TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Albuquerque Isotopes (Colorado Rockies) will prepare for game four of their six-game set on Friday night. Express RHP Adrian Sampson is slated to take on Albuquerque LHP Josh Rogers. First pitch is scheduled for 7:15 p.m. CT from Dell Diamond.

ONE-RUN ALBUQUERQUE WIN

The Isotopes took game three of the series last night by a final score of 4-3 at Dell Diamond. They have now won each of the last two games in the series. Albuquerque got on the board first in the top of the third inning after 2B Hunter Stovall scored on a sacrifice fly by SS Greg Jones. RF Sandro Fabian leveled the game at one in the bottom of the fourth for Round Rock with a solo blast over the pitch clock in center field. The Isotopes jumped back in front, 2-1, in the top of the eighth after LF Nolan Jones plated fellow Jones, Greg, on a double. Nolan would later score on a passed ball to increase the Albuquerque lead to 3-1. Four singles allowed the E-Train to tie the game at three in the bottom of the eighth frame. Fabian knocked in LF Dustin Harris before 1B Blaine Crim drove in C Andrew Knapp. The Express looked like they were going to take the lead as SS Jonathan Ornelas singled to left field but Nolan Jones used his Major League arm to nab Fabian at the plate. A solo home run by 1B Grant Lavigne gave Albuquerque a 4-3 lead. In the ninth inning, RHP Matt Koch secured the win to collect his third save of the season for the Isotopes.

SAMPSON'S TURN

Round Rock RHP Adrian Sampson is scheduled for his 22nd start of the year on Friday. He is one of seven pitchers in the Pacific Coast League to reach 100.0 innings on the mound. After going 8-3 with a 4.73 ERA (38 ER/72.1 IP) in his first 14 starts, Sampson has gone 0-4 with a 10.08 ERA (31 ER/27.2 IP) in his next seven. He has more walks in his last seven outings (17) than in his first 14 (16).

LEITER LIGHTS OUT

Express RHP Jack Leiter recorded all 11 of his outs yesterday via strikeout as he went 3.2 innings with one earned run on one hit and a walk. His 11 strikeouts set a new career high. He threw 41 of 62 pitches for strikes while 15 of his 34 fastballs were clocked at 99 miles per hour or higher. He is the first E-Train pitcher to strike out 11 batters this year. The last time an Express pitcher recorded 11 strikeouts came June 30, 2022 against Las Vegas.

CRIM WITH TWO MORE HITS

Express INF Blaine Crim went 2-for-4 with an RBI on Thursday. In his last 36 games, Crim is slashing .402/.490/.567 with nine doubles, four homers, 23 RBI, 20 runs scored, 23 walks and 20 strikeouts. Since July 1, among players with 100 plate appearances in the PCL, Crim's average exit velocity is sixth at 89.1.

J.O. GETS ABOARD

Round Rock INF Jonathan Ornelas extended his on-base streak to 22 games following a 1-for-3 night that included a walk. This season, the E-Train has had three players with an on-base streak over 20 games as INF Blaine Crim posted a 32-game on-base streak while OF Dustin Harris collected a 30-game streak.

PLAYOFF UPDATE

The Express enter tonight's game 4.5 games behind Tacoma for the second playoff spot in the second-half standings. Las Vegas, Reno, Salt Lake and Albuquerque are all in front of the E-Train.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
