### LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox were shut out on Friday night by the Hartford Yard Goats by a final score of 4-0. Neither team could score in the first eight innings. **Seth Johnson** and **Peter Van Loon** combined for eight scoreless frames for Bowie. Connor Van Scoyoc and three relievers combined for eight scoreless frames for Hartford. In the 9th, the Yard Goats plated four runs on five hits on two errors against **Wandisson Charles** to grab the win.

### ALL-STAR SAMUEL

Last Saturday, C/1B **Samuel Basallo** represented the Orioles in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game. In the game, Basallo went 0-for-1 with a four-pitch walk. The No. 2 O's/No. 12 MLB prospect is tied for ninth in the Eastern League in home runs (12), is eighth in hits (78) and is the first teenager to hit double-digit home runs in an Eastern League season since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. in 2018 (NH).

### THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is tied for second among active Eastern League players with 13 home runs on the season - tied for 10th-most in Double-A. After hitting 11 homers between May and June, the O's No. 11 prospect is still looking for his first homer in July.

### FEAR THE BEARD

Between Double-A Bowie and High-A Aberdeen, OF/1B **Matthew Etzel's** 40 stolen bags this season are tied for ninth-most in all of MiLB. The first member of the O's '23 draft class to reach Double-A, Etzel has hits in 21 of his first 26 starts at the level, including in his last six straight.

### LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 61 of 75 games played in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 6 prospect leads the team in walks (40), tied for the sixth-most in the Eastern League.

### YOU GOOD PHAM

On Monday, RHP **Alex Pham** was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for the first time in his career after he threw six scoreless innings, allowed just one hit, one walk and struck out six last Thursday at Altoona. The Orioles No. 23 prospect is fourth in the Eastern League and eighth in Double-A in strikeouts this season (96).

### ARMS RACE

The Baysox pitching staff has the fifth-best ERA in Double-A since June 1 (3.45) and has recorded the 2nd-most strikeouts this season (863)...The Baysox bullpen has thrown the most innings (423.2) at Double-A with the 3rd-best WHIP (1.21)...The Bowie rotation has also done its part with the 2nd-lowest ERA (2.21) in Double-A in July.

### A DRY JULY

The Baysox offense has struggled mightily this month through the first 13 games, with a league-low .198 batting average. They have scored 30 runs, which is the fewest in Double-A. In their last eight games, Bowie has managed to score just eight runs in its last seven games.

### THE GOATS ARE GRAZING

The Hartford Yard Goats visit Bowie for the first and only time this season. The Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies won the Northeast Division in the first half of the season. Nine of the Rockies' Top 30 prospects are on the active roster- IF Adael Amador (No. 2), OF Yanquiel Fernandez (No. 4), OF Zac Veen (No. 5), 1B Sterlin Thompson (No. 6), SS Ryan Ritter (No. 12), LHP Carson Palmquist (No. 14), 3B Warming Bernabel (No. 16), RHP Jaden Hill (No. 26) and RHP Connor Van Scoyoc (No. 28).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Evan Shawver gets the start for Hartford tonight in a possible bullpen game for the Yard Goats. The southpaw has primarily been as a reliever and tonight will be his 24th appearance of the season and his fifth start. The 24-year-old has not gone longer than 2.2 innings in an outing this season. Shawver has pitched a total of four scoreless innings in two meetings against the Baysox this season. The Lorain, OH native was drafted in the 7th round by the Rockies in 2021 out of Cincinnati.

Named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for July 9-14

**2024:** Threw 6.0 shutout IP, allowed just 1 H, 1 BB with 6 K in a ND on 7/11 @ ALT. Retired 17 of final 18 batters faced. Named EL Pitcher of Week for 7/9-7/14 for first time in career. First Baysox player to receive weekly award this season. Has struck out 2nd-most batters in O's system (96) and is tied for 3rd-most IP (73.2). 4th in EL and 8th in Double-A in strikeouts. Baysox have won nine of last 13 games that Pham has started in. Holds a 8.04 ERA in eight home starts. Ended month of June with a 4.43 ERA, best of the season thus far. Threw first scoreless start of season by matching career-high 6.0 IP and 0 BB over 6 K to record win on 6/11 @ HBG. Ended month of May with a 5.64 ERA. Allowed just two runs or less in four of his five starts in May. Collected first Double-A win on 5/7 vs AKR after dealing 5.0 IP with 6 K, matching season-high. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and was named Opening Night starter. Second season as full-time starter after beginning pro career in bullpen.

**2023:** Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. .163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

**2022:** Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings. Placed on IL for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season.

**2021:** Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

**Personal:** Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing 7th in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



### CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



### BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado on the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Coaching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.
