WINNING STREAK ENDS IN 3-2 DEFEAT

Bryan Hoeing yielded only an unearned run in 5.1 strong innings Friday, but the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp's five-game winning streak came to an end with a 3-2 loss in 10 innings to the Charlotte Knights from Truist Field. Billy Hamilton started the 10th inning on second base with the score tied at two. Laz Rivera laid down a sacrifice bunt before intentional walks to Zach Remillard and Adam Haseley loaded the bases. Jacksonville (7-5) reliever Anthony Maldonado (0-1) then gave up an infield single to Victor Reves to score Hamilton for Charlotte (6-7) to win the game. After allowing a run in the second, Hoeing dominated, fanning the final 12 batters he faced.

FIRST THINGS FIRST

Jacksonville's streak of 10 leadoff men reaching base to start off the game ended Thursday night. Of those 10 leadoff baserunners, five have come on swings on the first pitch. Seven of those 10 leadoff baserunners have also come via hits; Brian Miller reached on an error to start the Jumbo Shrimp's contest on April 2 at the Stripers, Edwards walked to start the bottom of the first on Sunday against Durham and Edwards drew a free pass to start Thursday's affair at Charlotte

LEADERS, NOT FOLLOWERS

The Jumbo Shrimp weren't able to get a first inning tally on Friday, which ended their streak of five consecutive games with a first inning run. In their last 12 games, the Jumbo Shrimp have struck for at least one tally in their first at-bats nine times. Jacksonville has scored first in seven of its 12 games thus far in 2023, going 6-1 when doing so. The Jumbo Shrimp scored the game's first run 83 times in 2022 (55.7 percent) and had a 62-21 (.747) record when doing so.

On Jacksonville's slugging offense, perhaps no one has shined more than C.J. Hinoiosa. Through eight games thus far in 2023. Hinoiosa is 14-for-36, slashing a robust .389/.410/.667/1.077 with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, 11 RBIs and five runs scored. The Houston native ranks tied for 12th in the International League in RBIs, sixth in batting average, T-15th in slugging and 15th in OPS.

CHARLOTTE'S WEB

Since the club's first season back in Triple-A, Jacksonville owns a 31-24 record against the Knights. The two teams played each other to a razor thin margin last year (12-9). Against Charlotte, the Jumbo Shrimp hitters slashed .288/.367/.470 with an .837 OPS (2nd-highest) among 2022 division opponents. The pitching staff owned 4.51 ERA (3rdlowest) among 2022 division opponents.

THE ENDS JUSTIFY THE MEANS

Only six teams in the IL (Iowa, Columbus, Omaha, Toledo, Syracuse and Norfolk) have scored more runs than Jacksonville through the season's first 12 games. Despite the club's 76 runs scored, the Jumbo Shrimp are ranked 8th in average (.253), 11th in on-base percentage (.339), 13th in slugging percentage (.411) and T-11th in OPS (.750). With runners in scoring position, though, Jacksonville's slash line is .254/.343/.430/.773, figures that rank eighth, ninth, seventh and ninth, respectively.

THE DIVINE RIGHT TO RULE

Through the club's first nine games of the season, Jacksonville's pitching staff struggled, ranking last in the IL with a 6.66 ERA. Since their off day on April 10, the Jumbo Shrimp pitchers have turned a corner and have ruled the Queen City since their opening contest on Tuesday. So far in the first four games against Charlotte, the Jumbo Shrimp pitchers have the second-best ERA in the IL (2.23) and have allowed nine earned runs, tied for the fewest during this span. In 14.1 innings, Jacksonville's firemen have vielded four runs (three earned) for a 1.88 ERA. They've also allowed 9 hits with five walks and 14 strikeouts.

SHRIMP BITES

Jordan Groshans has at least one hit in eight of Jacksonville's first 11 games so far this season, going 11- for-46 (.239/.314/.304/.618) at the plate with two doubles, five RBIs and six runs scored...Groshans increased his on-base streak to 11 straight with a walk last night... Peyton Burdick has two multi-homer games this season...His 116 MPH home run on 4/12 was the second hardest hit ball in MiLB this season...The Jumbo Shrimp played 39 one-run games in 2022, finishing 20-19. Through the club's first 12 games, Jacksonville is 3-1 in one-run games to start 2023.

ABOUT JEFF

- -A graduate of Illinois State University, Lindgren was mainly a reliever in college, starting in just 17 of his 83 appearances. He went 8-14 with a 6.02 ERA over his four seasons. However, entering 2022, he has already totaled 19 minor league starts in 36 career games, collecting an 8-10 record and 3.28 ERA.
- -Jeff comes from an athletic family; His father, John, played football at Henderson State University in Arkadelphia, Arkansas.
- -An alumnus of Illinois State University, Jeff followed in his sister Allyson's footsteps in attending school in Bloomington-Normal, Illinois. Allyson is a fellow graduate of Illinois State.

-Lingren played for the Pensacola Blue Wahoo's between stint with Jacksonville. In 2022 combine, Lingren posted a 7-4 record with 116 strikeouts in 136.2 IP.

2021 SEASON

- -With the bases empty, opponents hit .234 (59-for-252) with a .740 OPS. However, with runners in scoring position, Lindgren buckled down for a .211 (16-for-76) opponents' average and .598 OPS.
- -Lindgren got off to slower starts in 2021; in the first and second innings, opponents batted .290 (43-for-148). However, in the third and fourth innings, often his second time through the order, Lindgren held opposing hitters to a .183 (25-for-136).
- -When Lindgren got hitters in a 1-2 hole, they were just 7-for-71 (.099) against him with 33 strikeouts.

Interestingly, when Lindgren was pitching from behind on the scoreboard, he performed better, holding opponents to a .176 (24-for-136) average. When his team led, opposing hitters collected a .241 (27-for-112) average.

2019 SEASON

- -With High-A Jupiter, lefties hit .297 with a .680 OPS against Lindgren. However, he held right-handed hitters to a .176 average with a .432 OPS.
- -With the bases empty, opponents hit .275 (11-for-40) against Lindgren with a .626 OPS. With runners in scoring position, Lindgren limited opposing batters to .194 (6-for-31) with a .508 OPS. Total, with runners on, Lindgren posted a .188 (9-for-48) batting average against with an OPS of .471.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-At Centennial High School (Champaign, Ill.), Lindgren competed in both baseball and basketball. He served as the baseball team captain, helped win two regional championships and one sectional championship.
