## INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Malcom Nuñez smacked a two-run shot in the fourth inning, but the Indianapolis Indians dropped a 3-2 decision to the lowa Cubs on Saturday night at Victory Field. Trailing 1-0 in the fourth after Chase Strumpt singled home the game's first run, Indianapolis capitalized on a two-out fielding error by scoring a pair of runs. With Liover Peguero on first base, Malcom Nuñez blasted a two-run homer for his seventh long ball of the season to give Indy the lead. lowa responded in the top of the fifth with back-to-back doubles by Darius Hill and Bryce Windham to knot the score at 2-2. One inning later, the I-Cubs recaptured the lead thanks to an Alexander Canario sacrifice fly to cap lowa's scoring.

MALCOM MASHES ONE: Malcom Nuñez plated the Indians lone two runs last night with his seventh home run of the season in the fourth inning. He has now hit safely in each of his last four games, going 5 -for- 15 with two extra-base hits and two RBI. His last home run came on May 23 at lowa, a series in which he hit two long balls as the Indians piled them on, and three total run-scoring extra-base hits. Against the I-Cubs this season, he is hitting . 286 (12-for-42) with seven runs, two doubles, three home runs, six RBI and a . 948 slugging percentage.

BAE'S BACK: Playing in the second game of his rehab assignment after being assigned to Indianapolis on Friday, Ji Hwan Bae went 2-for-4 last night to tie Malcom Nuñez for the team's most individual hits in the game. Bae has been a consistent Triple-A hitter across his time with Indianapolis, logging a . 362 batting average (38-for-105) in 29 games this season and . 306 batting average ( 170 -for- 556 ) in 146 career games with the Indians since his Team MVP campaign in 2022.

RING CITY: Southpaw Martín Pérez began a rehab assignment with Indianapolis last night and tossed 5.0 two-run innings with no walks and four strikeouts, exiting with the game tied to take a no-decision. The outing improved an impressive career vs. the I-Cubs, going 3-1 with a 2.41 ERA (9er/33.2ip) and 24 strikeouts. The 33 -year-old was placed on the 15 -day injured list on May 28 (retroactive to May 27) with a left groin muscle strain. In 11 starts with Pittsburgh, he went 1-3 with a 4.71 ERA (30er/57.1ip) and 46 strikeouts. He won 10 games across 35 appearances ( 20 starts) with the World Series Champion Texas Rangers last season. In 44 career games (42 starts) in Triple-A since 2011, he is 18-12 with a 4.29 ERA (114er/239.1ip) and 158 strikeouts. He was originally signed by the Rangers as a non-drafted free agent out of Guanare, Venezuela on July 2, 2007. He had his contract first selected on Nov. 18, 2011 and made his MLB debut on June 27, 2012, vs. Detroit.

PITCHING LESSONS: The Indians' overall 1.88 ERA (20er/96.0ip) over the last 11 games leads all 30 Triple-A teams and is the second-best mark among 120 full-season minor league teams since June 11 (trailing Double-A Hartford, 1.82 [20er/99.0ip]). The Indians' bullpen has been at the center of that success, logging an International League-best 0.88 ERA (4er/41.0ip) in that time. None of Geronimo Franzua (4.2ip), Brent Honeywell (6.0ip), Chris Gau (3.0ip), Isaac Mattson (5.0ip), Ben Heller (2.0ip) or Justin Bruihl (1.0ip) have allowed a single run during that stretch.

TODAY: The Indians close out their lone homestand vs. the lowa Cubs, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago Cubs, today at 1:35 PM ET at Victory Field. The Indians and I-Cubs faced off at Principal Park in Des Moines, lowa, from May 21-26, splitting the series 3-3. In that series, the Indians launched 14 home runs. In a rematch of the series opener, RHP Domingo Germán (1-4,6.16) will take the mound against LHP Thomas Pannone (4-6, 4.19). The starters were the pitchers of record as Indianapolis defeated the l-Cubs, 4-2, with Germán logging Indy's fifth quality start and Pannone taking his third loss of the season against Indianapolis. Pannone has surrendered 13 earned runs in 11 innings against Indy this season.

DOMINGO'S DAY: Domingo Germán is set to make his seventh start with the Indians and third against lowa today at 1:35 PM after earning his first win of the season on Tuesday. In the outing, which was Indianapolis' fifth quality start of the season and third over the past two weeks, he logged 6.0 two-run innings with six strikeouts. In his past two starts (10.1ip), he has allowed just three earned runs combined after allowing three-or-more earned runs in each individual start prior. Against lowa this season, he is $1-0$ with a 4.76 ERA (6er/11.1ip) and 10 strikeouts.

THIS DATE IN 1997: Tim Belk went 5 -for-6 with a double, home run and four RBI as the Indians put up 18 runs on 20 hits in an $18-2$ win vs. lowa. Belk wasn't the only one with a standout performance, as Brian Hunter went 4-for-6 with four RBl of his own and a Victory Field era record-tying three doubles. Future International League Hall of Famer Chad Mottola joined the four-hit club with a home run and two RBI. The Indians pitching staff added to the overall dominance, allowing just two runs with nine strikeouts between starter Giovanni Carrara and Mike Walker.

## TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Domingo Germán: Right-hander Domingo Germán is set to make his seventh start of the year for Indianapolis against the lowa Cubs, today at 1:35 PM at Victory Field.

Last Outing: Germán toed the rubber for his second career start against the I-Cubs on $6 / 18$ as he punched out five batters across 6.0 innings while picking up his first win of the season.

Against the I-Cubs: Germán made his second career start against lowa on $6 / 18$, taking the win while only allowing two runs in his longest outing of the season.

Historic Germán: Domingo Germán spent the 2023 season with the New York Yankees. He made 20 total appearances (19 starts) while tossing the 24th perfect game in major league history on $6 / 28$ at 0akland which was the fourth in Yankees history. He was placed on the restricted list on $8 / 2$ and missed the remainder of the season.

Miscellaneous: Germán was signed by the Florida Marlins as an international free agent on May 27, 2010. On Dec. 19, 2014, he was traded to New York (AL) with RHP Nathan Eovaldi and RF Garrett Jones in exchange for RHP David Phelps and 3B Martin Prado. He had his contract first selected by the Yankees on November 4, 2016 and he made his MLB debut on June 11, 2017 vs. Baltimore. He was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on
March 16, 2024.
