SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

HOME, SWEET, HOME: Today marks the first game of a 12-game homestand for the Shuckers, their longest of the season... The Shuckers will play 12 home games in 13 days against the Birmingham Barons and Pensacola Blue Wahoos... The homestand is Biloxi's longest since June 20 to July 3, 2023, when the Shuckers played 12 games in 14 days against the Chattanooga Lookouts and Mississippi Braves.

The Shuckers will play 18 of their next 24 games at Shuckers Ballpark including 12 of the 18 against North Division opponents... Biloxi has played just 15 of their first 39 games at home.

<u>BACK IN BILOXI</u>: Through 15 home games this season, the Shuckers have a .667 win percentage (10-5), tied for the fifthhighest in Double-A... The Shuckers have won two of their first three home series and have split one.

** At Shuckers Ballpark, **1B Ernesto Martinez Jr.** leads all qualified batters on the Shuckers with a .308 average (16-for-52)... Martinez Jr. also leads Biloxi with 12 RBI at home in 2024.

<u>I'M A BOEVELIEVER</u>: With a 2-for-5 game on Sunday, **3B Mike Boeve** recorded his 11th multi-hit game in 26 games since being promoted to Double-A... Boeve has recorded a hit in 19 of 26 games with Biloxi.

Boeve enters today among the Southern League leaders in average (5th, .311), slugging percentage (7th, .453), OPS (7th, .818) and on-base percentage (8th, .365).

FROM BILOXI TO THE BIGS: RHP Bradley Blalock was recalled by the Milwaukee Brewers on Monday and is set to become the 72nd former Shucker in franchise history (since 2015) to make their MLB debut.... He's also set to become the fifth former Shucker to make their debut during the 2024 season.

Over seven starts with the Shuckers, Blalock led the Shuckers with a 2.27 ERA and struck out 29 batters in 35.2 innings... Blalock tossed 17 consecutive scoreless innings over three starts to begin his Double-A career.

IHE NEW FACES: The Shuckers added 1B/3B Ben Metzinger and RHP Blake Holub to the roster on Monday from Triple-A Nashville... Metzinger is set to make his Double-A debut after splitting this season between High-A Wisconsin [6g] and Triple-A Nashville [1g]... Holub, who made 15 appearances with Nashville, is set to make his Shuckers debut... Holub made 30 appearances with Double-A Erie in the Detroit Tigers system during the 2023 season, helping lead them to the 2023 Eastern League title, the first in franchise history.

COME GET YOUR STRIKEOUTS: The Shuckers' staff enters today with 388 strikeouts in 39 games, the third-most in Double-A and the most out of any team in the Southern League... The Shuckers are on pace for 1,372 strikeouts in 2024, a mark that would break the franchise record of 1,361, set during the 2023 season.

<u>LET'S GO PROSPECTING</u>: The Biloxi Shuckers roster features five Brewers Top-30 prospects, including **RHP Jacob Misiorowski** (No. 1, No. 33 overall), the organization's best pitching prospect... The other four are; **INF Brock Wilken** (No. 5), **INF Eric Brown Jr.** (No. 10), **INF Mike Boeve** (No. 13) and **RHP Brett Wichrowski** (No. 14).

TODAY'S STARTER // LHP NATE PETERSON [1-2, 3.58]: Peterson makes his eighth start of the year and his fourth at home during the 2024 season... Over his last two starts, Peterson has allowed two runs over 10 innings, a 1.80 ERA... Against left-handed batters this season, Peterson has limited them to a .195 average (8-for-41) with a 26% strikeout rate.
