The Round Rock Express and Sugar Land Space Cowboys will open their six-game series at Constellation Field on Tuesday night. Express RHP Adrian Sampson is scheduled to take the mound against Space Cowboys RHP Misael Tamarez. First pitch is set for 6:35 p.m. CT.

RENO TAKES THE SERIES FINALE

The Aces stole the series finale on Sunday at Dell Diamond by a final score of 3-1 over the Express. Round Rock scored first with a solo home run by LF Derek Hill in the first inning to jump out to a 1-0 lead. 2B Kolton Wong answered with his own solo shot for Reno in the top of the second inning to even the game at one. With two outs, the Aces took a 2-1 lead in the sixth inning thanks to an RBI single by SS Sergio Alcantara. Wong raced around and scored from second base. A solo home run in the seventh inning by DH Adrian Del Castillo extended the lead for Reno to 3-1. The Express threatened with two baserunners in the ninth inning but could not collect a run. Round Rock reliever, RHP Kyle Barraclough (1-1, 6.59), took the loss after 3.0 innings out of the bullpen. He allowed two runs on three hits and two walks with five strikeouts. Reno starter RHP Chris Ellis (2-3) 4.44) was credited with the win after pitching 7.0 innings, allowing just one run on three hits and one walk with seven strikeouts. Aces reliever RHP Scott McGough earned his first save of the season after throwing a shutout ninth inning

SAMPSON IN THE SERIES OPENER

Express RHP Adrian Sampson is slated to take the mound in the series opener on Tuesday. In his last five starts, the right-hander is 4-0 with a 2.17 ERA (7 ER/29.0 IP) with seven walks and 20 strikeouts. Left-handed hitters are batting .208 (16-77) against him while right-handed batters own a .340 average (32-94).

SINCE WE SAW YOU LAST...

The last time the E-Train played at Constellation Field they dropped four of six games and were 9-12 after the series. Since the last time they met, Round Rock has gone 16-7 and they own a 3.33 ERA (76 ER/205.1 IP). On offense, the E-Train scoring 6.1 runs per game over their last 23 games. In May, the Express have a 12-5 record and they've won four consecutive series.

CLIMBING THE HILL

Express OF Derek Hill had his contract selected by the Texas Rangers on Tuesday and will join the team in Philadelphia for tonight's game. In 34 games, Hill was slashing .333/.387/.659 with 10 doubles, four triples, eight home runs, 16 RBI, 30 runs scored with nine walks and 35 strikeouts. His eight home runs are the third-most for his career. He did not get eight home runs until June 13 last year when he hit 11 dingers for the season.

KNAPPY BOY

Express C Andrew Knapp is third in the PCL in batting average (.370), second in on-base percentage (.451), ninth in slugging percentage (.580) and fourth in OPS (1.046). He also owns a a six-game hitting streak. He'd have a 10-game hitting streak had he not pinch-hit and struck out in the ninth inning on May 12 vs Las Vegas.

BATTLE FOR THE FIRST HALF

This will be the last meeting between Round Rock and Sugar Land in the first half of the season. The two teams will not meet again until July 1.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win

campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
