### SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

**WELCOME TO THE TOP-100:** MLB Pipeline announced on Saturday that **C Jefferson Quero** entered the Top-100 prospect list at No. 100... Quero, the third-ranked prospect in the Brewers system, entered the list after **RHP Grayson Rodriguez** graduated from prospect status... Quero is one of 12 batters 20 years-old or younger in Double-A this year... He joins **OF Jackson Chourio** and **OF Sal Frelick** as the three Brewers to appear on the MLB Pipeline Top 100... In 25 games this year, Quero is slashing .283/.323/.511 with six home runs and has thrown out 41% (9-22) of baserunners.

**THE JOURNEY TO BILOXI:** After today, the Shuckers will return back to MGM Park for a 12-game home stand, tied for their longest of the 2023 season... Starting on Tuesday, the Shuckers will play 12 games over 13 days at MGM Park against the Montgomery Biscuits (TBR) and the Pensacola Blue Wahoos (MIA), and they're set to play 24 of their next 36 at home... The Shuckers are 10-8 at home this year and won four of six in their last home series against the Rocket City Trash Pandas.

**WAY UP AND OVER THE SCOREBOARD:** **C Jason Lopez** smashed his first home run of the 2023 season on Saturday night, a solo shot over the scoreboard in left... The homer marked his first since July 3, 2022 with the Shuckers against the Mississippi Braves, snapping a 24-game drought... Over Lopez's eight-year MiLB career, the catcher has hit 23 home runs.

**THE YOUNG AND RESTLESS:** Entering today's game, the Shuckers lineup is the youngest in Double-A... Per *Baseball-Reference*, which uses playing time to weight and measure the average age, the average Shuckers hitter is 22 years and six months old... For comparison, the oldest lineup in Double-A is the San Antonio Missions (SDP) with an average age of 26 years and three and a half months... The Shuckers roster has six players who enter today at 22 years old or younger with **OF Jackson Chourio** being the youngest player in Double-A at 19 years old.

**MOVING TOWARDS HISTORY:** Shuckers manager **Mike Guerrero** enters today needing 10 more wins to reach 1,400 in his managerial career... Guerrero is in his 25th season in Minor League Baseball in 2023 and his 24th with the Brewers organization... Over his seven-year managerial career in Biloxi, Guerrero has earned a two trips to the Southern League Championship Series, in 2018 and 2019... Guerrero also led the Shuckers to a franchise-best 82 wins during the 2019 season, a year after he led the Shuckers to a then-record 81 wins.

**TODAY'S STARTER // RHP CARLOS RODRIGUEZ (1-2, 2.84):** RHP Carlos Rodriguez is set to make his eighth start of the year after tying his season-low with three innings in the series opener on Tuesday... Rodriguez, the 10th-ranked prospect in the Brewers system, is currently the highest ranked pitching prospect on the Shuckers active roster... The righty enters today third in the Southern League with a .164 opponent's average.
