About the Last One: Looking for their first win of the series, the Baysox held on to a 5-3 lead in extras, as **Andrew Daschbach** homered twice in Friday night's contest, his first two Double-A homers, to power Bowie to a win. Leading 3-1 with two outs in the bottom of the ninth, Reading homered to tie the game and send it to the 10th. That's when Daschbach homered for the second time on the night, and **Diogenes Almengo** held on in the home half of the inning to shut the door.

Playoff Push: The top two teams in the Double-A Northeast League by winning percentage, regardless of division will compete in a Best-of-5 playoff series beginning the Tuesday after the regular season concludes. With 27 games remaining in the season after today, Bowie is in third place, one game out of a playoff spot. The Akron RubberDucks and Portland Sea Dogs are in first and second, respectively.

Game One

Gray's Day: Starting game one of the doubleheader for Bowie will be right-hander **Gray Fenter**. He has not allowed more than two runs in an outing since July 1st, and has allowed one run or less in three of his last four. In one appearance against Reading this year, all the way back on May 11th, Fenter threw 3.2 innings and allowed one run on two hits, with two walks and six strikeouts. In the Other Corner: Making a rehab start for Reading in game one will be righty **Zach Eflin**. He has been out since July 20th with patellar tendinitis in his right knee, and is looking to rejoin the Philadelphia Phillies soon. The expectation is for Eflin to throw between two-three innings, with the hope being that Eflin could return to the majors for his next start.

Game Two

Brnovich on the Bump: In game two, Bowie will turn to righty **Kyle Brnovich**. Brnovich was with High-A Aberdeen in May when Reading last played the Baysox. Since being promoted to Double-A, Brnovich's strength has been his longevity in outings, going less than four innings in just one of his appearances for Bowie. In the Other Corner: Starting on the mound in game two for Reading will be the right-hander **Hans Crouse**. He was acquired by the Phillies at the trade deadline this year in a six-player trade with the Texas Rangers. In two starts so far with the Fightin Phils, Crouse has allowed just one earned run (a home run) in 9.1 innings. He had a 3-2 record with a 3.35 ERA in 13 starts with Double-A Frisco before being traded.
