FRES-NOTES

TOUGH TUESDAY: The Fresno Grizzlies (22-17) dropped a 7-1 affair to the Visalia Rawhide (16-23) Tuesday morning from Chukchansi Park. The Grizzlies fell to 22-3 at home and 43-12 all-time against the Rawhide. The Grizzlies have still won 21 of their last 26 contests against their Highway 99 rivals. Fresno moved to 8-3 overall in day games, 6-2 in the first contest of a series and 5-2 on Tuesdays. The Grizzlies offense mustered just one run on five hits, three walks and one hit-by-pitch. Fresno scored their lone run in the bottom of the first when Braylen Wimmer lifted a sacrifice fly to right field, netting G.J. Hill. The former Diamondbacks prospect in Hill struck out a leadoff double prior to crossing the plate. Grizzlies' catcher Ben McCabe was not retired, reaching base three different ways (single, walk, hit-by-pitch). Fresno southpaw Albert Pacheco (1-2) was tagged with the loss after permitting seven runs (four earned) over four and two-thirds innings of work. Pacheco struck out six, but ran into trouble all game long. He finished with 107 pitches, the most by a Grizzlies arm in a game this season. A quartet of relievers followed Pacheco with four and one-third scoreless frames. Jake Madden, Tyler Hoffman and Braden Carmichael all struck out a batter in their appearance.

HIGHWAY 99: The Fresno Grizzlies and Visalia Rawhide (Arizona Diamondbacks Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Chukchansi Park. This is the first of two regular season series between the clubs in 2024 and the only meeting in Fresno. The Grizzlies are 22-3 at home (three sweeps) and 43-12 all-time against the Rawhide. The Grizzlies have also won 21 of their last 26 contests against their Highway 99 rivals. On the other side, four of the Rawhide's 12 wins have come via one-run walk-offs. The two cities are 39.26 miles from one another, or if you drive non-stop, 43 minutes or so. From Fresno to Visalia, you would drive in a southeast direction, following the CA 99 route.

TRANSACTIONS: The Colorado Rockies made a trio of transactions on May 21 that affected the Fresno Grizzlies roster. OF Jake Snider (High-A Spokane) and RHP Collin Baumgartner (Double-A Hartford) were promoted after fantastic starts to their seasons. Additionally, RHP Cade Denton was assigned to Fresno from the ACL Rockies, taking the place of Baumgartner in the bullpen. Snider played in 34 games, going 32-for-103 (.311 AVG/.497 OBP/.495 SLG/.992 OPS) with two homers, two triples, nine doubles, 20 RBI, 25 runs (one walk-off run), 33 walks, seven hit-by-pitches and eight stolen bases. The Louisville product left Fresno ranked first in the California League with 33 walks, first with a .497 OBP and second with a .992 OPS. Snider's triple on April 24th against San Jose was his 12th in a Grizzlies uniform, leaving him one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples. Baumgartner appeared in 14 games out of the bullpen, going 2-2 with four holds, one save, a 1.42 ERA and 0.68 WHIP, while opponents batted .119 against him. In 19.0 frames, Baumgartner permitted three runs (earned), on seven hits, six walks and one hit-by-pitch while fanning 30 batters. Over eight games in April, Baumgartner went 2-0 with three holds, a 0.43 WHIP and .057 batting average against him. In 11.2 scoreless innings, Baumgartner allowed two hits and three walks while striking out 21. Finally, Denton re-joins the Grizzlies after finishing 2023 with the club (four games in relief). Denton was selected by the Rockies in the 6th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Oral Roberts University and is ranked as the #29 prospect in the system according to MLB.com. He mainly attacks with two pitches (sinker and slider) that move in opposite directions and work against both lefties and righties. Denton played travel ball growing up with current Grizzlies LHP Braden Carmichael.

PEREZ PITCHES: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Bryan Perez. Perez signed with the Rockies as an International Free Agent on January 15, 2021 out of the Dominican Republic at 16 years old. He was considered the Top Pitching Prospect Signee by the Rockies in that signing period. Perez is the nephew of former MLB All-Star, World Series champion and No-Hitter recipient Edinson Volquez.

AN ACE IN JACE: Grizzlies' RHP Jace Kaminska has been lights out over seven starts this season. Kaminska is 3-1 with a 1.26 ERA and 0.87 WHIP, with the latter two ranking first in the California League. In 35.2 innings, he has allowed five runs (all earned), on 24 hits, seven walks and two hit-by-pitches while punching out 39. Kaminska has started two of Fresno's five shutout wins this season. He has tossed 18 straight scoreless innings (spanning three starts), allowing 12 hits and four walks while striking out 18.

WELINTON WINS CALIFORNIA LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Grizzlies' LHP Welinton Herrera was named by Minor League Baseball as the California League Pitcher of the Week for May 13-19. Herrera's dominant relief outings in Stockton helped the Grizzlies earn a series victory against the Ports. Herrera appeared twice out of the bullpen during the six-game series against Stockton. On Tuesday, May 14, Herrera hurled two perfect innings, striking out three of the six batters he faced (24 pitches, 18 strikes). Then, on Saturday, May 18, Herrera chucked a season-high three innings of sensational relief. Herrera did not permit a hit or run, walking one batter and fanning five (37 pitches, 24 strikes). Overall, Herrera dazzled for five shutout frames, allowing no hits or runs, walking one and punching out eight. The 20-year-old Dominican gives the 2024 Grizzlies their second California League award this season (Jack Mahoney). Fresno won 10 California League honors (Weekly and Monthly) in 2023 and 14 California League honors (Weekly and Monthly) in 2022, a franchise record. More on Herrera below.

HERRERA IS NOT HORSEING AROUND: Grizzlies' LHP Welinton Herrera has been unbelievable out of the bullpen this season. Over 12 games, Herrera is 3-1 with a 2.41 ERA and 0.80 WHIP, while opponents are batting .176 against him. In 18.2 frames, Herrera has permitted five runs (earned), on 12 hits, three walks and three hit-by-pitches while fanning 35 batters. The southpaw has 10 consecutive scoreless outings from April 12-May 18. Herrera has tossed 16 innings, allowing six hits, three walks and one hit-by-pitch while striking out 30 in that stretch. The 20-year-old is in his second season stateside and grew up on a ranch with horses in the Dominican Republic.

RISP IS A RISK: In the month of May, the Grizzlies hold a 9-10 record with 59 total runs scored (3.11 runs a game). A big reason for the lack of offense is the Grizzlies' inability to score with runners in scoring position (RISP). Over the 19 games in the month, Fresno is 36-for-163 (.220) with five different instances where the team went 0-for-0 with runners in scoring position. They have also left 150 runners on base in May. Yesterday, the Grizzlies went 0-for-5 with RISP and left six runners on base.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies INF Andy Perez has had an outstanding season (37 games), going 42-for-149 (.282 AVG/.331 OBP/.443 SLG/.774 OPS) with four homers (one grand slam), three triples, six doubles, 21 RBI, 17 runs, 11 walks and two stolen bases. Perez had hit safely in his first 18 games and 23 of first 24 games to start the season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. It was the second longest hit streak in the Grizzlies/Rockies affiliation since Drew Romo in 2021 (21 games, July 6-August 15) and it was the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball at the time. Perez went 26-for-76 (.342 AVG/.383 OBP/.579 SLG/.962 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), three triples, three doubles, 18 RBI, 12 runs, five walks and two stolen bases in that hit streak stretch. Perez's triple on April 24th against San Jose was his 10th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him three triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.
