Today's Game

The Fightin Phils begin a six-game series at the Chesapeake Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. It is the first/second-of-12 matchups between the teams this season and first and second-of-six at Prince George's Stadium in Bowie. Reading went 3-6 against the Baysox in 2024, going 1-2 in Bowie and 2-4 at FirstEnergy Stadium. Chesapeake returns to Reading from Aug. 26-31.

Game 79 Recap

The Fightin Phils dropped their third-straight game on Sunday, a 4-2 defeat at Somerset. Reading went with a bullpen game and Jack Dallas started, allowing one run over two innings, with a season-high five strikeouts. Travis Kuhn suffered the loss, allowing two runs over 1.2 innings, with two strikeouts. Gunner Mayer (1.1 IP), Saul Teran (1.0), Andrew Walling (1.0) and Andrew Bechtold (1.0) each did not allow an earned run out of the bullpen. Alex Binelas had two more hit and Carson DeMartini also had two hits, including his first Double-A home run.

It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller has become a threat on the basepaths this season. Miller is currently tied for first in the Eastern League with 31 stolen bases, a mark that ranks second in the Phillies organization. After his 31st stolen base on Saturday, Miller is the first R-Phil to swipe 31+ bags in a season since Roman Quinn had 31 in 2016. Johan Rojas was the last Fightin Phil to have 30, as he did so in 2023. Miller is just the fifth Reading player to have 30+ stolen bases in a year since the 2010 season. Additionally, Miller has been strong since moving to the leadoff spot on June 3. He has 19 walks and 20 strikeouts over 94 plate appearances batting first (20% walk rate), which compared to 21 walks and 53 strikeouts in the two hole across 189 plate appearances (11% walk rate).

The First for DeMartini

Carson DeMartini launched his first Double-A home run on Sunday at Somerset. He enters play on Tuesday riding a Double-A high 13-game on-base streak, dating back to June 20 (.368 OBP). DeMartini's 13-game on-base streak is the fifth-longest on-base streak by a R-Phil this season. DeMartini also has stolen nine bases since his Double-A debut on June 10, which is tied with Aidan Miller for fourth in the Eastern League over that stretch.

Binelas Brings the Boom

Alex Binelas stayed red-hot with two more hits on Sunday at Somerset. Since June 11 (21 games), Binelas is slashing .348/.392/.594 (.986 OPS), with 13 runs, five doubles, four home runs and 20 RBI. Since June 11, Binelas holds the following Eastern League ranks: 2nd AVG (.348), T-5th HR (4), T-1st RBI (20), 4th SLG (.594), 5th OPS (.986), T-10th hits (24) and T-10th TB (41). Since his Reading debut on May 27, Binelas is hitting .393 with RISP and .310 with two outs.

On The Move

Prior to Wednesday night's game at Chesapeake, the Philadelphia Phillies announced a variety of transactions to the Fightin Phils roster. Tristan Garnett makes his return to Reading as he was activated off the 60-day IL and Mitch Neunborn returns to Double-A after starting for Lehigh Valley on Sunday. To make room on the roster, Estiebznon Jimenez was placed on the Development List and Saul Teran was transferred back to Jersey Shore (A+). Additionally, Felix Reyes was placed on the 7-day IL and Luis Verdugo was reinstated from the Development List.

Anthony the Alumni

Former Fightin Phil Keaton Anthony, who started the season with Reading and played in 49 games prior to being called up to Lehigh Valley (AAA) on June 11. Anthony is currently riding a 41-game on-base streak, dating back to May 11. His 41-game on-base streak is currently the longest active on-base streak in all of Minor League Baseball and the third-longest in MiLB this season. Max Anderson of Erie recently snapped a 44-game on-base streak, which is the longest in 2025.

This Day in Baseballtown History

July 9, 1925: At Rochester, after flying out to lead off the 9th inning, Reading outfielder Howard Camp enters the stands, bat in hand, to chase a heckler. The fan runs away and the police quickly gather to escort Camp back into the dugout. The game, a 5-2 Rochester win, was "marked by considerable scrapping among the players of both clubs."

Down by the Bay

Chesapeake enters tonight with a 34-45 overall record and are 3-9 in the second half, which sits in last place in the Southwest Division. The Baysox dropped four-of-six games against Richmond, winning games on Wednesday and Thursday last week. After this week, Chesapeake is at Erie the weekend after the All-Star Break before going to Altoona for six games. Chesapeake's roster features nine of the Orioles' top-30 prospects: Enrique Bradfield Jr. (2), Patrick Reilly (9), Nestor German (10), Creed Williams (11), Trey Gibson (14), Braxton Bragg (15), Juan Nunez (20), Trace Bright (25) and Alex Pham (29).

Baysox Arms

Righty Levi Wells starts game one tonight for the Baysox. Over 13 games/10 starts this season, Wells is 0-4, with a 2.86 ERA (16 ER, 50.1 IP). On July 3 at Richmond, Wells allowed one run on three hits over four innings in a no-decision. Wells spent his first pro season in 2024 with Aberdeen (A+), going 0-9, with a 6.71 ERA over 21 starts. The 23-year old was a fourth round pick by the Orioles in the 2023 draft out of Texas State, where he played from 2022-23. Wells began his college career at Texas Tech in 2021. Righty, and Orioles No. 14 prospect, Trey Gibson makes his sixth start tonight for Chesapeake in game two. He is 2-1, with a 2.05 ERA (6 ER, 26.1 IP), with 31 strikeouts. Gibson earned the win July 2 at Richmond, tossing seven-shutout frames, allowing one hit and striking out six. He went 1-2, with a 5.12 ERA over nine games with Aberdeen (A+) to start the season. The 23-year old signed with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent in 2023 out of Liberty. Gibson pitched at Liberty from 2021-22.

Aoyagi struggled in his second outing with Reading, suffering the loss. He surrendered a season-high six hits and two home runs, while also hitting three batters. His command was better, with only two walks allowed and he matched his season-most with three strikeouts. After allowing one run in the first, Aoyagi was tagged for four runs in the second, then one more in the third before being lifted from the game. Aoyagi was relieved by Jack Dallas in the top of the third inning.

After tossing a scoreless first, McGarry was tagged for a run each in the second and third, before allowing four runs in the fourth prior to being lifted from the game. McGarry was relieved by Nelson Alvarez in the top of the fourth inning.

- Participated in Spring Breakout Game on March 14 vs Pirates
- Began season with Reading (AA), as he was transitioning back to starter after spending all of 2024 as relief pitcher
