Lopez also scored three times for the Fisher Cats (4-6).</li> <li>EARLY STREAKS: Lopez extended his hit streak to eight games with his first inning single. He became the first New Hampshire player to record four hits in a game since Alberto Mineo in July of 2019. Lopez leads the 2021 Fisher Cats with 15 hits, including five doubles.</li> <li>WINNING FORMULA: Maximo Castillo (W, 1-1) became the first New Hampshire starter since opening night to record a win. The 22-year old allowed five hits, walked two and struck out four. It was the first win at the Double-A level for Castillo.</li> <li>MORENO STAYS HOT: Gabriel Moreno went 2-for-4 with an RBI single in the third inning and is 14-for-28 on the season. His .500 batting average is tops among all Double-A hitters, and tied for fourth among all Minor League players as of May 14. Moreno has hits in each of his first seven games, and is 7-11 in this</li> </ul>
