YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels won the series opener against the Curve, 6-2. Victor Bericoto hit an RBI single in the first and another in the second to open a 2-0 lead. The Curve evened the score, 2-2, in the second with an RBI single by Jase Bowen and a double steal. Bryce Eldridge gave the Flying Squirrels a 4-2 lead in the fourth with a two-run triple. In the fifth, Andrew Kachel brought in a run on a fielder's choice and Carter Howell added a sac fly to extend the lead to 6-2. Jack Choate picked up his first Double-A win, allowing two runs over five innings with five strikeouts. Mat Olsen pitched two scoreless innings and Tanner Kiest retired all six batters he faced to end the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Altoona Curve in the second of a six-game series, the final games of the 2024 season. The Flying Squirrels dropped four-of-six against the Curve at The Diamond from June 4-9. From July 30-August 4 in their other visit to PNG Field this year, the Flying Squirrels dropped the first four games of the series before winning the last two. The Curve won four-of-six at The Diamond from August 20-25.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won seven-of-nine, including the first five games of last week's series against Akron. In their last 20 games since August 18, the Flying Squirrels are batting a league-best .266 (181-for-681) and averaging 9.1 hits per game (181 total), also the best in the league, and averaging 5.0 runs per game (100 total). In their last 20 games since August 18, the Flying Squirrels have homered 17 times after hitting six homers in their previous nine games from July 27-August 17.

THE CURVE are 9-4 in their last 13 games dating back to August 27, including a six-game sweep against the Fisher Cats from August 27-September 1. The Altoona roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including INF Terrmarr Johnson (No. 4), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 5), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 7), LHP Hunter Barco (No. 18), OF Jase Bowen (No. 27) and OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list includes four Altoona players, including Johnson (No. 3), Solometo (No. 7), Barco (No. 8) and Cheng (No. 18).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Nick Sinacola makes his 15th Double-A start and his fourth against the Curve. He last pitched last Thursday, allowing one run in five innings in a no-decision against the RubberDucks at The Diamond. For the year, Sinacola leads Giants Mil.B pitchers (min. 90 IP) in BAA (.216) and WHIP (1.03) while ranking second in BB/9 (2.08) and second in walk percentage (5.8%). He made his Double-A debut on June 6 against the Curve at The Diamond and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings. In his next five starts from June 12-July 4, he went 3-0 with a 1.33 ERA (4 ER/27.0 IP). Sinacola began the season with High-A Eugene and went 4-1 with a 2.68 ERA in 10 outings, including two starts. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Sinacola ranked second among Northwest League pitchers (min. 40 IP) in WHIP (0.79), third in BB/9 (1.56), third in BAA (.190), inith in ERA (.268), and 10th in K/9 (8.48). He spent the entire 2023 season with the Emeralds and went 2-5 with a 4.58 ERA over 23 outings (20 starts). Sinacola was selected by the Giants in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine, where he was the America East Pitcher of the Year that season as a senior. FOR ALTOONA: Left-hander Dominic Perachi makes his eighth Double-A start and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched last Wednesday at Hartford and surrendered five runs over four innings in a no-decision. On August 23, he started at The Diamond and allowed one run over six innings to pick up his first Double-A win. He began the season with High-A Greensboro and made three appearances before being promoted to Double-A in late-April. In his three games with the Curve, he posted a 4.91 ERA before being sent back to the South Atlantic League in mid-May. Perachi was selected by the Pirates in the 11th round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Salve Regina University in Rhode Island.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 90 groundball double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 21 double plays this year, which is the most in the minor leagues. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. They matched that feat with four double plays in the first four innings at Harrisburg on August 16 with Bertrand pitching. Those four double plays were tied for the most induced by a pitcher in the Eastern League dating back to 2005, which is the first year those statistics are readily available. It has been accomplished by three other Richmond pitchers, including **Daryl Maday** in 2010, **Clayton Blackburn** twice in 2014 and **Garrett Williams** in 2019. Bertrand's 21 GIDPs this year are tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history, trailing only 27 by **Craig Westcott** in 2012 (second-most in the Eastern league since at least 2005).

WELCOME HOME, BRYCE: Bryce Eldridge was assigned to the Flying Squirrels last Tuesday. The 19-year-old first baseman was selected with the 16th pick in last year's MLB Draft out of Madison High School in Vienna, Va. With his debut, he became the fifth player in Flying Squirrels franchise history born in Virginia, joining Jarrett Parker (2013-14), Matt Winn (2016-19),(2018-19) Connor Overton and Spencer Bivens (2023). At 19 years, 10 months and 14 days old, Eldridge became the second-youngest player in franchise history, trailing only Anyesber Sviira (2019) and just landed of Heliot Ramos 2019, 2021). As the 16th player selected in last year's draft, Eldridge is the seventh-highest draft pick in franchise history, trailing only Joey Bart (2, 2018), Hunter Bishop (10, 2019), Patrick Bailey (13, 2020), Tyler Beede (14, 2014), Will Bednar (14, 2021) and Will Wilson (15, 2019). This season, Eldridge leads the Giants organization in homers (23), RBIs (90), SLG (537), OPS (914), hist (191), extra-base hits (51) and total bases (218) and ranks second in doubles (26), second in runs (72), third in batting average (.293), fourth in OBP (.377) and sixth in walks (55).

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 68 games dating back to June 6, Victor Bericoto is hitting .301 (81-for-269) with seven homers, 17 doubles, 16 walks and 44 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on August 9 off the scoreboard in left-center at The Diamond. Dating back to August 24, Bericoto has homered three times in his last 12 games including a grand slam on September 1 at Erie. Last Thursday, he hit the second walk-off hit of his Flying Squirrels career, a 10th-inning single to beat Akron, 7-6. Bericoto has an RBI in seven consecutive games, tied for the longest streak by a player in the Eastern League this season and tied for the longest in franchise history, even with a seven-game streak by Clay Timpner from April 28-May 10, 2010.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: Diego Velasquez is batting .347 (17-for-49) in his last 13 games dating back to August 22, including a four-hit game that day against Altoona. He has 10 hits in his last eight games played with five RBIs. Among Giants full-season fourth in hits (119), tied for seventh in triples (4), ninth in total bases (151) and fifth in stolen bases (21).

HOWELL AT THE MOON: Carter Howell has collected 18 hits in his last 15 games since August 21, batting .295 (18-for-61) with a double and 10 runs scored. In the Eastern League this season, Howell is ranked first in doubles (30), tied for first in triples (6), fourth in hits (119), fifth in extra-base hits (39) and tied for eighth in total bases (170).

PACKING THE HOUSE: For the season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels are ninth in average attendance. In 2022 and 2023, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance for the first times in franchise history. This year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history.

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 13 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Aviia (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2023), Grant McCray (2024) and Sandro Fabian (2021). Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-24 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers), Fabian (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS: The have been 61 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, a new franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 31 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearances by **Andy Thomas** on June 1 against the SeaWolves and **Luis Toribio** on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 32 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season.

PROSPECT WATCH: Three of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including 1B Bryce Eldridge (No. 3), OF Vaun Brown (No. 11) and SS Diego Velasquez (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Eldridge (No. 1), Velasquez (No. 15) and LHP Jack Choate (No. 19).
