Lopez Goes 4-for-4 in 7-2 Fisher Cats Win: Otto Lopez went 4-for-4 with a pair of doubles and Maximo Castillo allowed one run in five innings as the New Hampshire Fisher Cats (Blue Jays Double-A affiliate) defeated the Somerset Patriots (New York Yankees) 7-2 on Friday night at Delta Dental Stadium. Lopez also scored three times for the Fisher Cats (4-6).

EARLY STREAKS: Lopez extended his hit streak to eight games with his first inning single. He became the first New Hampshire player to record four hits in a game since Alberto Mineo in July of 2019. Lopez leads the 2021 Fisher Cats with 15 hits, including five doubles.

WINNING FORMULA: Maximo Castillo (W, 1-1) became the first New Hampshire starter since opening night to record a win. The 22-year old allowed five hits, walked two and struck out four. It was the first win at the Double-A level for Castillo.

MORENO STAYS HOT: Gabriel Moreno went 2-for-4 with an RBI single in the third inning and is 14-for-28 on the season. His .500 batting average is tops among all Double-A hitters, and tied for fourth among all Minor League players as of May 14. Moreno has hits in each of his first seven games, and is 7-11 in this series.

COMING UP: The final game of the only series with Somerset is at 1:35 p.m. tomorrow. New Hampshire will also be home next week, playing six games with the Portland Sea Dogs (Boston Red Sox Double-A affiliate).

ROSTER MOVES: May 13: Pitcher Sean Rackoski placed on 7-Day IL. May 12: Catcher Rodrigo Vigil (pronounced vee-HEEL) has been activated on the New Hampshire roster. The 28-year old is a veteran of 473 minor league games, all in the Marlins organization.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: May 15, 2010 – The Fisher Cats topped Portland 5-0 at Delta Dental Stadium to improve to 24-12, the best start in team history. Kyle Drabek went seven innings, allowing six hits, to earn the win before a standing room only crowd of 7,035. Trystan Magnuson finished up the win. Offensively, Adam Calderone went 3-for-4 with a home run.

FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays lost to the Phillies 5-1 last night in Dunedin. Vladimir Guerrero Jr. hit his ninth homer....Triple-A Buffalo won 5-2 over Rochester. Bryan Baker earned his first save of the season. The Bisons beat Fisher Cats alum Sean Nolin, who started for the Red Wings...Vancouver used a Tanner Kirwer grand slam in an 8-2 win over Spokane...Dunedin lost to Bradenton 8-4.

ON THE HILL: LHP Zach Logue makes his third start of the season, and first at home in 2021. Had mixed results in Portland. Earned the win opening night with five scoreless innings, then allowed a couple of homers in Sunday's 12-6 loss in which he went 4.2 IP. The 25-year old was selected by the Blue Jays in the 9th round of the 2017 draft (Kentucky). This is his 21st Double-A start (4-7, 4.15 ERA) – and first against Somerset.

The Patriots turn to Luis Gil (HEEL) in the fifth game of the series tonight. The 22-year old RHP, on the Yankees 40-man roster, makes his third start. Opened twice in the Harrisburg series, but didn't figure in the Decision in either game. Impressed while rising through the Yankees organization, with 275 career strikeouts in just 213.2 IP. 2019 was 4-5 with 2.39 ERA for Class-A Charleston, making 17 starts. Also won his only decision in three starts for Adv. A Tampa. This is his first start against New Hampshire.
