RAKE COUNTY GOES YARD TWICE: Lake County scored 2 of its runs via the long ball on Saturday night. In the bottom of the 4<sup>th</sup> inning, DH Wuilfredo Antunez hit a leadoff home run to extend the Captains' lead to 2-0. One frame later, RF Alfonsin Rosario, MLB Pipeline's No. 25 Guardians prospect, hit a leadoff home run to give Lake County a 3-0 advantage. Rosario is the only Guardians Minor Leaguer with 10+ HR this year, leading the Cleveland PD System with 11.

YORMAN'S SCORELESS START: RHP Yorman Gómez (W, 5-0) earned his 5<sup>th</sup> win of the season with a scoreless start on Saturday night. The right-hander pitched 5 shutout innings, allowing just 3 H and 2 R, while throwing 5 K in 84 pitches (57 strikes).

IT'S COMEBACK SEASON: Each of the first 4 games of this series were won in comeback fashion. Lake County overcame deficits of 2-0, 3-2, and 5-4 in the first 3 games, while Dayton overcame a 1-0 deficit in its 2-1 win on Friday night. The Captains broke this streak on Saturday night with a wire-to-wire 4-2 win.

DEFEND THE 'SHIP: This season, the Captains are looking to win back-to-back Midwest League Championships. <u>Lake County will look to record the 7th instance of a franchise winning consecutive MWL titles.</u>

# **TRENDS & NOTABLES**

SANTOS STANDS ALONE: On Jan. 30, it was announced that Manager Omir Santos would return for his 3rd season as Lake County's skipper. He is now the longest-tenured manager in Captains history, and 1 of just 2 to win a championship for Lake County (Ted Kubiak, 2010). With his 171st win with the Captains on June 4 at West Michigan, Santos is now the winningest manager in history. He surpassed 2003 South Atlantic League Manager of the Year and former longtime Toronto Blue Jays First Base Coach Luis Rivera (2003-04; father of current Lake County Bench Coach Yan Rivera) for the most wins by a manager in Captains history.

MIDWEST LEAGUE PLAYER OF THE WEEK: On Monday, June 9, OF Jonah Advincula was named the Midwest League Player of the Week for the week 6/2-6/8. The 2023 8<sup>th</sup>-round pick out of Washington State led qualified MiLB hitters in OPS (2.017), SLG (1.333), and AVG (.600, tied). After recording just 1 HR and one 3-hit game in his first 40 games played this year, Advincula hit 3 HR and tallied a trio of 3-hit contests at West Michigan, while recording 3 SB, 5 RBI, and 4 BB to just 1 K in 19 PA.

TULLOCH GETS THE CALL: LHP Adam Tulloch was promoted to the Double-A Akron RubberDucks on Friday, June 13. <u>The southpaw made 14 relief</u> appearances for Lake County this season, and was 1 of just 3 Midwest League pitchers with 3+ HLD, 2+ SV, and a 2.30-or-lower ERA at the time of his promotion. Tulloch also spent the entire 2024 season with the Captains, earning the save in Game 2 of the 2024 Midwest League Championship Series.

DeLUCIA'S DAZZLING DOUBLE-A DEBUT: RHP Dylan DeLucia, who was promoted to the Double-A Akron RubberDucks on Tuesday, June 10, made his Double-A debut on Wednesday, June 11 at Hartford (Double-A, Rockies). The right-hander logged his 1st career pro quality start, allowing just 2 H and 0 BB in 6 scoreless innings, striking out 5. This marked DeLucia's 1st outing with 6+ IP since his final college appearance on June 23, 2022, a CG shutout for Ole Miss vs. Arkansas that sent the Rebels to the 2022 CWS Finals.

ALFONSIN'S AWESOME OFFENSE: OF Alfonsin Rosario, MLB Pipeline's No. 25 Cleveland prospect, has had an impressive start to his High-A career. The 20-year-old ranks top-5 in the Midwest League in HR (11, T-2<sup>m</sup>) and SLG (.513.4<sup>m</sup>), while ranking 7<sup>m</sup> in TB (96) and just outside of the top-10 in OPS (.856, 11<sup>m</sup>) and XBH (22, T-11<sup>m</sup>). Rosario is the only MWL player with 10+ 2B, 10+ HR, and a .510+ SLG this season.

HARTLE'S HEROIC CAMPAIGN: LHP Josh Hartle, MLB Pipeline's No. 22 Guardians prospect, has been one of the Midwest League's premier pitchers this season. <u>The left-hander ranks top-10 in the MWL in: GS</u> (12, T-1st), W (5, T-2std), W% (.833, T-2std), ERA (2.77, 5th), WHIP (1.17, 5th), opposing AVG (.235, 6th), and IP (55.1, 8th).

JOSE'S EXTRA BASES: After winning the 2024 Midwest League Championship with Lake County, INF Jose Devers has excelled early to begin the 2025 campaign. The Samana, DR native leads High-A with 18 2B and ranks T-3"d in the Midwest League with 25 XBH this season. After hitting 7 HR in 102 games with the Captains last year, Devers already has 6 HR in his first 59 games played this season.

RALPHY'S POWERFUL BAT: 1B/LF Ralphy Velazquez, MLB Pipeline's No. 6 Guardians prospect has displayed a strong bat at the plate this year. The 2023 1st-round pick out of Huntington Beach HS (CA) ranks T-2nd in the Midwest League with 4 3B, while ranking top-10 in HR (8, T-6th) and RBI (35, T-9th), and top-15 in XBH (21, T-14th) this season.

# **BIO**

**Mokoro** (wears #43) enters her first season as Lake County's Bat Dog, and first season with the Guardians organization. The 1-year-old Chocolate Labrador Retriever is owned and trained by **Victoria Brody**. **Brody** is a professional dog trainer who started Mission Empawthy (pronounced "EMPATHY"), LLC, a local dog training company which focuses on specializing in psychiatric service dogs for those whose disabilities aren't always visible. **Mokoro will retrieve bats and balls for the Captains alongside Brody at all Thursday home games and select additional games this season!** 

**Mokoro** is named after a type of dugout canoe found in Botswana. These vessels, which usually carry 1-2 passengers, are commonly used to navigate the Okavango Delta for both transport and game viewing safaris. While mekoro (plural form of "mokoro") used to primarily be made from Jackalberry, Mangosteen, and Sausage trees, they are now mainly made from fiberglass.

LAST TIME OUT: LHP Matt Wilkinson (ND) did not record a decision in an eventual 3-2 Captains victory versus Dayton this past Tuesday, June 10. The portsider was 1 out shy of his 1st quality start of the season, allowing just 2 hits, 1 earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 7 strikeouts in a season-high 5.2 innings of work. Wilkinson's lone run allowed was courtesy of a leadoff home run to begin the 5th inning.

TOP 30 PROSPECT: Wilkinson is currently the No. 24 Cleveland prospect according to Baseball America. <u>Baseball America on Wilkinson</u>. "He's a functional mover on the mound despite his size and creates plenty of deception thanks to a low release height and crossfire landing. <u>Wilkinson</u> has a three-pitch mix that is uninspiring in a vacuum but effective in practice."

A HISTORIC 2024 CAMPAIGN: Across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg, Wilkinson led qualified Minor League pitchers with 13.20 strikeouts per 9 innings and a 37.6% strikeout rate. He also ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> in MiLB in: strikeouts (174), ERA (1.90), opposing AVG (.169), and WHIP (0.91). <u>Wilkinson</u> became the only MiLB pitcher with a 0.95-or-lower WHIP, 1.90-or-lower ERA, and at least 170 strikeouts in a season since at least 2005.

2024 HONORS: Wilkinson was named to the 2024 All-MiLB Prospect Second Team and Baseball America Second Team Minor League All-Star Team. He was also named a 2024 Midwest League All-Star, as well as MiLB Pipeline's 2024 Cleveland Guardians Pitching Prospect of the Year and the Canadian Baseball Network's 2024 Wayne Norton Award winner (Tro Canadian Minor League Minor L

PLAYOFF HEROICS: Wilkinson made 2 starts for the Captains during the 2024 Midwest League Playoffs. The left-hander was the only pitcher to log double-digit innings (12.1) during the 2024 MVIL Playoffs, while also leading in win percentage (1.000, 1-0), wins (1, tied), and games started (2, tied). Wilkinson saved one of the best performances of his career for last with Lake County's season on the line in Game 2 of the 2024 MVIL Championship Series vs. Wisconsin. The southpaw recorded the longest start of his professional career, pitching a career-high 6.2 innings in his first career postseason quality start. He allowed just two earned runs, and two walks, while throwing five strikeouts in a career-high 96 pitches (career-high 60 strikes). Wilkinson ultimately helped force a decisive Game 3, which Lake County eventually won the following night to clinch the 2024 Midwest League Championship.

ALL ABOARD THE "TUGBOAT": Wilkinson has held the nickname "Tugboat" from a young age. His father's best friend growing up, Phil McNeil, gave Matt the nickname, "after seeing Wilkinson run around the bases at a pace he thought was similar to that of the boat designed to tow larger vessels," MLB.com's Rob Terranova wrote. "I love it, I love being called Tugboat," Wilkinson said to Terranova. "But I don't want people to forget that I'm Matt Wilkinson, too."

THE INVISI-BALL: When Wilkinson trained at the Okotoks Dawgs Academy in Canada early in his career, a place where he still trains during the offseason, one of his coaches, Joe Sergent, took note of the left-hander's unique delivery, particularly for his fastball. "He's just got a certain run and life on his fastball that you don't see in regular pitchers. There's just another gear that comes out of his hand," Sergent told lan Wilson of AlbertaDugoutStories.com. "It's just the way the ball comes out of his hand —we call it the 'invisi-ball."

A START FOR THE AGES: On April 25, 2024, Wilkinson made Minor League Baseball history in his start against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (Single-A, CHC). The left-hander pitched 6 scoreless, hitless innings, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 15 strikeouts in 82 pitches (56 strikes). According to MilLB com's Jesús Cano, Wilkinson beame the 5° MilLB pitcher since 2005 to record at least 15 strikeouts without allowing a hift. The MILB pitchers to do this are Hall-of-Famer Warren Spahn (1960), 1971 NL All-Star Don Wilson (1967), Hall-of-Famer Nolan Ryan (3 times), 3-time NL Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw (2014, whom Wilkinson said was his favorite player at the 2015 Little League World Series), and 3-time Cy Young Award winner Max Scherzer (2015).

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Wilkinson was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for the month of April 2024 as a member of the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. *In 4 starts, he went 2-0 with a 0.44 ERA, a Minor League-best 41 strikeouts, and a Minor League-best .091 opposing AVG.*Wilkinson also allowed just 6 hits and 6 walks in 20.2 innings of work.

VALIANT VAQUERO: After initially committing to the University of Washington, Wilkinson pitched collegiately at Central Arizona College (JUCO), where he was the 2023 NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year, a 2023 NJCAA 1st Team All-American, the 2023 ABCA/Rawlings Pitcher of the Year, and the Arizona Community College Athletic Association Pitcher of the Year. In 2023, he went 10-2 with a 1.07 ERA, 136 strikeouts, a 0.73 WHIP, and 2 complete games in 16 appearances (14 starts), and won the NJCAA Division I Baseball World Series in 2022. Following his 2023 campaign, Wilkinson eventually chose to forgo his commitment to Arizona State after being selected by the Guardians in the 10th round of the 2023 MLB Draft.

LITTLE LEAGUE LEGEND: When he was 12 years old, Wilkinson had a remarkable performance at the 2015 Little League World Series as a member of Team Canada. In his only start, he pitched 5 scoreless innings against Team Mexico, allowing just 2 hits and throwing 16 strikeouts in a 1-0 defeat. "(The LLWS) was definitely a cool experience, it was like a dream come true," Wilkinson told The Daily Sentinel's James Burky. "It felt like more than a game for the first couple of weeks. Leading up to the tournament, you had to do ESPN interviews, all of those walkup things. I loved it because it was something that I wanted to do since I was eight."

MORE ON WILKINSON: Wilkinson grew up in Ladner, British Columbia, the same hometown as former longtime MLB LHP James Paxton. He has 2 Australian Kelpie dogs, Reggie and Mookie, who are named after Baseball Hall-of-Famer Reggie Jackson and 8-time MLB All-Star Mookie Betts.
