Last Time Out: Led by Blade Tidwell and two home runs, the Binghamton Rumble Ponies beat the Somerset Patriots 4-2 on Wednesday to move into a tie for first place in the Northeast Division. Tidwell allowed just two runs over a careerhigh 7.2 innings with seven strikeouts and no walks in his first Double-A win. Jeremiah Jackson hit a two-run homer, his first long ball as a member of the Mets' organization and Mateo Gil blasted a two-run shot to extend the lead.

Blade Was Sharp: Mets' top pitching prospect **Blade Tidwell** earned his first Double-A win on Wednesday at Somerset. The 22-year-old struck out seven and allowed just two runs over a career-high 7.2 innings. Tidwell holds the lowest ERA in the minor leagues (1.92) since earning his first High-A win on May 17. He is now tied for 14th in all of Minor League Baseball with 121 strikeouts this season.

Steady Stuart: Mets' No. 7 pitching prospect **Tyler Stuart** currently leads all qualified pitchers in Minor League Baseball with a 1.70 ERA this season. Stuart has thrown three quality starts in four starts at the Double-A level and is coming off seven scoreless innings against New Hampshire last Thursday. Stuart has a 1.70 ERA and 99 strikeouts in 100.2 innings of work across High-A (14 starts) and Double-A (4 starts) this year, in his first full professional season.

Action Jackson: Newly acquired infielder Jeremiah Jackson crushed his first home run as a member of the Mets' organization on Wednesday at Somerset, with a goahead two-run homer. Jackson has reached base safely in all six games and has totaled six runs batted in with Binghamton. The former second-round pick in 2018 hit 15 home runs with Double-A Rocket City this year and now has 16 total homers.

Hayden's Day: Catcher **Hayden Senger** had an all-around game on Wednesday against Somerset. Senger had a multi-hit game with a double and single, his sixth multi-hit game of the year. He also threw out two would-be base stealers at second base to end innings, including as part of a strike 'em out, throw 'em out double play in the fifth inning. He crushed a two-run home run on Tuesday in the series opener.

What's at Stake?: With a win today, the Binghamton Rumble Ponies would move into sole possession of first place in the Northesast Division in the second half.

Last Start: Stuart threw seven scoreless innings, while allowing just three hits and two walks with five strikeouts against New Hampshire at home on Thursday night. He faced the minimum in five of his seven innings of work and threw 15 pitches or fewer in all seven frames. He induced two 4-6-3 double plays, including one to end his outing in the seventh.

2022: Stuart was drafted by the Mets in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Southern Miss. Stuart made three total appearances and two starts across the Florida Complex League and Low-A St. Lucie after being drafted.

BACKGROUND: Stuart is currently ranked as the Mets' No. 7 pitching prospect and No. 16 overall prospect in the organization, by MLB Pipeline. Stuart did not pitch for the first two seasons at Southern Miss, redshirting in 2019 and not seeing action in the shortened 2020 season. He was primarily a reliever, making 35 appearances and four starts across 2021 and 2022. As a redshirt junior in 2022, Stuart pitched to a 4-0 record in 22 appearances and four starts, while holding a 3.38 ERA. He tossed 1.2 scoreless innings against LSU in the Hattiesburg Regional last season, across two outings for the regional champions. Stuart was a three-sport standout in high school in baseball, football, and basketball. He broke Herscher High School's all-time receiving record in football with 2,064 yards, including a 793-yard and 10-touchdown senior campaign. Was second on the team in scoring, while leading the team in rebounds and assists as a senior in basketball. He was First Team All-State and a Collegiate Baseball Second Team All-American to end his three-year varsity baseball career.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo.
