Brandon McIlwain had a bases-clearing three-run double with two outs in the fifth. Seven of the Ponies' eight runs were driven in with two outs in an inning.

Vasil Among the Eastern League: Here's how Mets' #4 pitching prospect **Mike Vasil** ranks among Eastern League pitchers: 1st in WHIP (0.70), 1st in BAA (.154), 4th in ERA (2.19), and T-4th in SO (46). Vasil's 0.70 WHIP ranks second in all of Minor League Baseball.

Rudickulous: Outfielder **Matt Rudick** extended his hit streak to 10 games with three hits in Tuesday's game. He has 16 hits, four doubles, three homers, and 12 runs batted in over his 10-game hitting streak. Here's how Rudick ranks among Eastern League hitters: 1st in OBP (.463), 2nd in AVG (.322), T-2nd in OPS (1.022), 4th in RBIs (24), 4th in R (29), 5th in SLG (.559), and T-5th in 2B (10). He ranks in the top 5 in the league in seven offensive categories.

BMac Delivers: Outfielder **Brandon McIlwain** extended his hitting streak to eight games on Tuesday. McIlwain had a three-run double and a single with three runs batted in yesterday.. McIlwain has 10 hits and 10 runs batted in across his eightgame hitting streak.

Last Start: Coming off his longest outing of the season, Vasil threw seven scoreless innings at New Hampshire last week. He allowed just three hits and two walks, while striking out five batters. He lowered his season ERA to 2.19.

2022: Went 4-2 with a 3.53 ERA in 18 appearances and 17 starts across three levels. Made eight starts for both St. Lucie (A) and Brooklyn (A+). Went 3-1 with a 2.19 ERA for St. Lucie and 1-1 with a 5.13 ERA for the Cyclones. With St. Lucie, he allowed opponents to bat .193 against him. With Brooklyn, opponents hit .197 against him. He totaled 85 strikeouts in 71.1 innings across the three levels.

BACKGROUND: Begins the 2023 season ranked as the Mets' No. 4 pitching prospect and the No. 11 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline. Pitched for the Peoria Javelinas in the 2022 Arizona Fall League, alongside teammate Brandon McIlwain with Ried Brignac as a coach on the staff. He was drafted by the Mets in the eighth round of the 2021 draft out of Virginia. Helped lead UVA to the College World Series in his final season as a junior in 2021, while ranking in the top 10 in the ACC in strikeouts looking (33), wins (7), and innings pitched (81.2). Was the 2017 Massachussetts Player of the Year and Perfect Game's No. 1 overall player out of Mass. and the No. 7 pitcher in the country out of high school
