seven runs and tied his career high with ten hits allowed in the loss. The last time he faced the Yard Goats he gave up seven hits and four runs in a five-inning outing, including a pair of two-run home runs to Coco Montes.

Ryan Feltner will take the mound for Hartford this evening. His last outing against New Hampshire was perfect, as he went seven innings and struck out nine while allowing just two hits. He has pitched six innings or more in seven of his last eight outings, and has held opponents to a WHIP of 0.98 and an average of .194 this month.

LAST TIME OUT: Started last Sunday in Harrisburg, and didn't make it out of the fifth inning after allowing a career-high seven runs (five earned) on ten hits. Three of the hits were consecutive first inning home runs. Suffered his first loss since his first Fisher Cats game back on June 27.

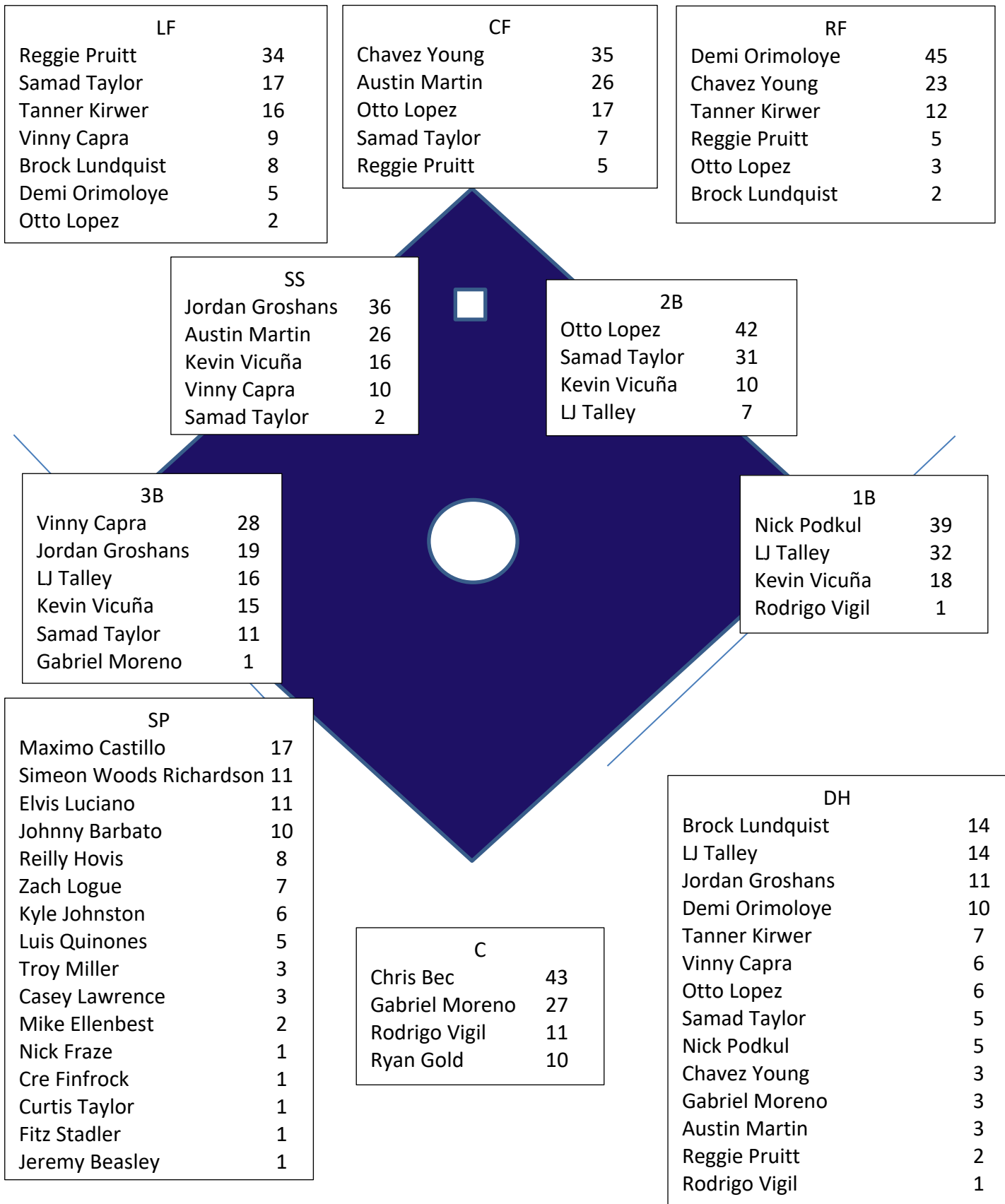
