Jersey Shore BlueClaws (31-25) at Greensboro Grasshoppers (31-24)

First National Bank Field - Greensboro, North Carolina (opened 2003) LHP Braeden Fausnaught (5-1, 3.19) vs RHP Derek Diamond (3-0, 2.56) Series: Game 6 of 6 (BlueClaws lead season series 3-2 of 12)

Last Time Out... Trailing 5-0 entering the eighth inning, the BlueClaws scored four times in the eighth and four more in the ninth, storming back to top Greensboro 8-6 on Saturday night at First National Bank Field...Leandro Pineda gave the BlueClaws the lead with an RBI single after Otto Kemp had tied the game with an RBI single of his own...Justin Crawford, Kemp, and Andrick Nava all had two hits for the BlueClaws.

State of the Claws...The BlueClaws have won three straight games after dropping the first two in Greensboro and are a half-game behind Greensboro with 11 games to play in the first half (which ends June 20th)...They are 22-12 since May 1st...Jersey Shore split six games with Brooklyn last week...The BlueClaws have been as many as 4.5 games out and as many as 1.5 games up... They were 1.5 games out at the start of this series... The BlueClaws are trying to make the post-season in back to back years for the second time in team history (2009-10).

For First Place...A win today would give the BlueClaws a half-game lead with nine games left to play (they will be 1.5 games out with a loss today)...They BlueClaws have not been in sole posession of first place since May 14th when they

Comeback Claws...The BlueClaws erased a five-run deficit, their largest comeback win of the season (their largest last year was six (5/24/23 at Aberdeen in a game they trailed 8-2 and won 12-10)...The win was their third in which they trailed entering the ninth inning (4/5 vs Aberdeen – Opening Night, 5/21 at Aberdeen, and 6/8 at Greensboro).

Welcome to Greensboro...The BlueClaws are in Greensboro for six games this week (BlueClaws lead 3-2) against the first place Grasshoppers...Jersey Shore and Greensboro will play 12 games in June, their only 12 meetings of the season (GBO will be in Lakewood from June 25th – 30th)...The BlueClaws went 3-9 against Greensboro last year, 1-5 in New Jersey and 2-4 in North Carolina

Go Go Leandro...Leandro Pineda enters today on a 13-game hitting streak over which he is 19-55 (he extended it with the game winning 9th inning single on Saturday)...He had two hits on Tuesday and Thursday and homered on Friday...He is now 26-80 in his last 20 games to get back to .306 on the season...He leads the team with six home runs on the year after hitting nine last year and also leads the team with 37 RBIs...Pineda had a different 13-game hitting streak through May 12th, the longest by a BlueClaw this season...Last season, Pineda hit .243 (.298 in the second half with an .852 OPS and .193 in the first half with a .607 OPS).

William The Kid...William Bergolla, the BlueClaws youngest player (19), hit his first professional home run on Saturday night...He is 28-87 since he entered the April 30th game at .145 for the year...He is 20-58 in his last 15 starts...The #12 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline, Bergolla is one of just six 19 year olds to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A affiliate (including teammates Justin Crawford and Bryan Rincon who were 19 when they debuted with Jersey Shore last year and have since turned 20).

Hot Hitting Otto...Otto Kemp is 29-81 since May 14th with four home runs, five doubles, four triples, nine walks and three stolen bases...He is hitting .331 with the BlueClaws this year...He was Phillies Minor League Player of the Month

for May, hitting .337 over 24 games with a 1.034 OPS and a .453 OBP...Kemp has also played first (his first four professional games there), second, and third base this year, plus one inning in right field (he caught a fly ball to end the win on May 19th at Hudson Valley), his first professional appearance in the outfield... He finished last season with the BlueClaws, hitting .223 in 31 games...Kemp signed with the Phillies out of Point Loma Nazarene (CA) in 2022.

Going for Three (Hundred)....The BlueClaws enter the day with both Otto Kemp (.331 in 145 ABs) and Leandro Pineda (.306 in 186 ABs) over .300 in at least 140 at bats this season...The last time a BlueClaw hit over .300 in at least 200 at bats was in 2016 when Zach Coppola hit .324 and Josh Tobias hit .304.

Jumpin Justin...Justin Crawford enters today with three straight two-hit games (over which he is 6-14), his 16th 17th, and 18th multi-hit games of the season to lead the BlueClaws...He was a double shy of the first cycle in BlueClaws history on May 30^{th} but went 3-5 with a grand slam...He enters today at .281 on the seson and leads the BlueClaws with 19 stolen bases (he has 76 in his career)...He had a four-hit game on May 7^{th} (the second by a BlueClaw this year following William Bergolla on April 6th)...He was the 17th overall pick in the 2022 draft from Bishop Gorman HS in Las Vegas and is the 15th former first-round pick to play for the BlueClaws.

A Multi-Home Run Game...Otto Kemp hit two home runs on Wednesday night, his third and fourth of the season, and the 11th and 12th of his career...Kemp also had three hits in the win on Wednesday...Kemp's 2-HR game was the first by a BlueClaw this year and the first since Gabriel Rincones, Jr. had one at Hudson Valley last year on August 14th...Last year, the BlueClaws had six 2-HR games (Rixon Wingrove 3, Kendall Simmons, Leandro Pineda,

A Career Season...Andrick Nava had two more hits on Thursday and Saturday after he hit a solo home run and had three hits on May 28th...Since May 4th, Nava is 22-58 with a home run and five doubles and 10 RBIs...Nava has two HRs on the season after he hit three with the BlueClaws last year, adding a .221 batting average...Nava has beer with the BlueClaws since August of 2022 and turned 22 in October.

EB1...Erick Brito had two more hits on Friday night and now has 11 multi-hit games with the BlueClaws this year – two more than he had from June 13th (when he arrived) through the end of the season last year with Jersey Shore...He enters the day at .275 on the year with a .348 OBP...Last year with the BlueClaws he hit .208 with a .310 OBP)...He also has added nine stolen bases while only being caught once

Lock it Down...Daniel Harper earned his 5th save of the season on Saturday, the first BlueClaws save since May 28th...Harper leads the team with five...Gunner Mayer has three...Andrew Walling and Charles King each have two.

Going Gone ... The BlueClaws (11 HRs in Lakewood and 20 on the road) have four home runs this week – two by Otto Kemp, one by Ryan Leitch, and one by Leandro Pineda...Pineda leads the team with six on the season...Kemp has three, while Crawford, Cade Fergus, Troy Schreffler, and Jordan Dissin have three apiece.

Strike 'em Out Danny...LHP Danny Wilkinson, a Scotch Plains native, has 28 strikeouts in just 16.1 innings this season...Last year, he fanned 106 batters in 56.2 innings with Clearwater...Wilkinson signed with the Phillies in 2022 out of Villanova.

Three Saves for Gunner...Gunner Mayer has earned his first three professional saves over the last few weeks (two at Aberdeen between May 21st and 26th and May 28th against Brooklyn)...He has moved to the bullpen this year and struck out 27 batters in 21 innings (27 of the 83 batters he faced)...Last year as a starter, Mayer had a 5.47 ERA with 79 strikeouts in 77.1 innings pitched...He was a 5th round pick in 2019 from San Joaquin Delta JC (CA).

Harper Locks It Down...Daniel Harper has allowed four earned runs in 21.2 innings so far this year with 30 strikeouts...Since May 1st, he's allowed one run in 14.2 innings with 20 strikeouts...Harper was an 18th round pick in 2022 from the University of Kentucky...He also has five saves on the year.

Keep On Chuck-king... Charles King earned a save on April 6th in his professinal debut...He threw two scoreless innings on May 19th to earn his first professional win...King signed with the Phillies in February after spending the two previous seasons with the Padres as a biomechanical pitching analyst...He had not played competitive baseball since graduating TCU in 2021 before signing with the Phillies after spending the winter at Driveline in Scottsdale...14 of his 18 outings this year have been scoreless outings and he has two saves.

Trying For Back to Back...The BlueClaws have only made the playoffs in back to back years once - in 2009 and 2010, both SAL Championship seasons...They have a chance to do so again this year after reaching the SAL Northern Division Championship Series last year.

Youth Is Served ... Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws have five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3rd youngest), Bryan Rincon (9th), Justin Crawford (11th), Hendry Mendez (17th), and Emmaarion Boyd (21st).

In the First Round...Justin Crawford is the 15th former first round pick to play for the BlueClaws and the fourth to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A team (Andrew Painter

and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 first-round pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.

Go Phils...The BlueClaws have several players that grew up Phillies fans: C Jordan Dissin (went to Malvern Prep in Philadelphia, 27 miles from Citizens Bank Park), OF Troy Schreffler (from Harrisburg), and LHP Braeden Fausnaught (from Danville and went to West Chester University).

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws had an Opening Night walk-off win when Emaarion Boyd scored on a wild pitch...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.
