Last Night: Whitecaps 11, Lugnuts 10 (10 innings). The Caps scored four runs off of Lugnuts second baseman Joshwan Wright, pressed into emergency pitching duty in the 10th inning, and then held on tight to snap Lansing's season-high four-game winning streak. MSU Spartan Marty Bechina went 3-for-4 with a walk, HBP and four RBIs in his Nuts debut.

On Deck: The division-leading Dayton Dragons roll into Lansing on Tuesday, opening up a six-game series with a Grand Slam School Day at 11:05 a.m.! Then Wednesday is a Dog Days of Summer with dogs welcome to the ballpark, followed by a Labatt Blue Thirsty Thursday, a LAFCU Frontline Friday on Biker Night, and, coming up on Saturday, May 14, the return of EAT-A-PALOOZA, where \$25 admission brings you in for all-you-can-eat food!

#### Lug•Notes

Congratulations: Right-hander Jeff Criswell was named the Midwest League's Player of the Week after nearly delivering Lansing's first ever individual no-hitter in Saturday's Game 2 at Lake County, settling instead for the Lugnuts' first 7-IP complete game since Jack Cushing at Great Lakes on July 9, 2021, a one-hitter with six strikeouts on just 65 pitches. The Nuts have two no-hitters in franchise history: a three-pitcher nine-inning no-no in 2003 vs. Dayton, and a two-pitcher six-inning no-hitter in defeat in 2016 at Peoria. Criswell's shutout is the second in all of Minor League Baseball this year and the first in the Midwest League as well as the Midwest League's first complete game.

Go Green: UT Marty Bechina joined the Lugnuts yesterday from Triple-A Las Vegas, becoming the second Spartan to play for the Lugnuts (joining 2011 outfielder Eli Boike). Bechina played four years at Michigan State University, where he competed against the Nuts in the 2016 and the 2017 Crosstown Showdowns. The Chicago native was drafted in the 32nd round in 2019 by Oakland. He

Coincidence: The Lugnuts have lost four-run leads twice this year. Each came against West Michigan. Each led to an 11-10 defeat.

Best in the League: Lansing's offense leads the Midwest League in batting average (.255) by 11 points above second-best West Michigan and 56 points above last-place Beloit. The Lugnuts are the hardest team to strike out in the circuit (214 K's) and also boast the most base hits in the league (210) while ranking third in the league in on-base percentage (.332).

Amongst the MWL Leaders: Outfielder Lawrence Butler is fourth in the Midwest League with 19 walks, infielder Euribiel Ángeles is fourth with 31 hits, southpaw David Leal is fourth with a 0.69 WHIP, and reliever Angello Infante is tied for first with five saves and tied for second with nine appearances.

Let's Play Two... Again: The Lugnuts have played doubleheaders in each of their first five series of this season, getting swept in a twinbill at home against the Captains on April 9, splitting two at West Michigan on April 14, getting swept in two at home against Fort Wayne on April 23, splitting last Saturday's doubleheader at Lake County, and sweeping Wednesday's doubleheader against West Michigan. Last year, the Lugnuts played seven doubleheaders, four in September.

**165 Major League Nuts...:** Infielder **Vinny Capra** (2018 in Lansing) debuted for the Blue Jays on May 1, becoming the 165th all-time Nut to reach the Majors and the fourth this year, joining A's relievers **Zach Logue** and **Zach Jackson** and Oakland infielder **Christian Lopes**.

Talent Rich: The Nuts boast the No. 1 prospect in the Athletics' organization in Tyler Soderstrom, a 20-year-old catcher drafted 26th overall in 2020 who is considered MLB Pipeline's No. 56 prospect in all of baseball. Soderstrom is one of six Top 25 A's prospects on the roster, joining teenager Brayan Buelvas (No. 10) and Euribiel Ángeles (No. 11), starting pitcher Joey Estes (No. 18), first baseman/outfielder Lawrence Butler (No. 20) and pitcher Jeff Criswell (No. 21).

# 26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

#### **Today in Lugnuts History**

**2010:** The Nuts brought a 4-0 lead to the bottom of the 9th at Parkview Field, but the TinCaps rallied to tie the game thanks to errors by 2B Ryan Schimpf and 3B Sean Ochinko and a passed ball by A.J. Jimenez. In the 10th, a surprise storm blew in, causing Casey Beck to throw back-to-back wild pitches with a wet ball, bringing in Jonathan Galvez with the winning run in a frustrating 5-4 TinCaps win. Less than ten minutes after the game had ended, the sky was clear and blue again.


**Personal:** Drafted in the 20th round in 2017 from the Puerto Rico Baseball Academy and High School (Gurabo, Puerto Rico) and signed away from Alabama State University commitment... signing scout: Hector Stewart.

PRBHS History: Founded in 2002 by Ed Correa, who first used the Los Angeles Dodgers' Dominican complex in Las Palmas, DR, in 1999 as what would become the Puerto Rico Baseball Academy and High School three years later... produced Carlos Correa (1st overall in 2012), Hiram Burgos, Joe Jiménez, Vimael Machin, Jesmuel Valentin and Christian Vázquez... this year produced one draftee, Astros 16th-rounder Gaby Nieves... in 2017, when Berríos was drafted, he was one of four players drafted from PRBHS.

Puerto Rican Baseball: Puerto Rico has produced four Hall of Famers thus far in Roberto Clemente, Iván Rodríguez, Roberto Alomar and Orlando Cepeda, with 1996 Lugnuts outfielder Carlos Beltrán and current catcher Yadier Molina each with their own Hall of Fame cases... today's Major League stars from Puerto Rico are led by Javier Báez of the Tigers, Francisco Lindor of the Mets, José Berríos of the Blue Jays, and Carlos Correa of the Twins... Lindor, like Osvaldo Berrios, was born in Caguas.

**Pro Debut - 2017 in AZL:** Made professional debut on July 1, 2017, vs. AZL Giants, allowing three runs on five hits in 1 2/3... final appearance of the year was his best (3 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K) vs. AZL SD1 on September 2... gave up .302 avg. to lefties, .366 to righties... base-stealers were 4-for-6.

**2018 in AZL:** Relieved Daulton Jefferies in the second game of the season, tossing 3 2/3 innings (6 H, 1 R, 5 K) vs. AZL Giants Black... pitched six-inning gem (3 H, 1 R, 4 K) on the 4th of July vs. AZL White Sox... gave up just two earned runs in final 17 2/3 innings... limited righties to .252 avg./.628 OPS while lefties hit .348/.860... base-stealers were 6-for-6.

**2019 in AZL and the NYPL:** Opened season with AZL A's Gold, making four appearances... in first game of the year, appeared in relief on June 17 and struck out six AZL Cubs2 in 3 2/3 innings, allowing only one hit... tossed five-inning gem (4 H, 1 R, 4 K) on July 1 vs. AZL Dodgers, earning promotion to Short-Season A Vermont... finished the year with best outing for the Lake Monsters, August 29 vs. Connecticut in Game 2 of doubleheader (5 IP, 1 H, 2 BB, 4 K)... with Vermont, gave up .326 avg./.855 OPS to right-handed hitters while lefties hit .241/.770... base-stealers went 1-for-1 in the AZL and 7-for-9 in the New York-Penn League.

2021 in Low-A West: Received the Opening Day start for the Stockton Ports, May 4 at Modesto, allowing two-run homer to Nuts catcher Matt Scheffler in the second inning but nothing further in four innings, striking out five... by month: May (4 G, 2 GS, 17 1/3, 3.63, .231, 0.98 WHIP)... June (5 G, 3 GS, 23 1/3, 8.49, .350, 1.89 WHIP)... July (4 G, 3 GS, 18 2/3, 4.82, .282, 1.39 WHIP)... August (3 GS, 16 IP, 6.19, .308, 1.44 WHIP... in best outing, whiffed nine batters in 5 2/3 innings, July 6 at Modesto, allowing two runs on four hits and two walks... vs. left-handers: .320/.379/.484, 3 HR... vs. right-handers: .283/.333/.514, 9 HR... base-stealers stole 22 bases in 26 attempts.

2021 in High-A Central: Promoted to Lansing on August 19, replacing starter Jack Cushing (promoted to Double-A Midland; the RockHounds' 2022 Opening Day starter, coincidentally)... enjoyed a smashing debut, limiting Great Lakes to two runs in six innings, August 20 at Dow Diamond... followed up with six scoreless innings of seven-hit relief at West Michigan, August 26, earning the win... faced the Whitecaps in back-to-back home starts to end the year, allowing two runs in three innings in a no-decision September 15, and suffering the loss on the final day of the year, September 19: 2 1/3 IP, 6 H, 8 R, 3 BB, 3 K, serving up a solo HR to Jake Holton in the 1st inning and knocked out by a six-run 3rd... Whitecaps won the game, 19-4, to end the season with an identical 58-62 record as the Lugnuts.

Winter Ball: Pitched for Cangrejeros de Santurce – a cangrejero is a crabber – in Liga de Béisbol Profesional Roberto Clemente, who finished 17-15 in 3rd place and were knocked out in the playoff semifinals by champs Criollos de Caguas... appeared in six games in relief: 5.87 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 9 H, 5 R, 2 BB, 6 K... the Santurce Cangrejeros were the same team that the great Clemente himself played for in the early 1950s... the 1954-55 Cangrejeros had both Clemente and Willie Mays in their outfield.

2022 - Return to Lansing: Followed Joey Estes to the mound and pitched the final three innings in relief against Michigan State in the 2022 Crosstown Showdown presented by Delta Dental, allowing one run and striking out three in Lugnuts' 3-2 win... moved into the starting rotation when Jake Walkinshaw and Hogan Harris landed on the Injured List just prior to the season... made 2022 debut April 12th at West Michigan, allowing five runs in four innings (one in the 1st, four in the 2nd)... departed with Lugnuts trailing 5-4... Nuts tied the game in the 9th on a pinch-hit RBI single from Jonny Butler and took a 10-6 lead in the 11th, only to see West Michigan walk off with 11-10 victory thanks to a five-run rally.
